# Tampere in brief

- In 1779 Tampere received its city rights from King Gustaf III of Sweden and Finland
- The city is located on an isthmus between two lakes Näsijärvi and Pyhäjärvi, which are connected by Tammerkoski rapids
- Inhabitants 31.12.2007
  - in Tampere 207 866
    - Age structure: Ages      0–15: 15 %  
   16–64: 69 %  
   65– : 16 %
  - in Tampere Central region 341 168
- The third biggest city in Finland, the biggest inland city in the Nordic countries
- Surface area 688 km<sup>2</sup>: land area 523.4 and water area 164.6 km<sup>2</sup>
- Population density 397 people/km<sup>2</sup>
- Climate:
  - Four seasons, temperature between –25 to +30 degrees Celsius (in the winter and in the summer)

- Jobs: 111 216 (2005): industry 20 %, energy-, water supply and sewerage & construction 6 %, trading, accommodation & nutrition 15.4 % and services 50 %

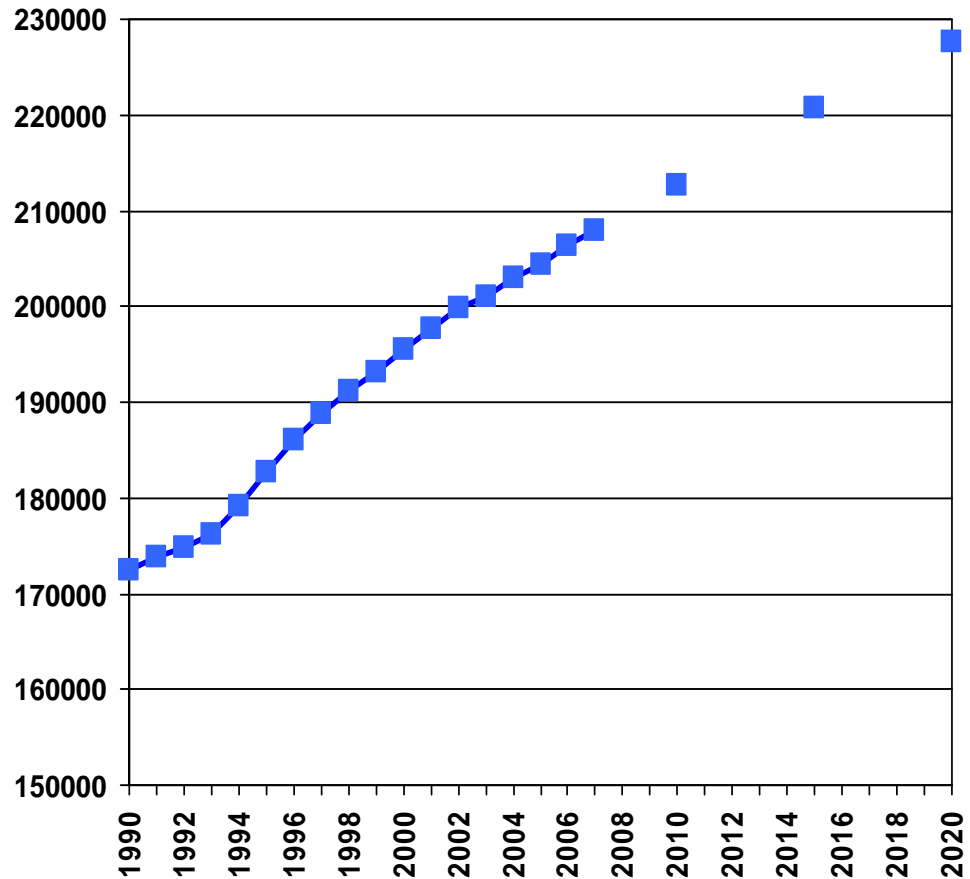

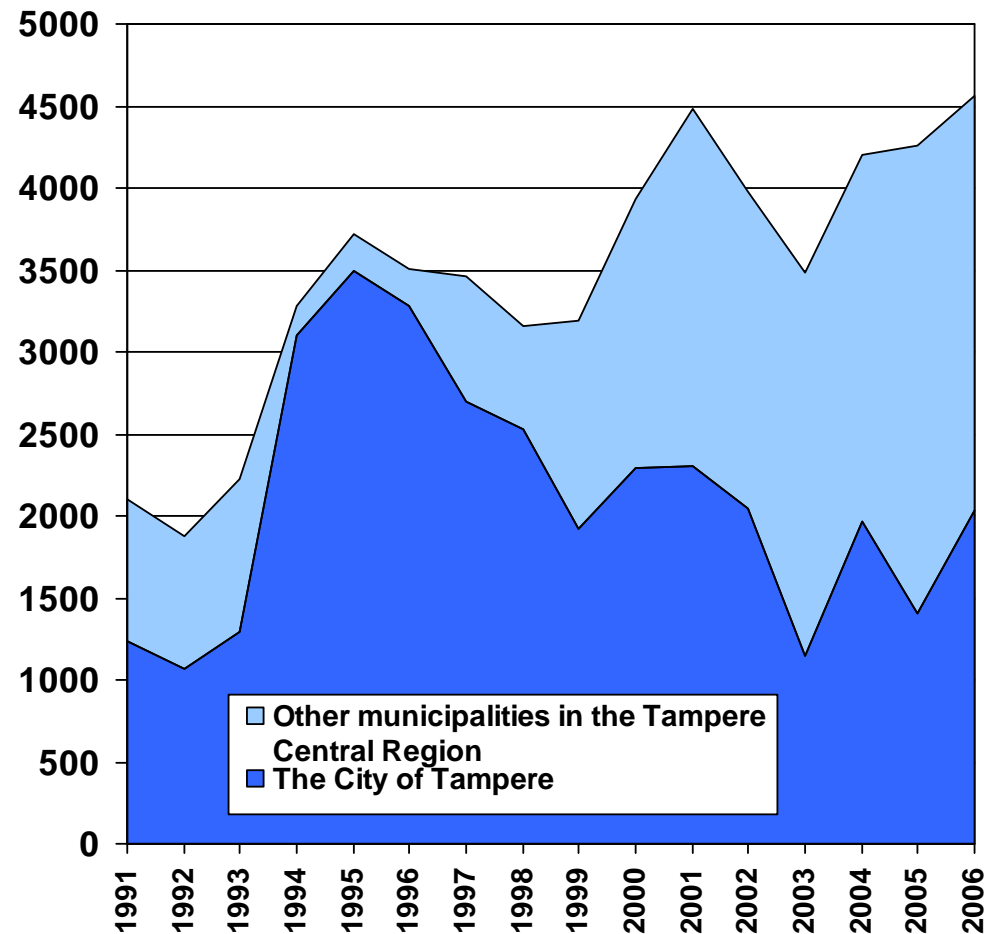

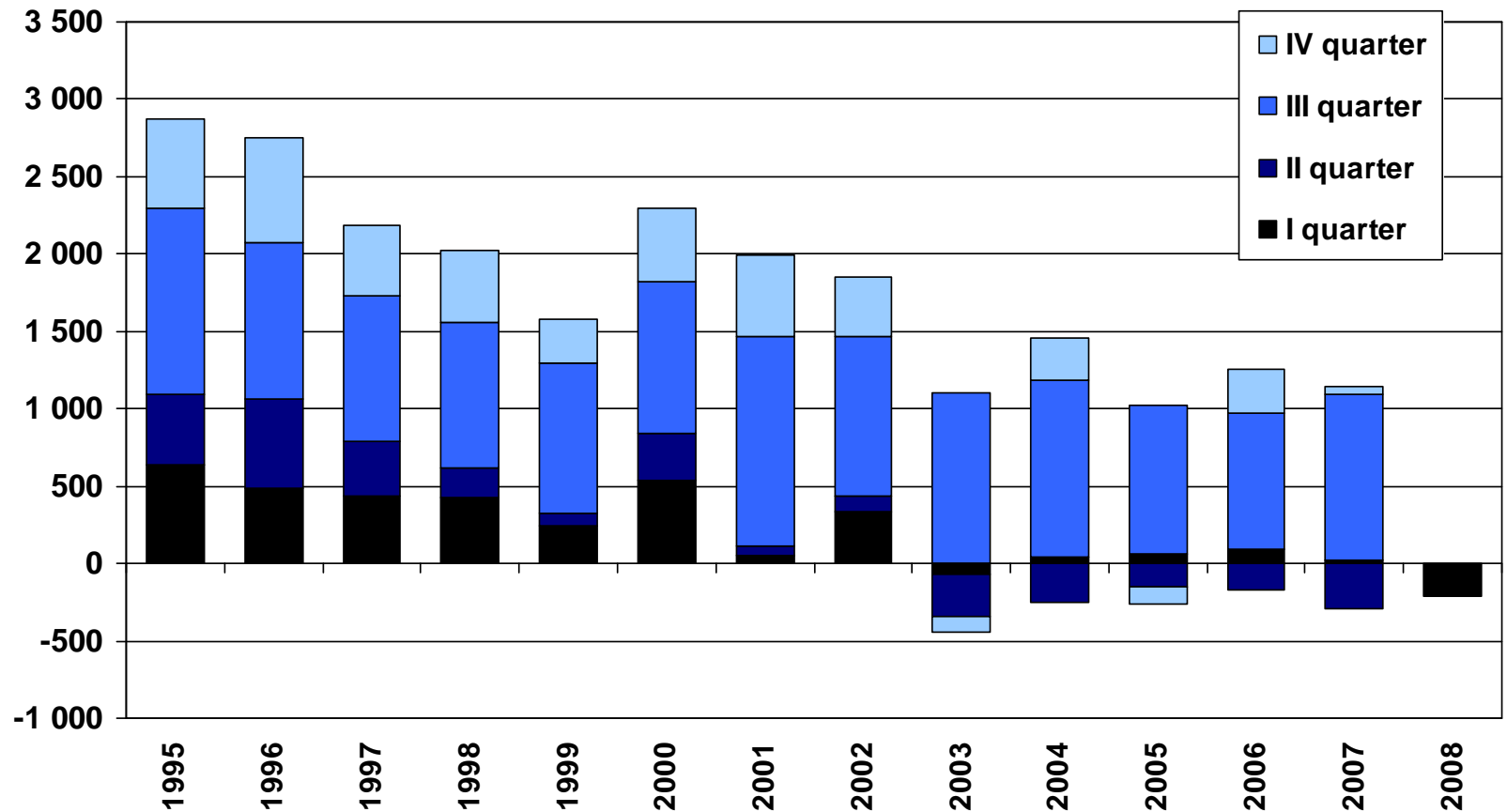

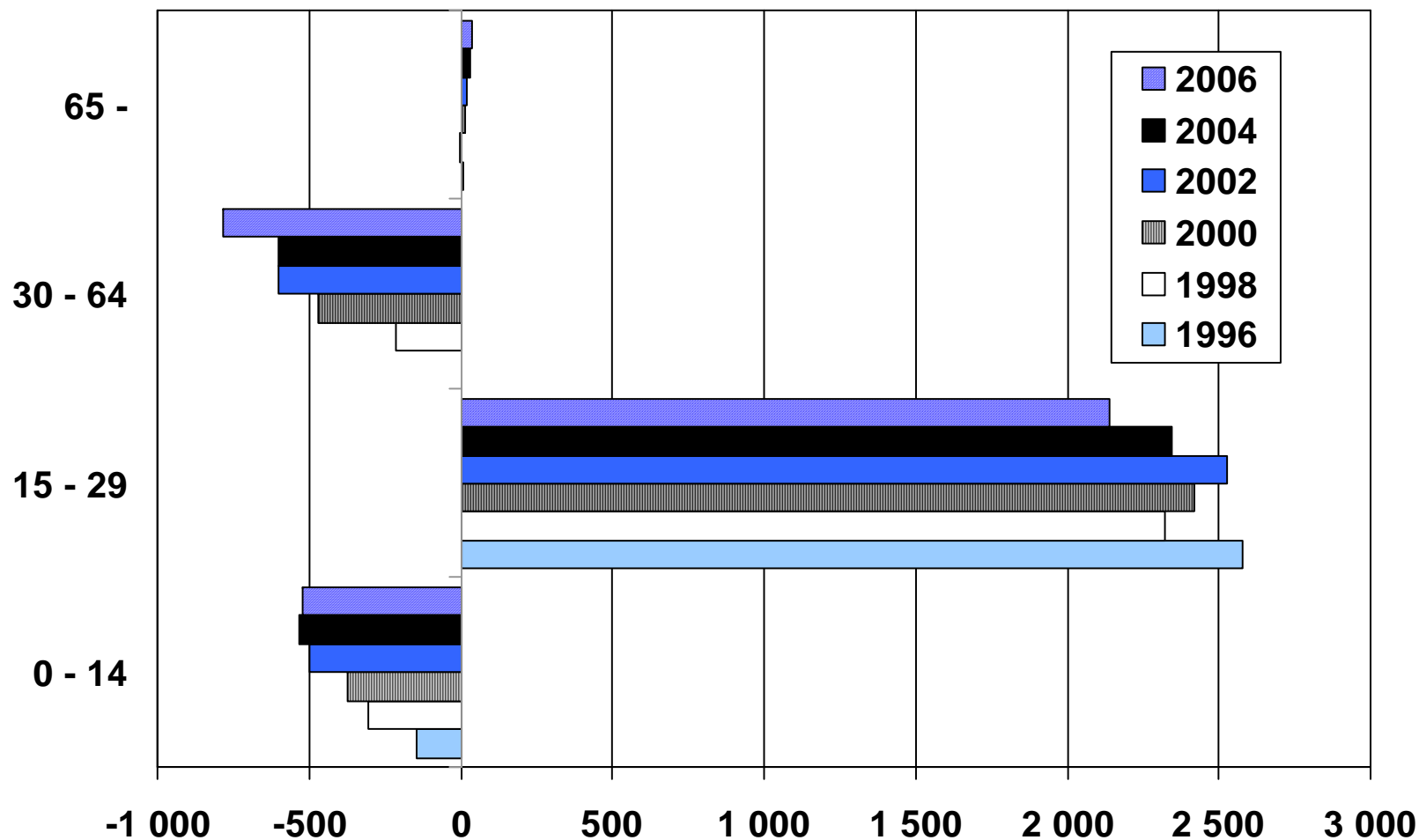
# Migration, 1995–2008 (quarter of a year)

