Viktor Yanukovych was born on July 9, 1950 in Yenakiyevo of Donetsk region into a working class family. Citizenship: Ukrainian.

Education: Donetsk Polytechnic Institute (presently, Donetsk State Technical University), Studies in Mechanical Engineering and Ukrainian Academy of Foreign Trade, Master's degree in International Law.

His working career Viktor Yanukovych started in 1969, worked as fitter and mechanic of Yenakiyevo metal works. Over 20 years' experience in top executive positions including General Director of major production firms – "Donbastransremont", "Ukrvuhlepromtrans" and Donetsk Region Motor Transport Territorial Production Association.

In August 1996 V.F. Yanukovych was appointed Deputy Head and in September – the First Deputy Head of Donetsk Regional State Administration, Deputy of Donetsk Regional Council pluralistically.

In November 21, 2002 Mr. Yanukovych was appointed Prime Minister of Ukraine.

In July 4, 2004 he was nominated by Regions Party for the presidency.

In August 4, 2006 Verkhovna Rada has approved Viktor Yanukovych as Prime Minister of Ukraine.

Viktor Fedorovych Yanukovych is a Doctor of Economics, Professor, Full Member of the Academy of Economic Sciences of Ukraine, Member of the Presidium of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine.

Mr. Yanukovych is awarded with the Orders of three degrees "For Merits", Honoured Transport Worker of Ukraine, other state awards.
