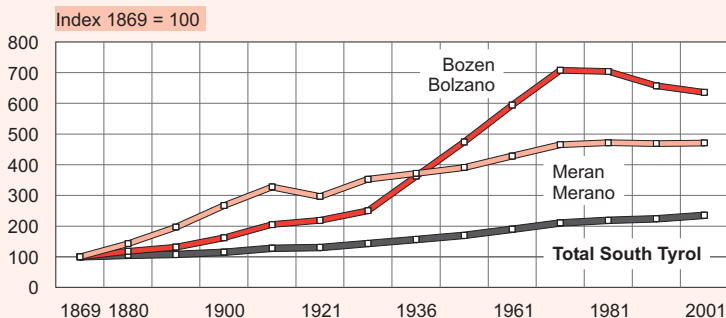

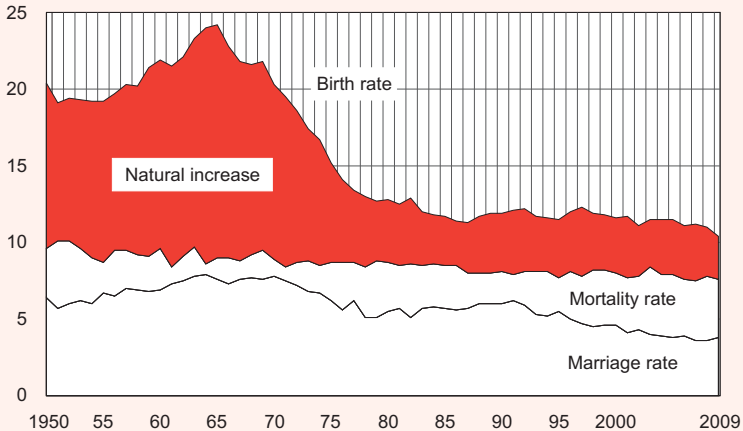

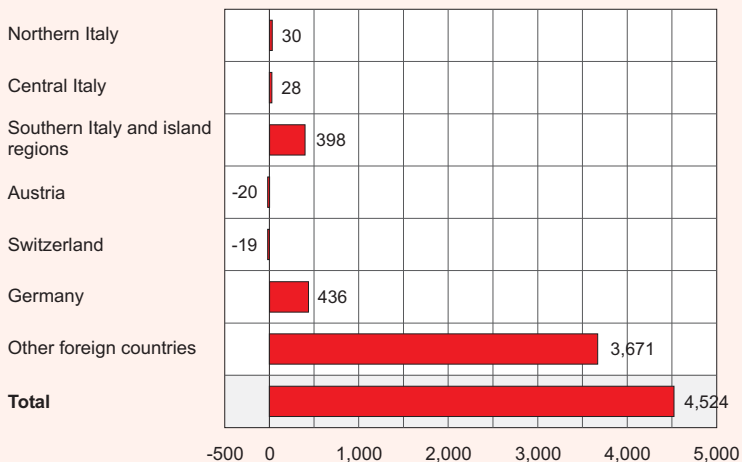
**Migration balance by source and destination area - 2007**

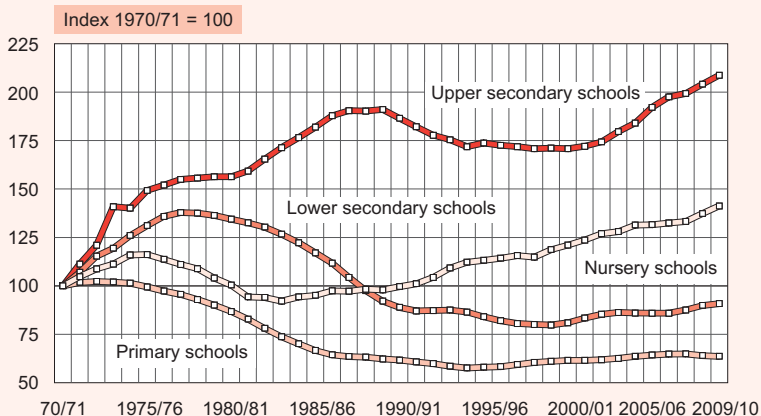

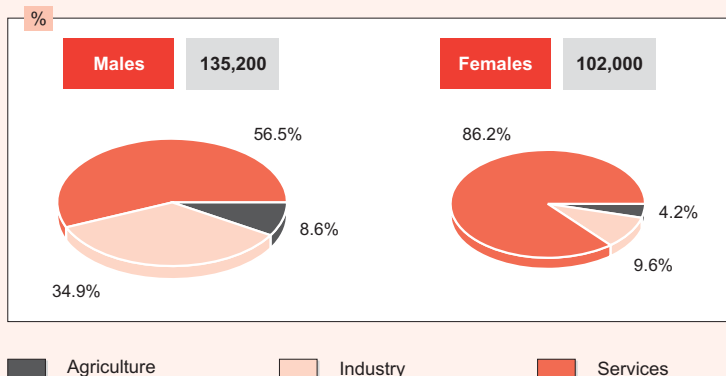

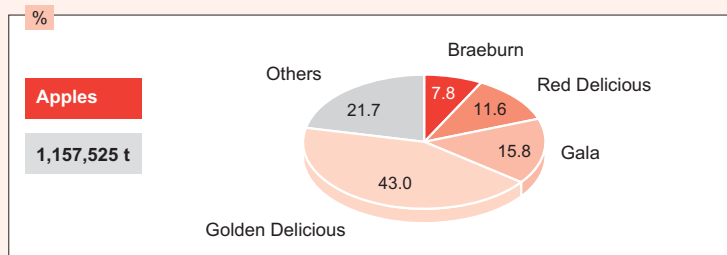

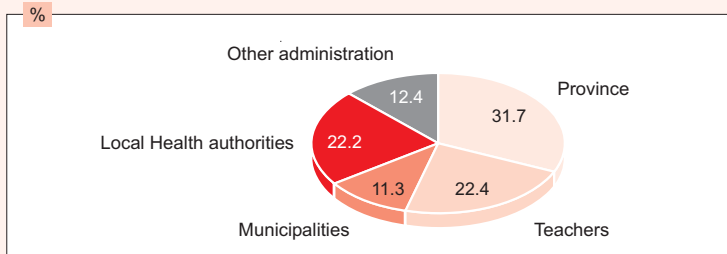