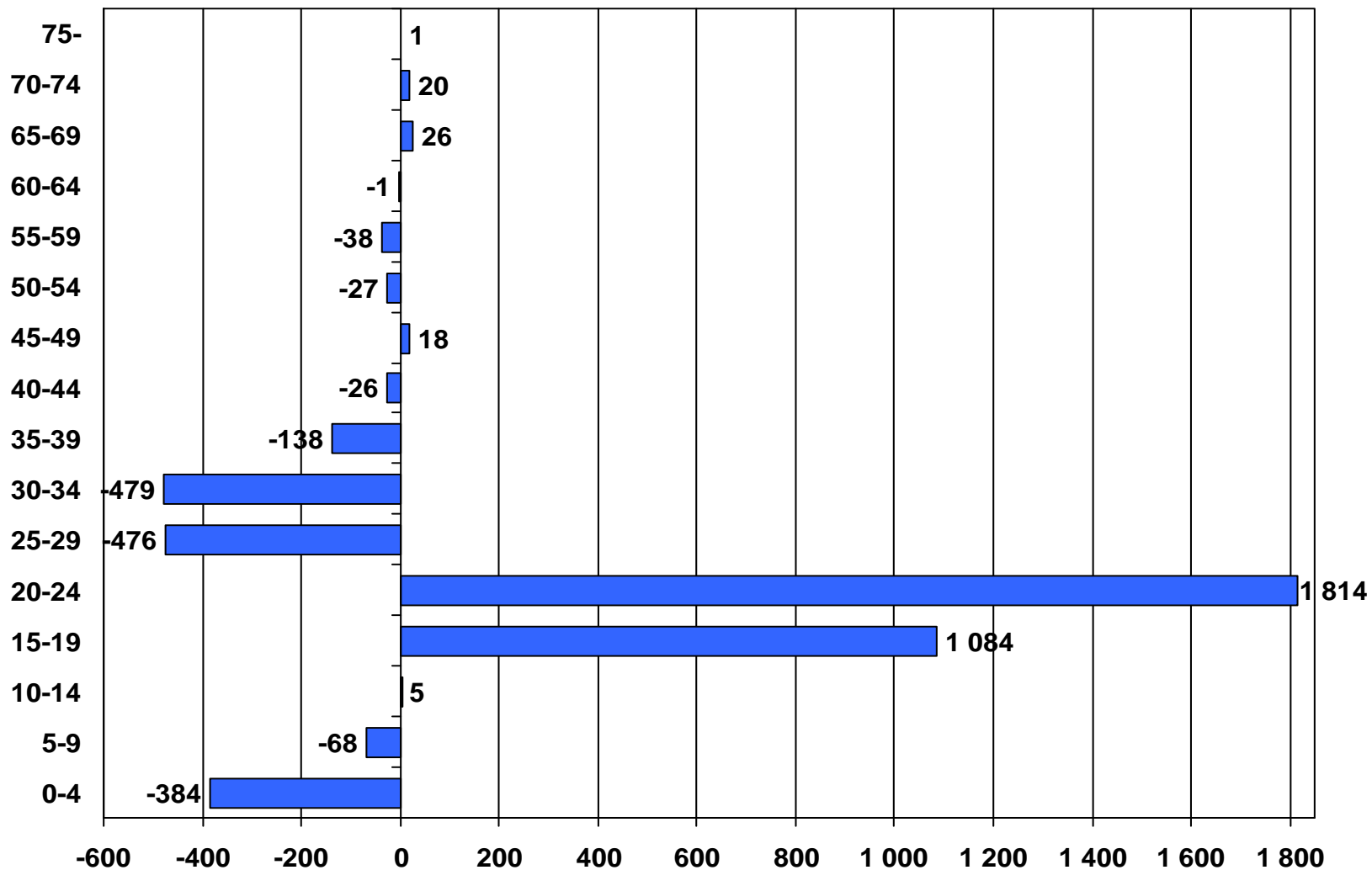
# Net migration by age, 1996–2006

# Net migration by age, 2006

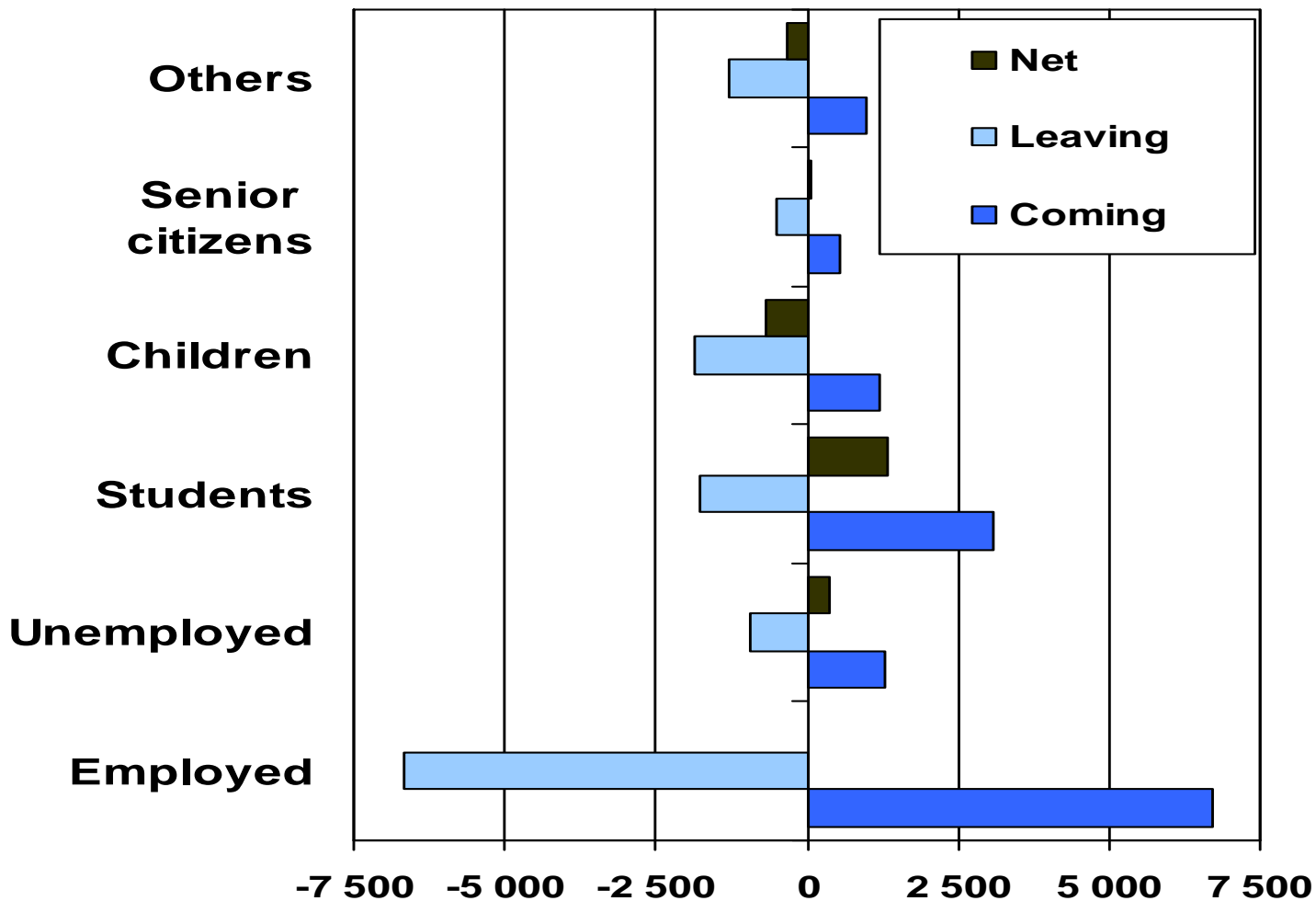

# Migration by field of activity, 2005

