(cont'd) One of my hobbies is to reunite old books with their previous owners...or in most cases, their family. The internet is a great help and has many tracks to follow.

"Mr Lawrence" proved to be a real challenge. He had passed away many years ago so it was time to start ringing possible descendants. After many phone calls, I found a distant relative in Orange, NSW.

He told me that "Mr Lawrence" was born in 1907 and spent a lifetime in the civil aviation industry and had owned a house in Sydney. He married but never had any children

This was starting to get more difficult until the Orange contact told me about his elderly aunt in Sydney.

Before I contacted her, I was able to find the late "Mr Lawrence" in the 1936 census which also listed his address at the time.

So, with some nervousness I contacted the Sydney descendant. I spent quite a few minutes convincing her that this we not a scam and I didn't want any money. But what I did want to do was to return the old book to "Mr Lawrence's" family. She was speechless. The lady was actually "Mr

Lawrence's" favourite niece. This old book had finally found a new and rightful home.

She told me that he had passed away in 1978 and that he was a real gent. *She sent me a beautiful thank-you letter* on behalf of all the "Lawrence" family. I think I was just as excited as they were."

To be sure, not all genuinely lost items will make it back home as in John's story. One or two that does will make a welcome difference.

By the way, **Missing Persons Week** is Aug 3-9. The Salvos International Family Tracing Service has a 75%+ success rate in locating missing family members and relatives.
