INTRODUCTION

The following report is a comprehensive survey of the World Bank Group operations in China since the People's Republic of China assumed its World Bank membership in 1980.

For more than 38 years, China and the World Bank have worked together in partnership to address China's evolving development challenges. The country's overall success with reform, growth and poverty reduction during this time is well known. While China deserves full credit for these positive developments, the Bank has played a supporting role in helping China to: introduce relevant international practices and experiences; make timely diagnostic studies of China's challenges and recommendations to address them; follow up with well-considered investment projects to test innovative ideas; and implement appropriate capacity building programs to turn some of the more successful elements into replicable models.

The objectives of the Bank's assistance program have shifted as China's development needs have changed. The Bank Group's program in China aims to help:

- **Support greener growth**, by shifting to a sustainable energy path, enhancing urban environmental services, promoting low-carbon urban transport, promoting sustainable agriculture practices, demonstrating sustainable natural resource management approaches, demonstrating pollution management, and strengthening climate change mechanisms.
- **Promote more inclusive development**, by increasing access to quality health services and social protection programs, strengthening skills development programs, enhancing opportunities in rural areas, and improving transport connectivity for more balanced regional development.
- **Advance mutually beneficial relations with the world**, by supporting China's South-South cooperation and China's role as a global stakeholder.

The World Bank Group is developing a new Country Partnership Framework. The World Bank's program is carried out through three main instruments: loans for physical investments; loans and grants for technical assistance; and non-financial services in the form of analytical reports, policy advice, workshops and training. These instruments are used singly or in combination as appropriate to the specific objective.

The World Bank-supported lending program supports key Government priorities in infrastructure, human development, rural poverty reduction, environment and natural resource management with financial resources as well as with knowledge and capacity building embedded in lending projects. Since the first loan in 1981 supporting development of Chinese universities, the World Bank's cumulative lending to China as of June 30, 2018 was more than US\$61.91 billion for a total of 422 development projects. 83 of these projects are under implementation, making China's portfolio one of the largest in the Bank.

World Bank-supported projects can be found in almost all parts of China and in many sectors of the economy. The portfolio is concentrated in environment, transportation, urban development, rural development, energy, water resource management, and human development, but the focus of projects in each of these areas has shifted as China's development needs have changed. Early World Bank supported projects focused on introducing modern project appraisal,

management, and construction techniques. Today, more than 70 percent of World Bank Group-financed projects and activities include a strong focus on the environment. Urban projects focus on improving the urban environment, including sustainable water supply, sanitation, and urban transport; and energy projects focus increasingly on introducing new approaches to encourage energy efficiency and use of renewable energy. Transport projects, which traditionally focused on connecting the poorer inner provinces to the dynamic coastal areas, are increasingly focused on rural roads and on environmentally sustainable urban transport. Recent projects support migrant skills training and technical and vocational education. The Bank also uses new instruments—program-for-results (PforRs) and development policy operations (DPOs)—for larger transformational and programmatic operations that address national priorities, such as curbing air pollution and strengthening subnational fiscal management.

Knowledge sharing and transfer are central to the China-Bank Group relationship - both through helping China to access global development experiences and knowledge and through analysis and dissemination of China's own economic growth and poverty reduction experiences to other countries. The Bank is supporting a broad range of analytical and advisory activities to: assess specific China challenges in light of global experience; facilitate national and global policy discussions; and lay the groundwork for future development investments and other activities. The Bank provides analytical support to assist the Government in sustaining effective macro-economic management, reducing systemic risks in the financial system, and improving the environment for private sector development. This analytical and advisory work addresses areas such as urbanization, access to finance, early child development, health system reform, pension system reform, social protection and labor market, aged care, low carbon cities development, and sustainable urban transport. The Bank is also providing analytical and advisory work to help further improve the efficiency and sustainability of natural resource use. In recent years, the World Bank has successfully completed three joint flagship studies, China 2030 and Urban China with the Development Research Center (DRC) of China's State Council, and Healthy China with the World Health Organization, the Ministry of Finance, the National Health and Family Planning Commission, and the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security of China. The World Bank Group and the DRC are currently undertaking a joint flagship study on the New Drivers of Growth.