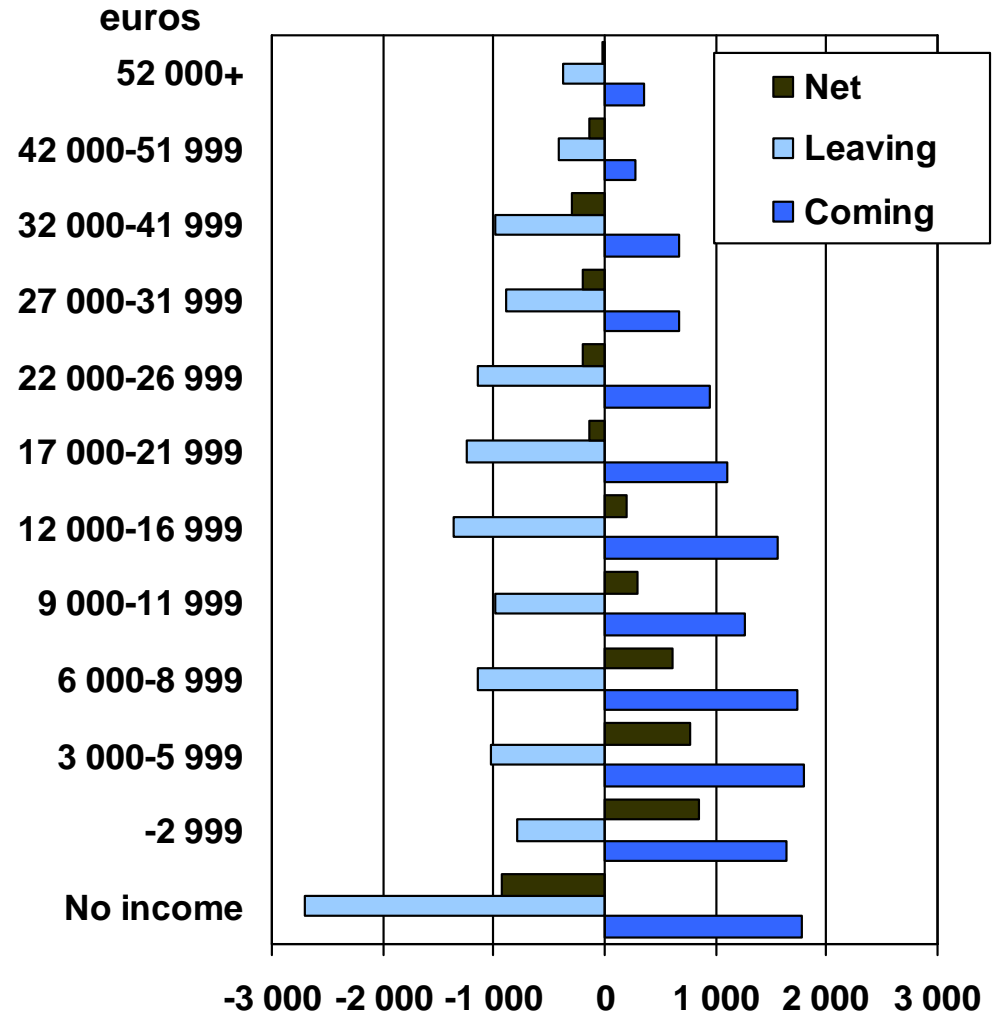

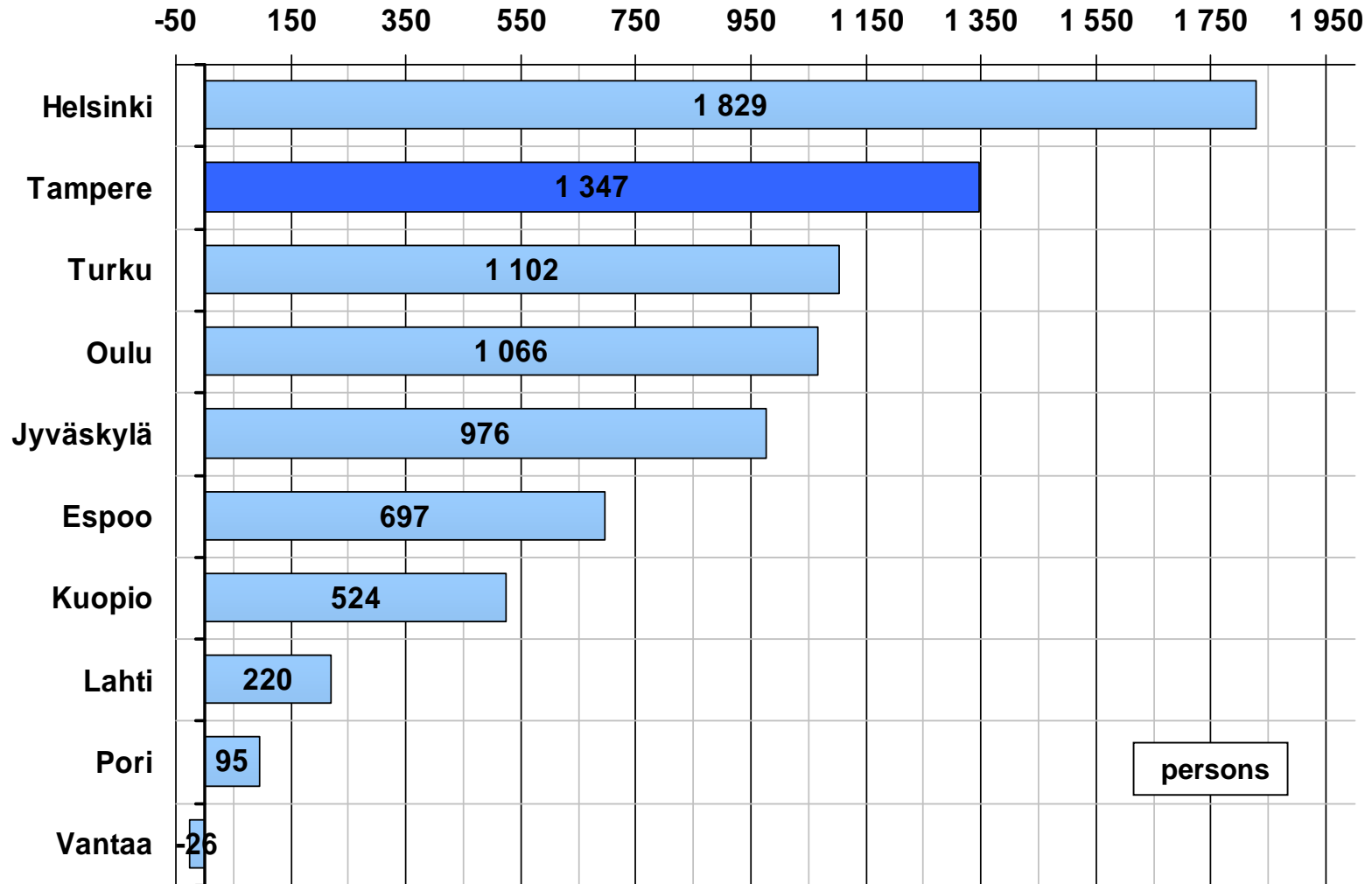

# Net migration of students, 2005

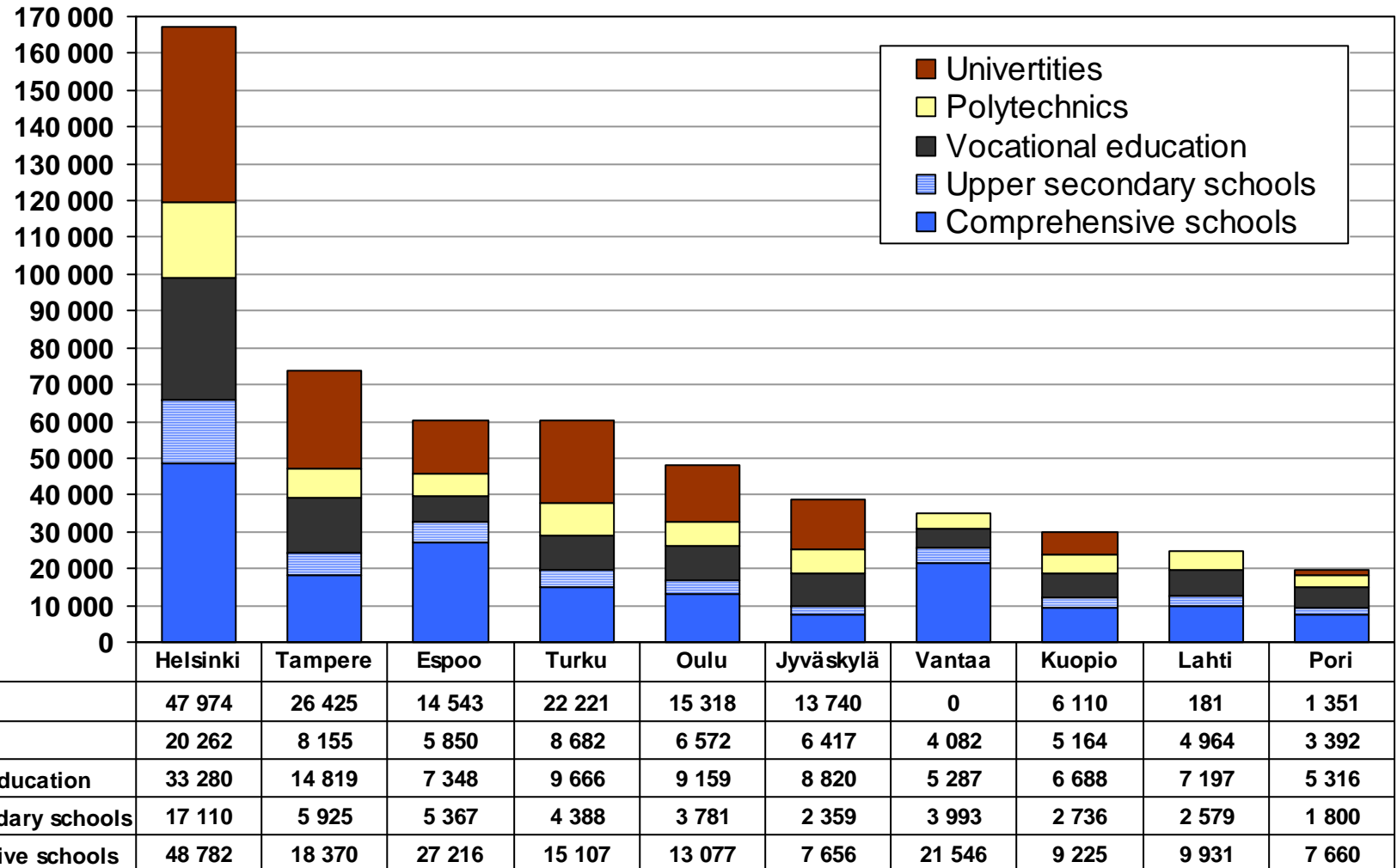
10 largest cities in Finland

