Furthermore, if cases are limited to one area, just that area may be raised to a Caution and Warning level.

<sup>\*2.</sup> Requests for closure of "certain industry" types, will be based on the previous prefectural cases of infection transmission and national policy.

<sup>\*3.</sup> In regard to prefectural schools, the decision to close schools will be made by the Prefectural Board of Education. The Prefectural BOE has established standards to close schools based on the spread of infection (within the jurisdiction of the local Health Department) and MEXT's 「学校における新型コロナウイルス感染症に関する衛生管理マニュアル」(School Hygiene Management Manual for Novel Coronavirus).