A three-year rolling cooperation program between China and the World Bank is reviewed and updated once a year. The Ministry of Finance is the chief counterpart agency for all World Bank Group operations in China. The National Development and Reform Commission also plays a central role in program formulation. Program proposals may be submitted by either side. All project proposals are thoroughly appraised technically, economically, financially, environmentally, and socially before being submitted for final approval by both lender and borrower. For analytical and advisory work, an annual program of major activities is agreed, supplemented by ad hoc requests from the Government for work on emerging issues. The World Bank's China program is managed through its office in Beijing.

This survey is updated in July each year, while our website (www.worldbank.org/china) provides detailed and up-to-date information about the World Bank's activities in China.

SECTION IV. MIGA OPERATIONS IN CHINA

Created in 1988, the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA) encourages foreign direct investment (FDI) in developing countries by providing political risk insurance (guarantees) to foreign investors and lenders against the risks of expropriation, transfer restriction, breach of contract, war and civil disturbance, and non-honoring of financial obligations. As part of its guarantee program, MIGA helps investors and governments resolve disputes that may adversely impact investments guaranteed by MIGA, thus preventing potential claim situations from escalating and keeping investments going. MIGA also helps countries formulate and implement strategies for attracting and retaining FDI through its financial contribution to Investment Climate (IC) Advisory Services (formerly known as Foreign Investment Advisory Services or FIAS), as well as offering online services and free information on investment opportunities, business operating conditions, and political risk insurance.

MIGA in China

Since 2000, there has been rising interest for MIGA guarantees covering investments into China, particularly for projects that involve sub-sovereign risk, such as those in the water, wastewater and solid waste management sectors. MIGA is eager to facilitate more investments into China, especially in support of China's PPP Program and western and northeast regional development strategy. At the same time, MIGA is working closely with Chinese partners on outward investment in support of the country's "Going Abroad" and "the Belt and Road Initiative". For the past few years, MIGA has received increasing interest from Chinese banks and companies to cover their outward investments.

Guarantees

Exposure. MIGA has been active in supporting FDI into China. Since 1993, MIGA has supported 36 projects amounting to over US\$593.9 million. Most of these projects are in the water, wastewater, and waste management sectors.

For Chinese outward investment, MIGA has in the past six years supported eight projects totaling US\$1.24 billion in guarantee coverage that included the participation of Chinese and other investors in the power, telecom, extractive industries, construction, and health sectors in Kenya, Jordan, Egypt, Myanmar, Ghana, Nigeria, and Turkey. MIGA guarantees to those projects helped facilitate a total of US\$2.08 billion in investment. A number of Chinese banks such as the Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (ICBC), ICBC (Asia), Bank of China (Hong Kong), Bank of China Singapore Branch, China Construction Bank (CCB) and China Development Bank have benefited from MIGA guarantees for those outward infrastructure

investment projects. In addition, MIGA is currently preparing several new projects for both inward and outward investments.

Cooperation with the Ministry of Finance (MOF) and Ministry of Commerce (MOFCOM): Focus on Outward Investment. MIGA has been working with the MOF and MOFCOM, with a focus on facilitating Chinese investment overseas, specifically into Africa and Asia. In 2005, MIGA organized a workshop jointly with the MOF, China EXIM Bank and the IFC to introduce risk mitigation tools provided by the World Bank Group, particularly by MIGA. In 2006, MIGA and FIAS organized a conference jointly with MOFCOM to present the findings of a survey of 150 Chinese companies with overseas investments. Also in 2006, MIGA co-sponsored the Dialogue Conference between Chinese enterprises and Fortune Global 500 Companies with MOFCOM's China Investment Promotion Agency in Wenzhou. In 2012, MIGA co-organized two workshops on Chinese outward investment and risk management with its Chinese partners in Beijing and Tianjin, respectively. In 2016 and 2017, MIGA Vice President and Chief Operating Officer and MIGA Executive Vice President attended the Investing in Africa Forum in Guangzhou, China and Dakar, Senegal and presented recent examples of MIGA's support for Chinese overseas investments.