# Students in the major cities, 2006

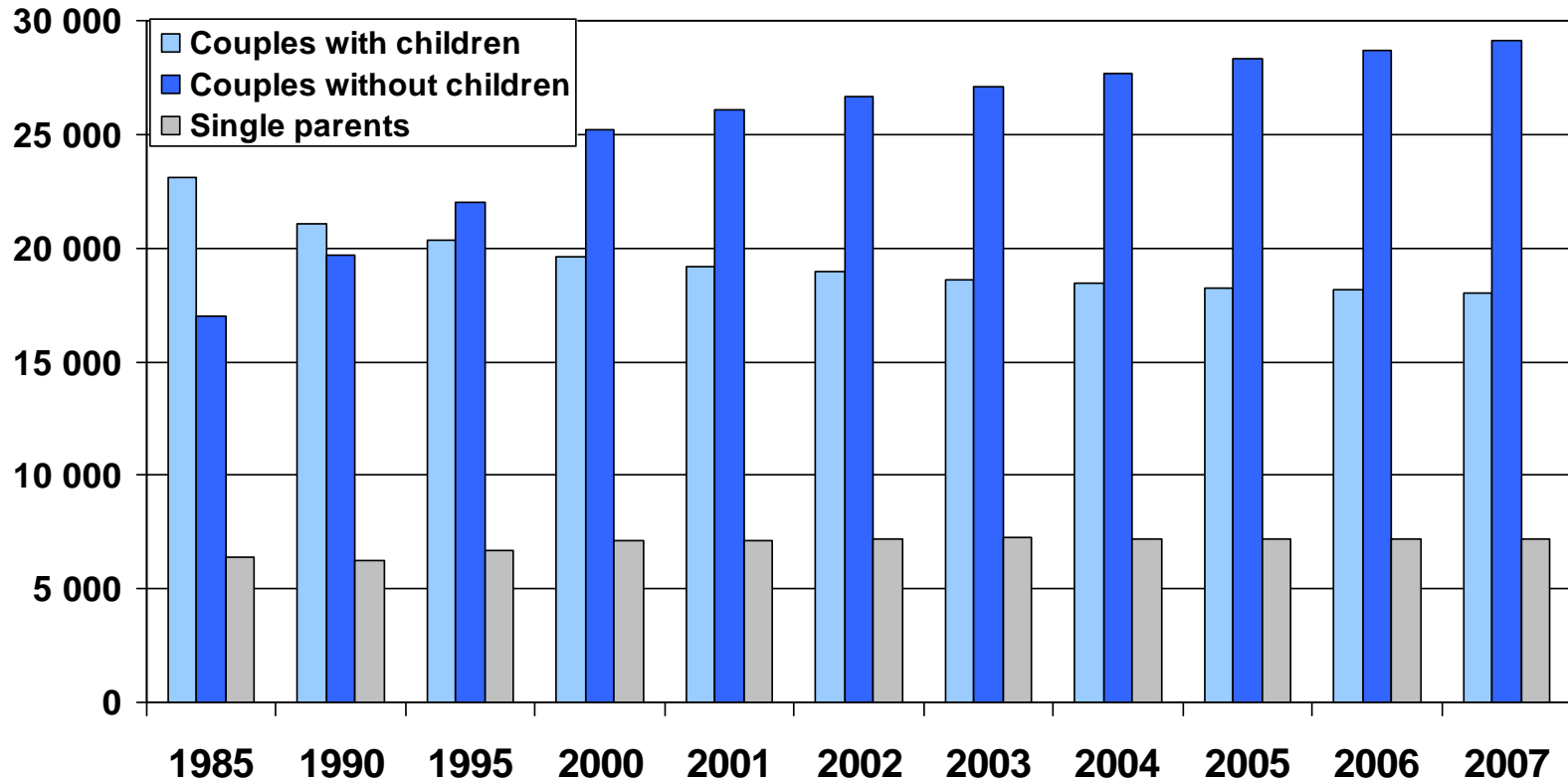

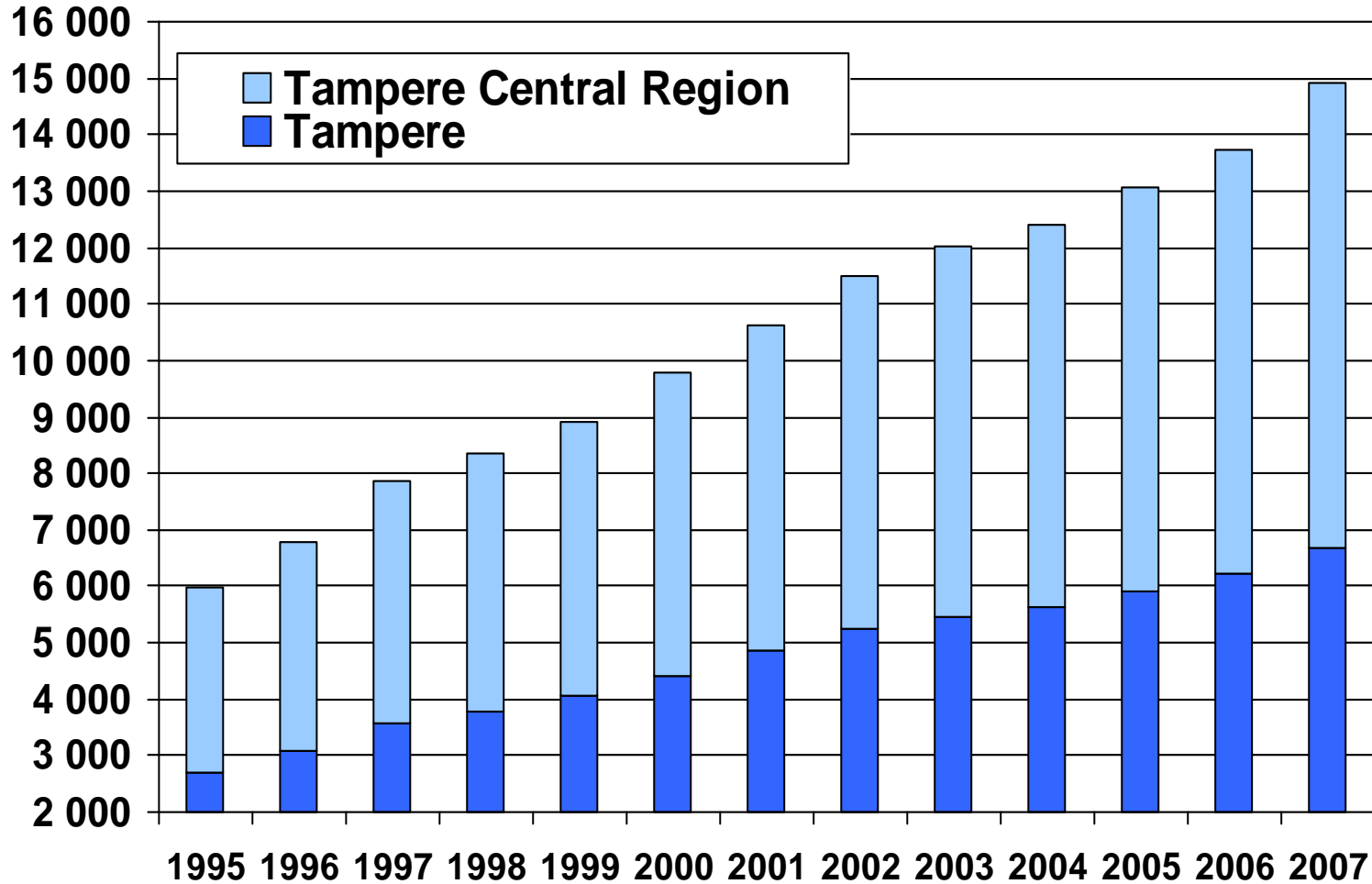
# Families by family type, 1985–2007

At year-end 2007 53.6% of the families were childless.





