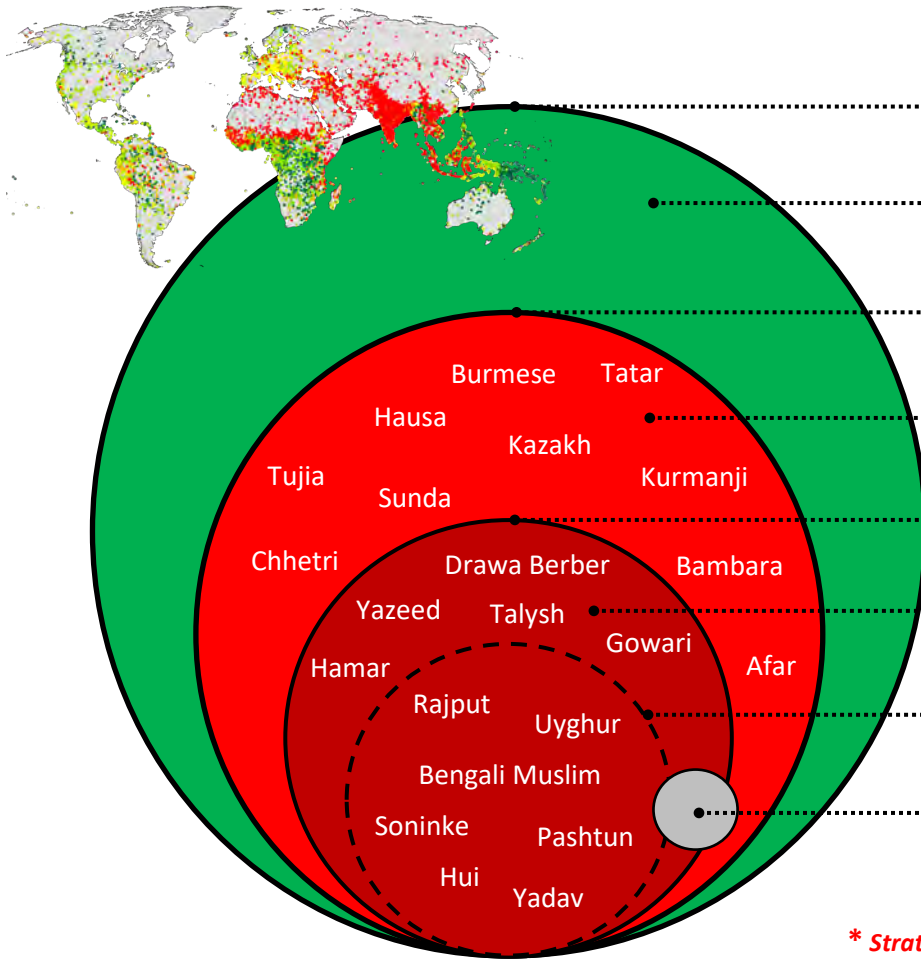


A People Group View of the World

* **Strategic ministry focus:** 1 out of 5 individuals in the world live in just 293 largest Frontier People Groups. Ministry among these 293 will impact the smaller Frontier Peoples and Unengaged Peoples near them.

Reached: Often still in great need of saturation evangelism, discipleship, and pastoral training, but can be done by Christ-followers and resources existing within the people group.

Unreached: No indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate numbers and resources to evangelize their people group without outside assistance.

Frontier: subset of Unreached that have virtually no followers of Jesus and no known movements to Christ, and still needing pioneer cross-cultural workers

Unengaged: subset of Unreached and Frontier that have no known onsite workers focused on starting reproducing churches and movements.