Cooperation with Sinosure, China EXIM Bank, China Development Bank, Bank of China, ICBC, China Africa Development Fund, and other partners. In 2005, MIGA signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Sinosure on cooperation in marketing and co-insurance of Chinese outward investment. Between 2005 and 2017, MIGA provided four investment insurance training courses for Sinosure, and co-organized a series of political risk insurance road shows in China's coastal cities. MIGA has also strengthened its cooperation with China EXIM Bank, Silk Road Fund, China Development Bank, Bank of China, and ICBC through joint projects, regular dialogues and identification of potential projects for future cooperation. Between 2010 and 2017, MIGA also arranged a number of workshops for China Development Bank, China Africa Development Fund, Silk Road Fund, Bank of China (Hong Kong) and ICBC in Beijing, Changchun and Hong Kong.

SECTION V. GEF PROJECTS IN CHINA

(World Bank as Implementing Agency)

The Global Environment Facility (GEF) provides grants and concessional loans to UNDP and World Bank-eligible countries to co-finance projects and programs that both protect the global environment and promote sustainable economic growth. The GEF is an independent financial institution which began as a pilot program in 1991 and was formally established in 1994. It funds the agreed incremental costs of activities that benefit the global environment in six focal areas: climate change; biological diversity; international waters; persistent organic pollutants, land degradation and stratospheric ozone depletion. The Climate Change, Biodiversity and POPs Conventions have designated the GEF as their funding mechanism. Countries must ratify the relevant convention to qualify for GEF support in these three focal areas.

Countries access GEF resources through either one of three “implementing agencies”: the UN Development Program (UNDP), the UN Environment Program (UNEP) and the World Bank, or through several “executing agencies” including the Asian Development Bank (ADB). The GEF Secretariat, which is functionally independent from the three implementing agencies, reports to and services the GEF Council (Board) and Assembly. The Ministry of Finance is the Focal Point for coordinating GEF projects in China.

Since 1992, the World Bank has facilitated 53 GEF-supported projects in China with grants of more than US\$691 million.

SECTION VI. MONTREAL PROTOCOL PROJECTS IN CHINA

(World Bank as Implementing Agency)

The World Bank signed an agreement with the Multilateral Fund to the Montreal Protocol (MP) in 1991 whereby it agreed to provide support to eligible countries to meet their MP obligations and became one of four implementing agencies engaged in country efforts to phase out ozone depleting substances (ODS). The effectiveness of a given ODS in removing ozone is measured by its Ozone Depleting Potential (ODP). The use of ODS and their substitutes penetrates all facets of daily life - refrigerators in homes, domestic and commercial air conditioning in buildings, freezers in supermarkets and transportation, aerosols for hair sprays, paint or shaving cream, fire extinguishers, furniture, construction materials, insulation foams, automobile air conditioning, and so on.

As an "Article 5" country (developing country), China is eligible for financing from the Multilateral Fund for the implementation of the MP. Between 1993 and 1997, the World Bank approved four China ODS Phase-out Projects. The ODS I and II Projects were completed in mid-1997 and phased out a total of 15,800 ODP tons. The ODS III Project financed phaseout activities in individual companies producing or using ODS. It was completed in December 2006 and phased out about 19,000 ODP tons.

The ODS IV Project is a sector- and performance-based umbrella project composed of ten sector plans including mobile air conditioning, commercial refrigeration, CFC production, 1.1.1.-TCA, halon, foam, CTC Production and process agents I and II, CFC/Halon accelerated phase-out, and pharmaceutical aerosol. The ODS IV Project implemented during 1997-2013 helped China to achieve a total reduction of 211,811 ODP tons, ensuring fulfilment of its obligations under the MP ahead of schedule, while contributing greatly to climate change mitigation. ODS IV also included activities on HCFC phase-out demonstration subprojects in the foam sector, and the preparation of HCFC Phase-out Management Plans in the foam and production sectors.