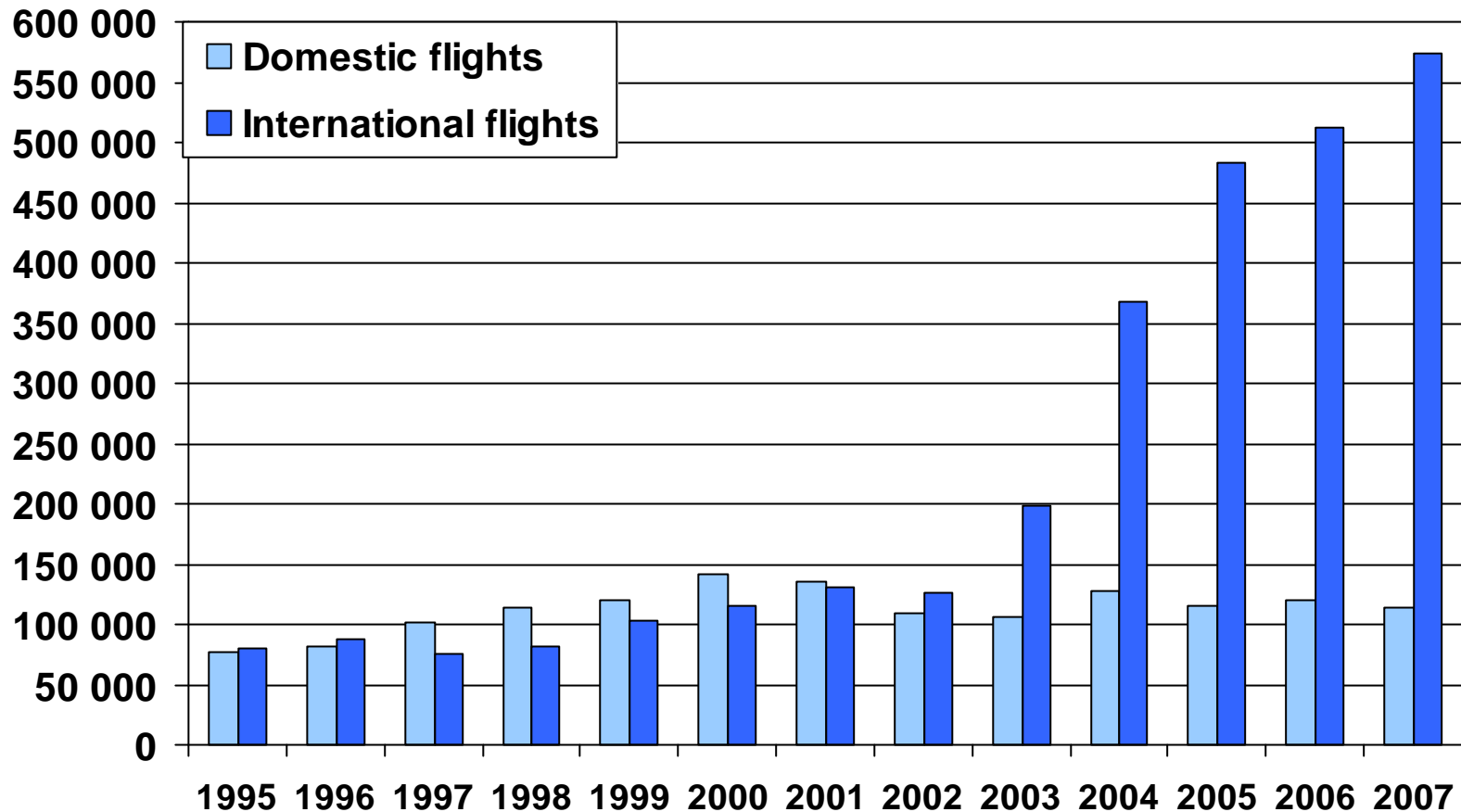
# Foreign citizens, 1995–2007

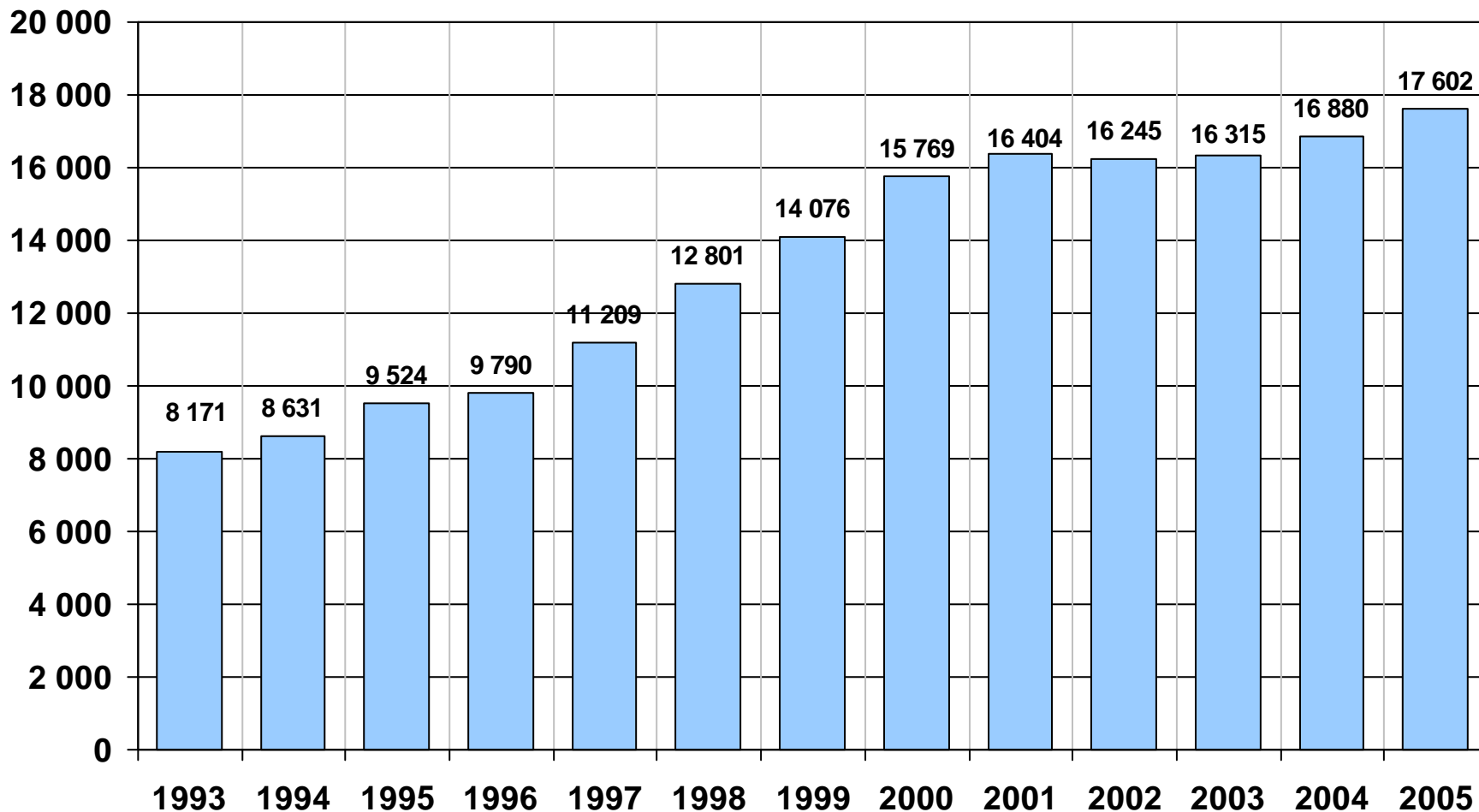
# Passengers at the Tampere-Pirkkala Airport 1995–2007

# Jobs in ITC Sector, 1993–2005

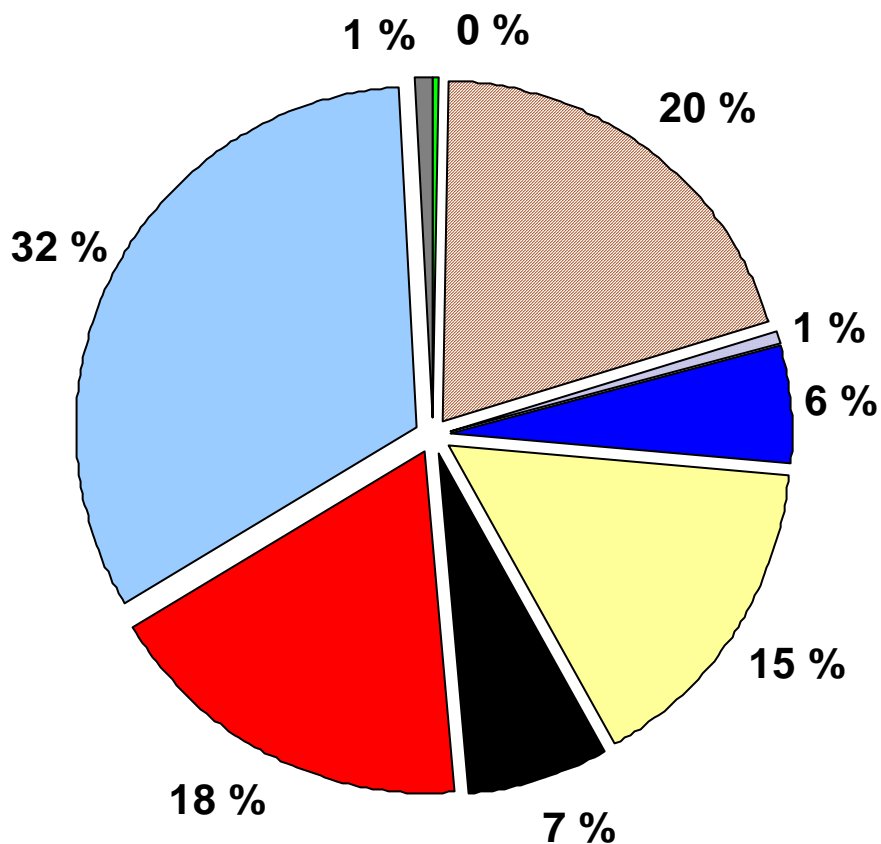

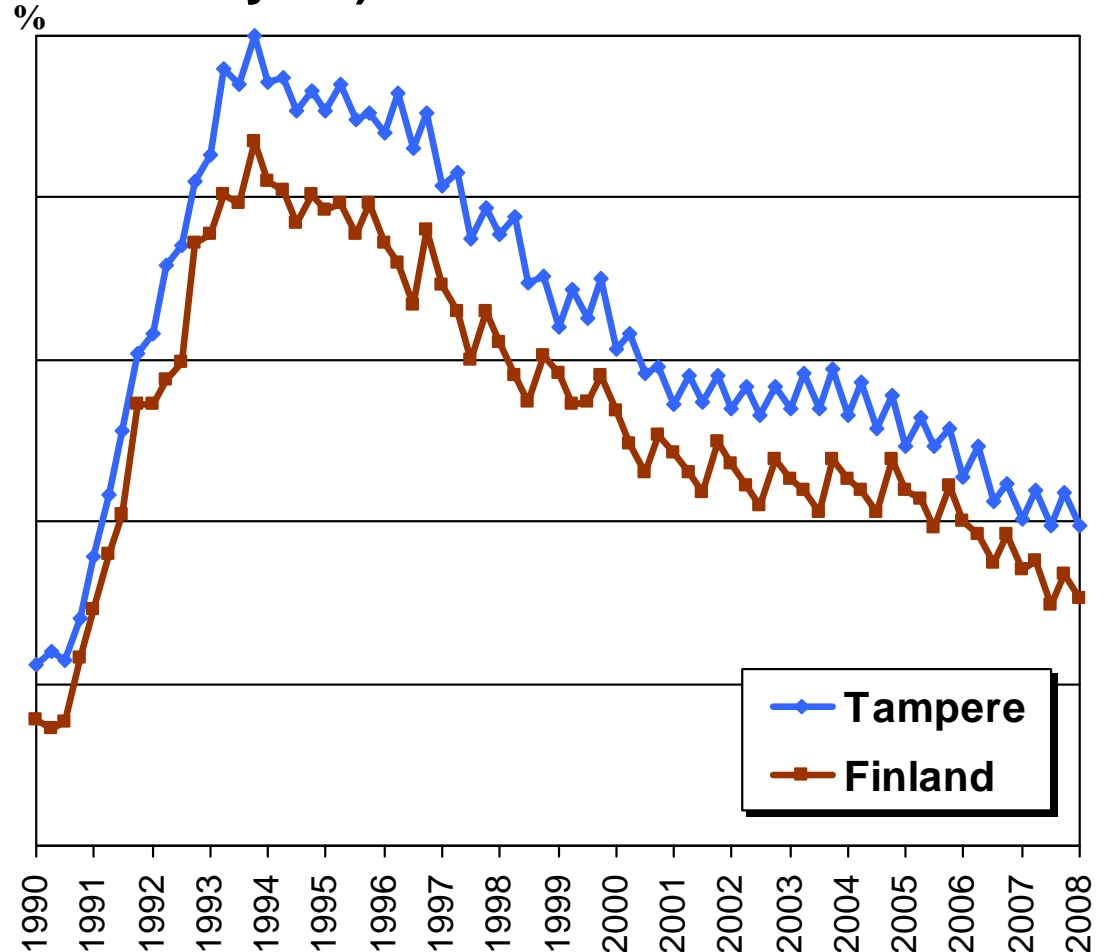

  - **1 093** young persons (15-24 years old)

