SPRINGFIELD, Mass. (January 1, 2007) – Since the first Smith & Wesson® Model 29 appeared in 1957, the powerful handgun experienced a meteoric rise to legendary status as tales of its size and stopping power spread over the world. Whether it was the revolver used by shooting sports legend and author Elmer Keith or the one Clint Eastwood toted on the silver screen as “Dirty Harry,” the Model 29 came to personify the Smith & Wesson image. Once again, shooters and collectors alike can delight in owning a Model 29 as it is being reissued in an engraved model as part of the Smith & Wesson Classics line.

This six-shot handgun chambered in .44 Magnum® is made of carbon steel and weighs 48.5 ounces. A red ramp front sight and an adjustable white outline rear sight are standard on the revolver's 6-½-inch barrel. With an overall length of 12 inches, the Model 29 features an old style thumbpiece, African Cocobolo wood grips and is available with either a blue or nickel finish. Unique machine engraving sets this Model 29 apart with the traditional Smith & Wesson logo on the four-screw side plate and decorative scrolling down the length of the barrel. This vintage revolver is destined to be as valuable to collectors as it is to serious shooters.

The time-tested Model 29 is standard with an authentic square-butt frame and serrated trigger and is shipped in a glass-top wooden presentation case. Inside the case, the Model 29 is complete with a traditional cleaning rod, brush and replica screwdriver. Like the originals, this Smith & Wesson Classics Model 29 has the same duty-proven configuration and conforms to the standards of accuracy and dependability that made Smith & Wesson and the Model 29 the legends they are today.

The Smith & Wesson lifetime service policy is standard with each revolver.