In 2007, the Parties to the MP decided to accelerate the HCFC consumption and production phase-out schedule for both developed and developing (Article 5) countries. HCFCs are used primarily as refrigerants in refrigeration and air-conditioning equipment and as blowing agents for producing insulation foam. With low ODP values, HCFCs were introduced in some applications as transitional substances to replace the potent ODS group, CFCs.

With the adjusted schedule, all Article 5 countries were required to reduce their HCFC production and consumption levels to baseline levels (2009-2010 average) by January 1, 2013 and achieve a 10% reduction by January 1, 2015. Additional reductions are scheduled from 2020 until 2030 when complete phaseout is mandated except for a small allowance for servicing equipment until 2040.

A total funding of US\$168 million was approved for China's HCFC Phase-out Project (Stage I) to assist it in meeting its 2013 freeze and 2015 reduction obligations. The project comprises a US\$73 million grant approved in November 2012 for China to reduce HCFC- 141b consumption in the polyurethane (PU) foam sector and a \$95 million grant approved in April 2013 to reduce HCFC production, both while reducing corresponding greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions (as ODS are also GHGs). The project has five components: 1) Investment in HCFC 141-b consumption reduction in the PU foam sector; 2) Investment in HCFC production reduction; 3) Technical assistance and policy support; 4) Project management; and 5) Preparation of HCFC phase-out activities beyond 2015.

As of mid-2018, the total grant amount of \$168 million had been released to China, of which more than \$137 million, representing 82%, was disbursed to subprojects, technical assistance activities and project management units. So far, the project has already met or exceeded and sustained most of its key outcome targets, including compliance with China's 2015 MP production and consumption limits for HCFCs.

This was possible in the foam sector through a total of 63 subprojects (57 foam enterprises and 6 foam system houses) that converted foam manufacturing to low-GWP alternatives. According to a 2017 progress report, consumption of HCFC-141b at these beneficiaries was reduced from 1,404 ODP tons in 2010 to 152 ODP tons in 2017. Conversion to hydrocarbon and water blown technologies in the foam sector has resulted in a climate impact of 7.5 million tCO₂e of emissions avoided.

The elimination of HCFC production under ODS V was achieved through a total of 28 production reduction contracts signed with HCFC producers including 4 for idle production line closures, 19 for quota reductions and 5 for production closure. As a result, production of all types of HCFCs in 2016 was 15% below the MP allowable limit of 26,210 ODP tons for that year. In total, HCFC production was reduced from 30,180 ODP tons in 2010 to 22,514 ODP tons in 2016, representing a reduction of 7,666 ODP tons. The closedown of production capacity and reduction provides climate co-benefits equivalent to 184 million tCO₂e, surpassing the target of 63 million tCO₂e by more than 100%.

To enable China to fulfill its subsequent HCFC phase-out obligations, the Multilateral Fund approved in 2016 an additional \$141.47 million for a second stage of HCFC phase-out in the PU foam sector which will lead to complete HCFC-141b consumption phase-out in the sector by 2026. A pipeline HCFC Phase-out Project (Stage II) will provide support to an estimated 150-200 larger foam manufacturers, several hundred SMEs across ten foam subsectors, eight foam system houses, as well as policy support and technical

assistance. In addition, HCFC production reductions to mirror consumption phase-out requirements will also be included in the project for 23 remaining HCFC production companies. The Multilateral Fund has already approved a “bridging fund” of US\$23 million for China to meet its 2018 HCFC production reduction commitments to the Montreal Protocol. Additional funding for Stage II implementation of HCFC production reductions is expected in 2019. A new China-World Bank grant agreement to channel these funds is expected to become effective by 2018.