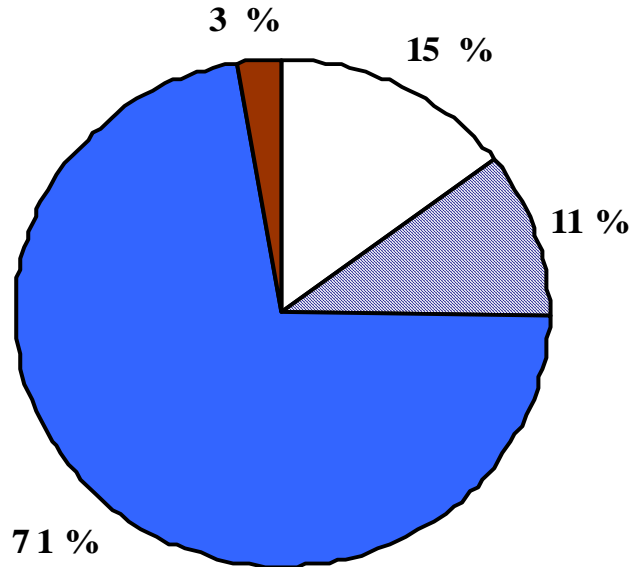

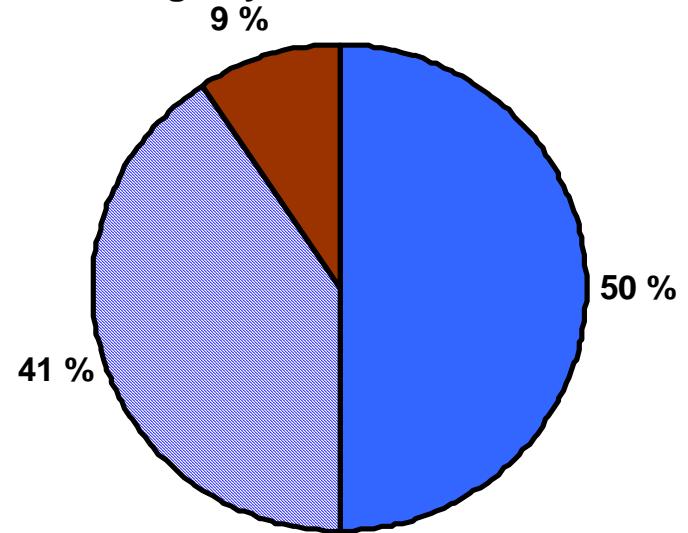

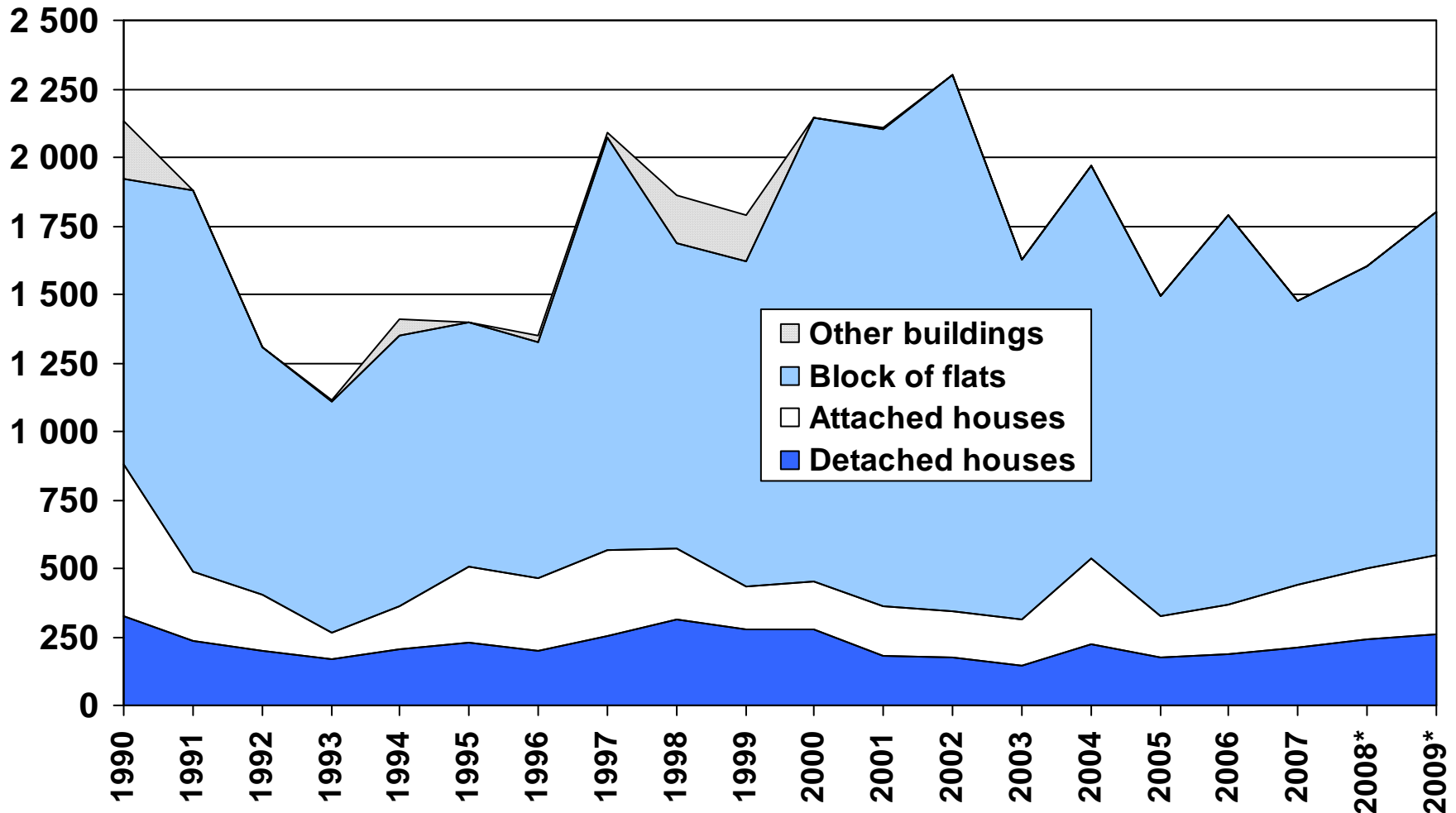

# Completed dwellings by type of building, 1990–2009\*

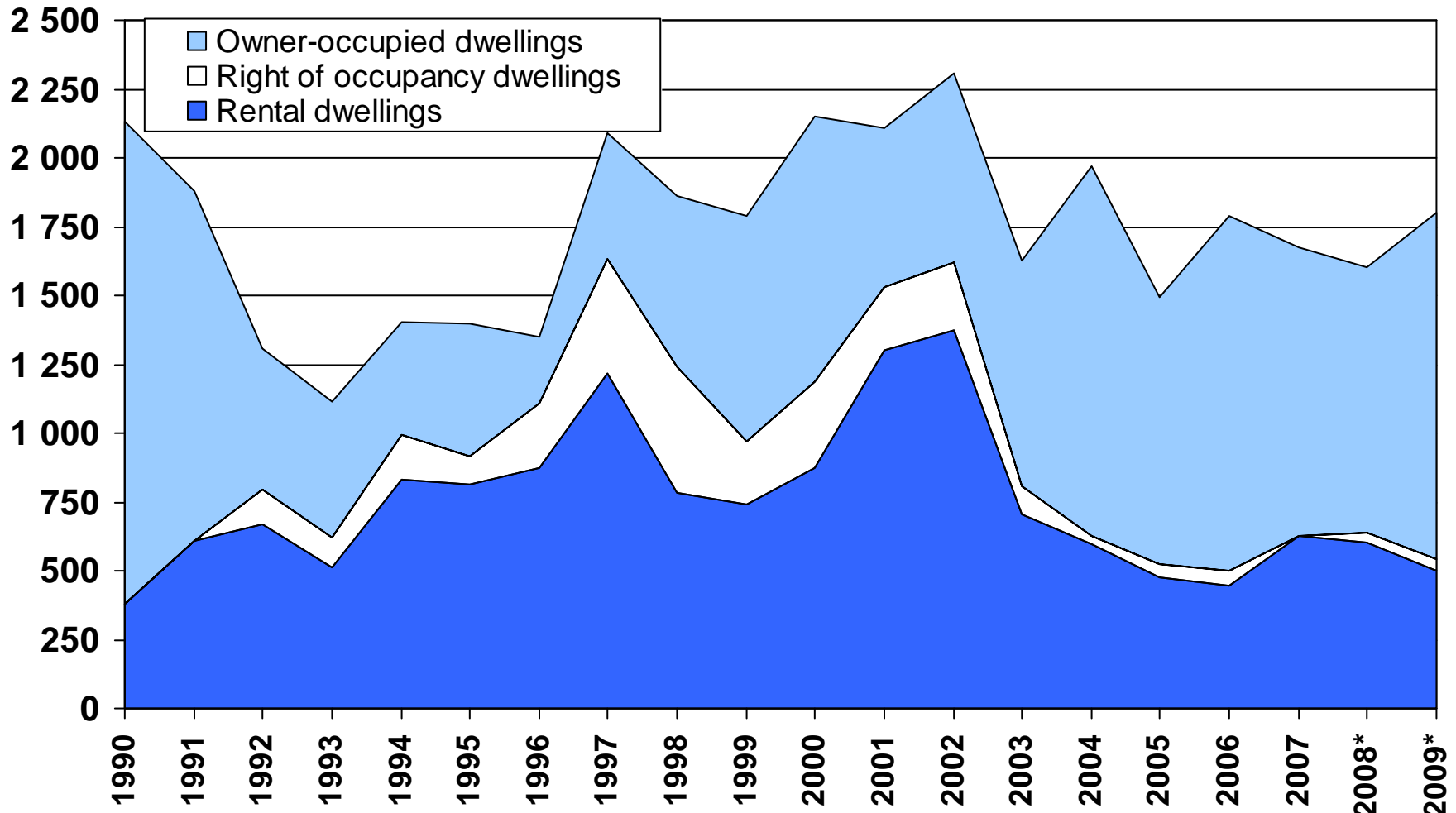

# Completed dwellings by type of tenure status, 1990–2009\*



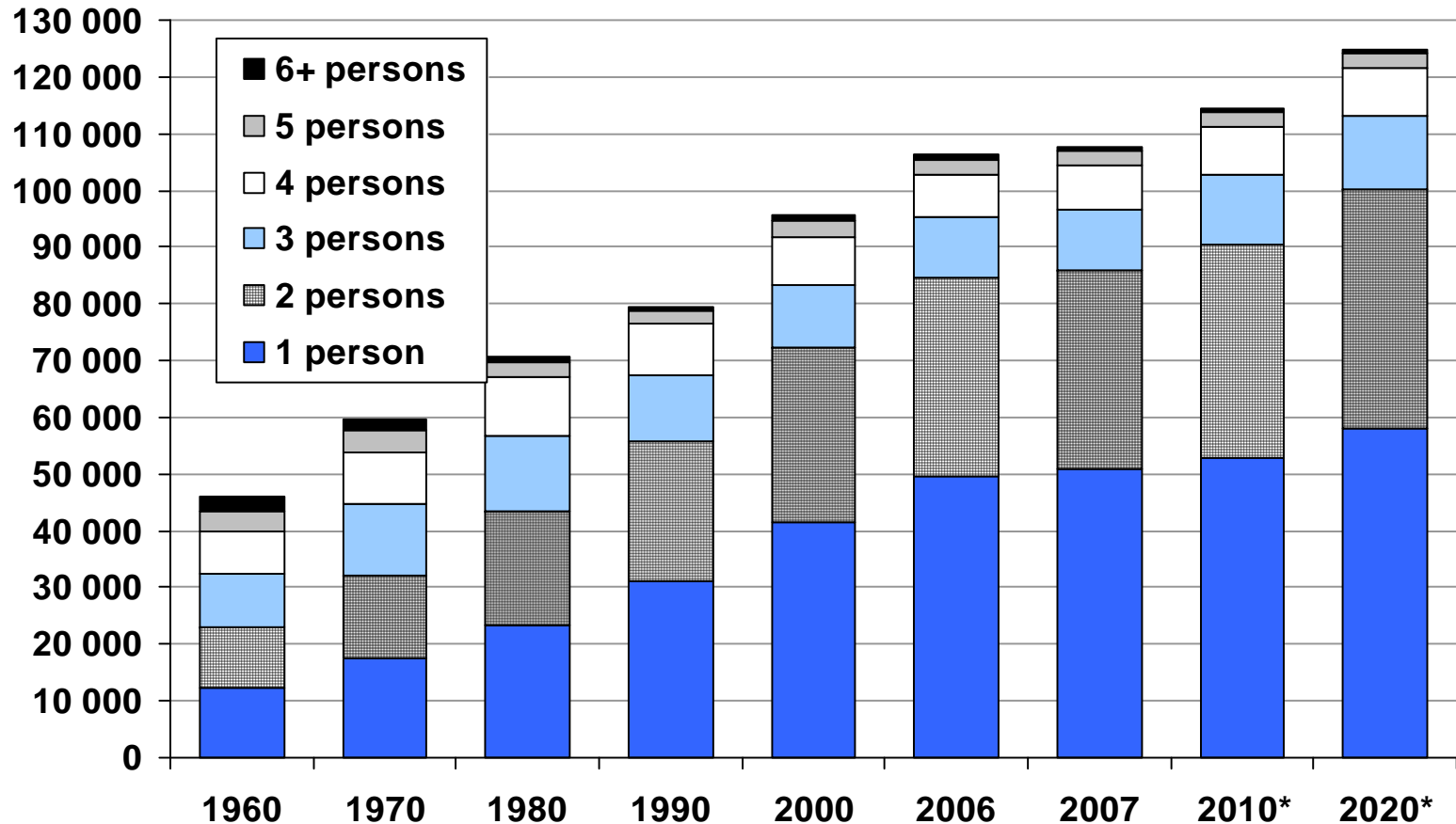

