**Reached:** Often still in great need of saturation evangelism, discipleship, and pastoral training, but can be done by Christ-followers and resources existing within the people group.

**Unreached:** No indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate numbers and resources to evangelize their people group without outside assistance.

**Frontier:** subset of Unreached that have virtually no followers of Jesus and no known movements to Christ, and still needing pioneer cross-cultural workers

**Unengaged:** subset of Unreached and Frontier that have no known onsite workers focused on starting reproducing churches and movements.
