


COME EXPLORE ALABAMA'S DELTA

Where the Mobile, Spanish, Tensaw, Appalachee and Blakeley rivers flow into Mobile Bay stands an incredible new facility for outdoor recreation, conservation and land stewardship in Alabama: 5 Rivers. It's the ultimate place to begin your adventure into over 250,000 acres of scenic waterways, woods and wetlands. Or, simply soak up the natural beauty and incredible history of the region with plenty to do and see at the facility itself.



ALABAMA'S DELTA READY FOR YOU TO EXPLORE.



With the 4th highest plant and animal diversity in the U.S., including the occasional alligator, Alabama is a true nature-lover's paradise - the Delta is no exception. From Hernando DeSoto to the famous naturalist William Bartram, explorers have been drawn to these wilds for centuries. As you navigate through stands of moss-covered swamp cypress and experience the incredible wildlife found here, you might be touched by the same sense of wonder that they felt.

A DRIFTER'S PARADISE The call of the water is strong at 5 Rivers. Whether you're a paddling enthusiast or prefer to explore Alabama's coastal waters by powerboat, you will love the facilities available to you. Canoeists and kayakers can put in and take out from our floating dock at Bartram's Landing – the new terminus of the legendary Bartram Canoe Trail. This free pier is ADA-compliant and also features a retail store for sales and rentals. A separate powerboat landing accommodates boats up to 30'. Delta boat tours and airboat tours of the area are also available for charter from this facility.


