About the District

Khammam town was part of the larger Warangal district till October 1st, 1953. Five taluks of the Warangal district viz., Khammam, Madhira, Yellandu, Burgampadu and Palwancha (now Kothagudem) were carved out and a new district with Khammam as district head quarters was formed. In 1985, following the introduction of mandal system, the district was divided into 46 mandals in four revenue divisions viz., Khammam, Kothagudem, Palwancha & Bhadrachalam. The Khammam District as a part of Telangana state formed with 21 mandals in two revenue division's viz., Khammam & Kalluru, 380 Revenue Villages & 589 Grama Panchyaths and has been bifurcated as Bhadradri Kothagudem district with 19 Mandals and 2 mandals into Mahabubabad District in the part of new districts formation.

The District shares boundaries with (03) Districts i.e., Bhadradri Kothagudem, Mahabubabad, Suryapet Districts in Telangana State and Krishna, West Godavari Districts of Andhra Pradesh State. The Khammam district, which is a part of Telangana region and state has between 16⁰-15'-0" and 17⁰-47'-42" of Northern Latitude and 79⁰-57'-22" and 80⁰-55'-0" of the Eastern Longitude.

The District headquarters is located at Khammam Town which is located on the Bank of the Munneru River one of the tributaries to the river Krishna.

The district is well known for its permanent historical and traditional importance. The nomenclature of Khammam is said to have derived from a temple 'Narasimhadri' built on a hillock in the town. The temple was referred as 'Stamba Sikhari' and later 'Stambadhri'. It is believed that lord Narasimha emerged from a stone pillar and killed the evil king Hiranya kasyapu to save his child devotee Prahlada. This incident is said to have occurred in the Krutayuga. The vertical rock under the temple is known as 'Kamba' and the town at the foot of the hill was called Kambamettu which gradually changed to Khammam mettu and finally Khammam.

BASIC FEATURES OF KHAMMAM DISTRICT

- Khammam district has an area of 4361.33 Sq.Km which consists 3.89 percent of the state.
- Forest area occupies 14.36% of total geographical area.
- Its population 14.02 Lakhs account for 4.00 percent of the State total.
- **34.12 percent population is SC & ST (SC-19.93%, ST-14.19%)**
- The overall sex ratio was 1006.
- 68.08% of the area is under cultivation.
- 88.39% of Cropped area is under irrigation.
- Munneru, Akeru and Wyra streams are passing through some mandals in the District.
- Agriculture is the main stay in the district as majority of the population depend on agriculture and allied activities for their lively hood.
- Major crop are Rice, Cotton, Sugarcane and Maize.
- The Horticultural Crops - Chillies crop occupies majority share in area (*8.94% of total cropped area*).
- The fruit crops i.e., Mango, Sapota, Lemon and Vegetables have also occupied considerable share in the district.

- The vast Granite deposits in the district is fine and export quality.
- The added advantage to this region is railway connectivity with major towns and cities in the state.
- Khammam Fort was built in 950AD by the kakatiyas, Khammam fort has a long and checkered history. It was taken over by the Qutub Shahi rulers in the year 1512 and subsequently passed into the hands of asaf jahi rulers in the 17th century. Built with granite, the fort stands majestically on a hill in the heart of Khammam town.
- Nelakondapally is located 21 kms from Khammam, i.e. historic site encompassed by a mud fortification wall covering nearly 100 acres. Excavations have unearthed foundations of brick built viharas, wells cisterns, a mahastupa, terracotta figurines, a bronze idol of Buddha, a miniature stupa carved in lime stone and other early historic materials belonging to 3rd and 4th centuries AD.
- Just 20Kms from Khammam is Kusumanchi where one of the biggest Sivalingam was installed in the Ganapeshwara temple built during the Kakatiya period.
- Palair Reservoir located in Kusumanchi mandal, Wyr Reservoir located in Wyr mandal and Lankasagar project located in Penuballi mandal.