Household-dwelling units in total 107 682 (at year-end 2007), of which 47 % with one occupant only. Average size of a household-dwelling unit 1.8 persons.



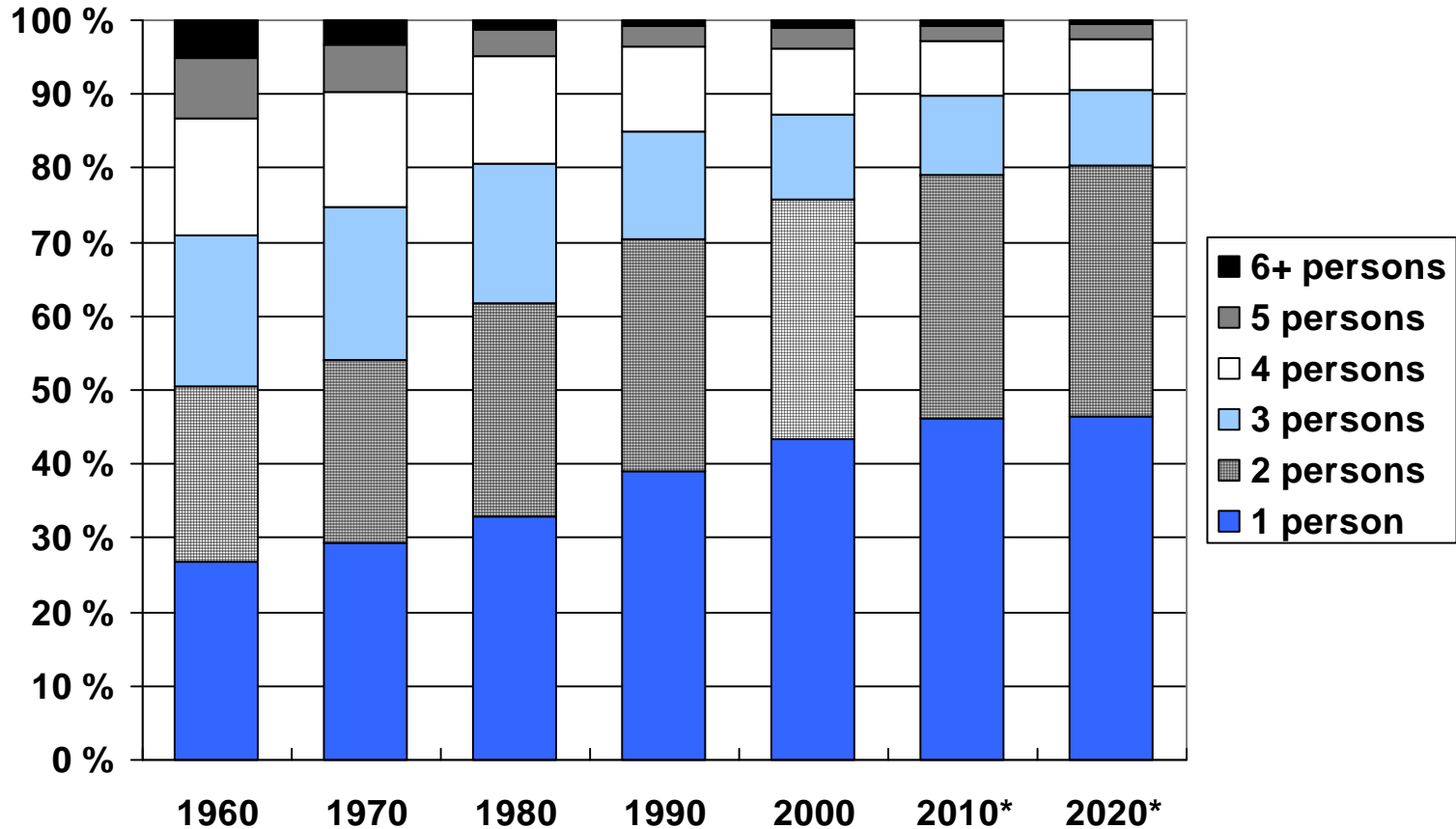

Household-dwelling units in total 107 682 (at year-end 2007), of which 47 % with one occupant only. Average size of a household-dwelling unit 1.8 persons.

