After his stint at the Twin Falls *Times News*, Niels Nokkentved worked at the Olympian newspaper in Olympia, Washington, before returning to Idaho. Also, Bob Cooper left Idaho to work for KING-TV in Seattle, then returned to Idaho to work for the state Lottery Commission. Al Bunch and Ann Kirkwood left Idaho after their journalist jobs in the Gem State to run a weekly newspaper in Alaska, then returned to Boise, where they work outside the news media.
