An abstract of at least 150 words should accompany the article. **All manuscripts must be anonymous, with no reference to the author appearing in the text or notes, and will be refereed by experts in the field.**

For standard titles and abbreviations of ancient sources, the author should consult LJS⁹, OLD, and OCD³. For bibliographical citations, the author must follow the author-date format; the format may be found in the style-sheet in *TAPA*.