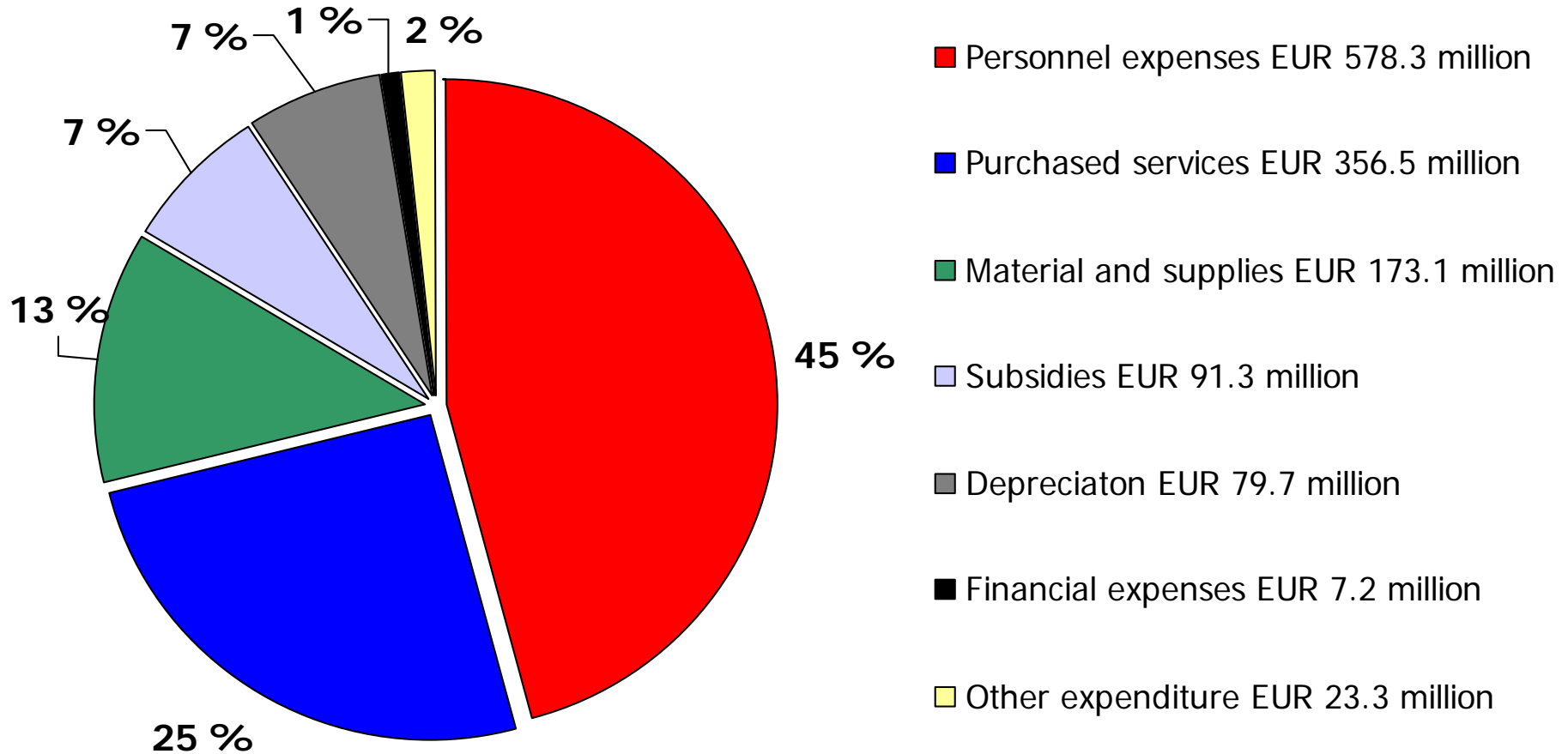

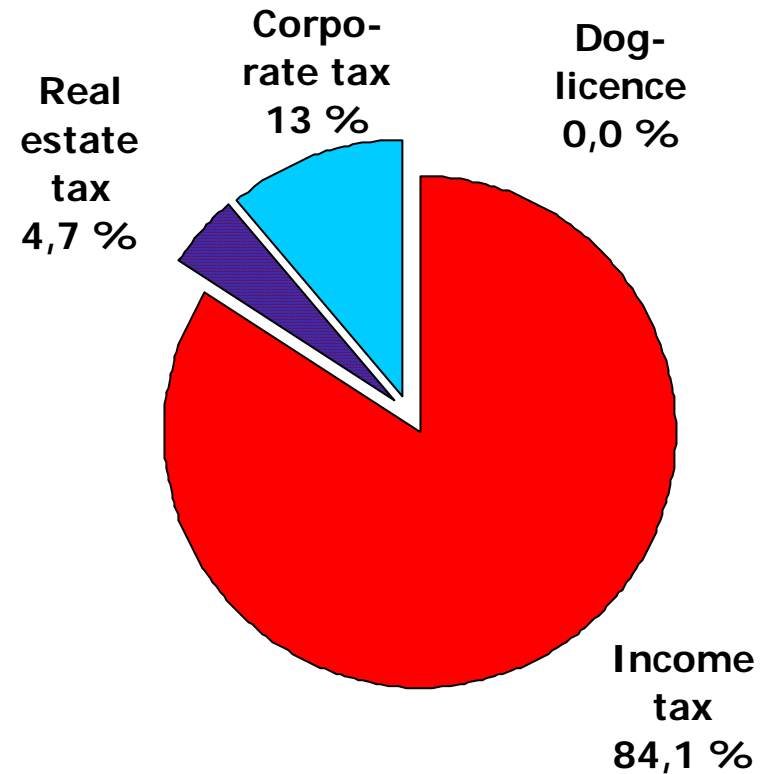

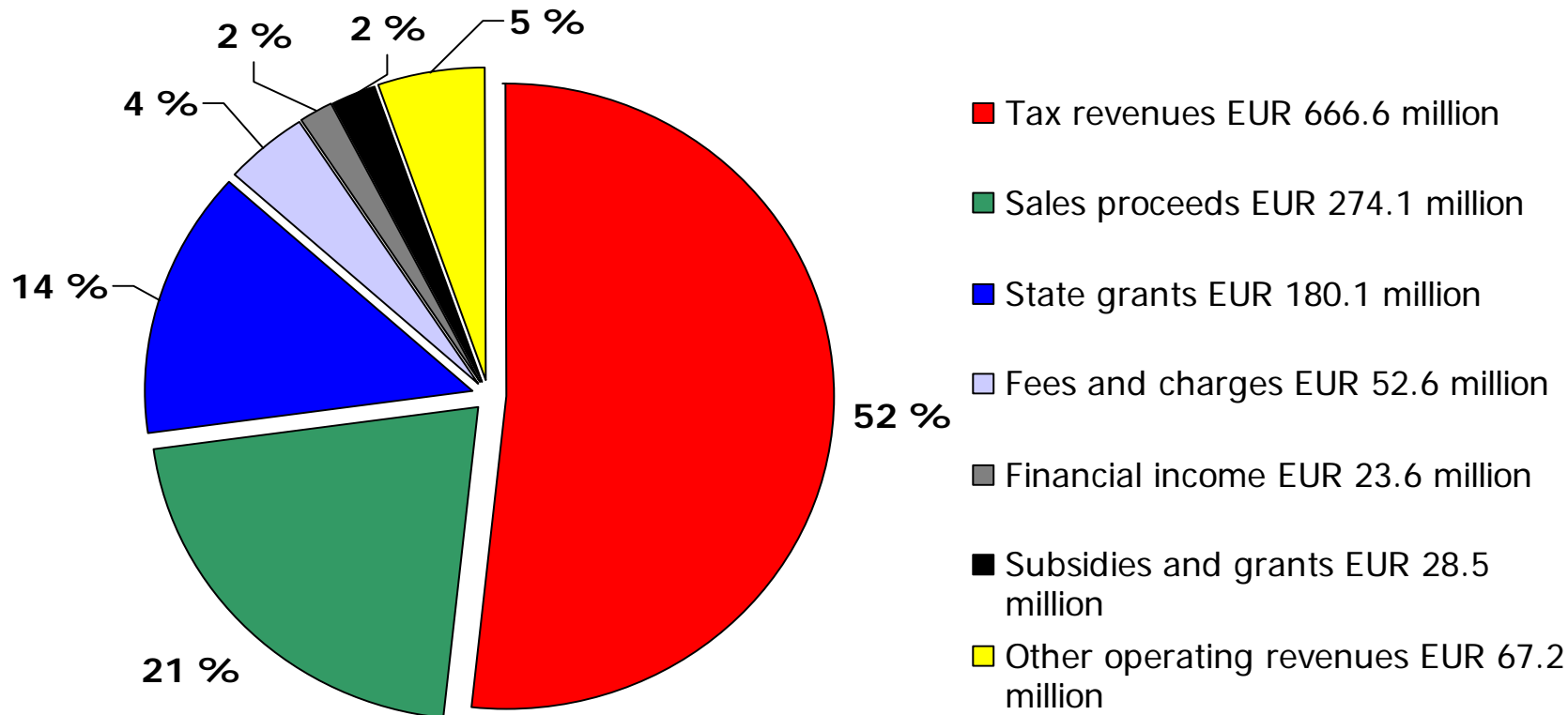

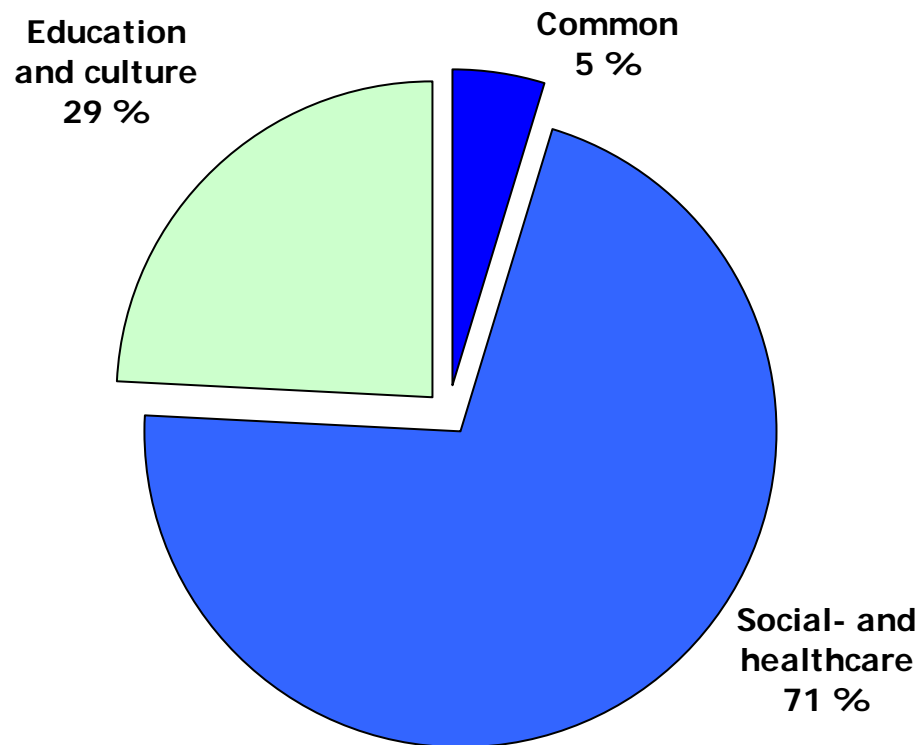

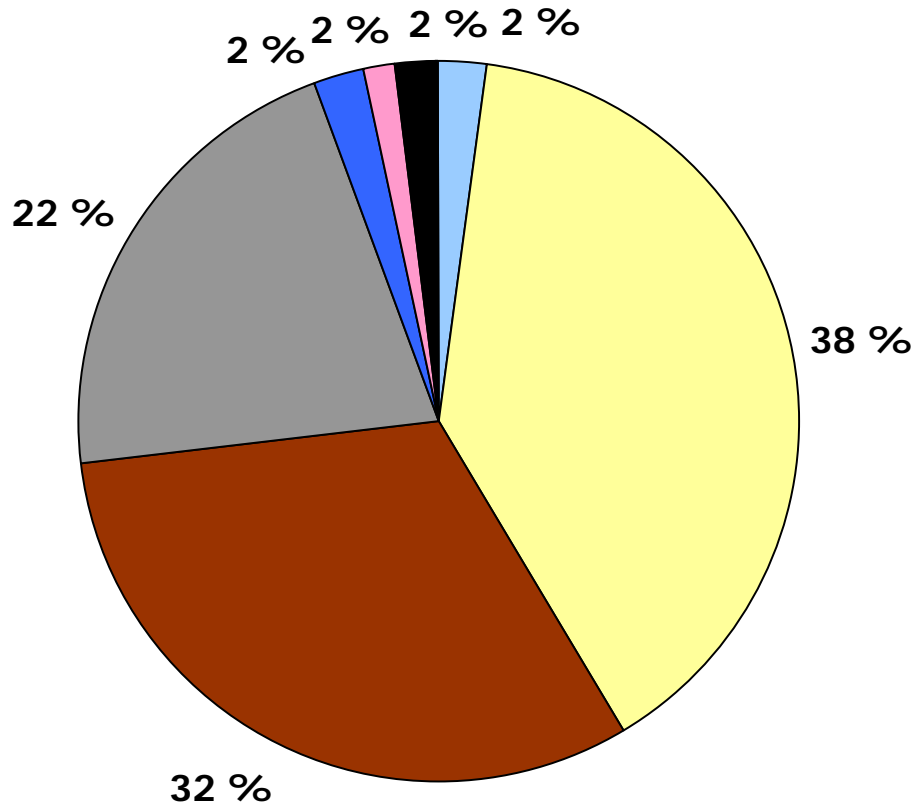

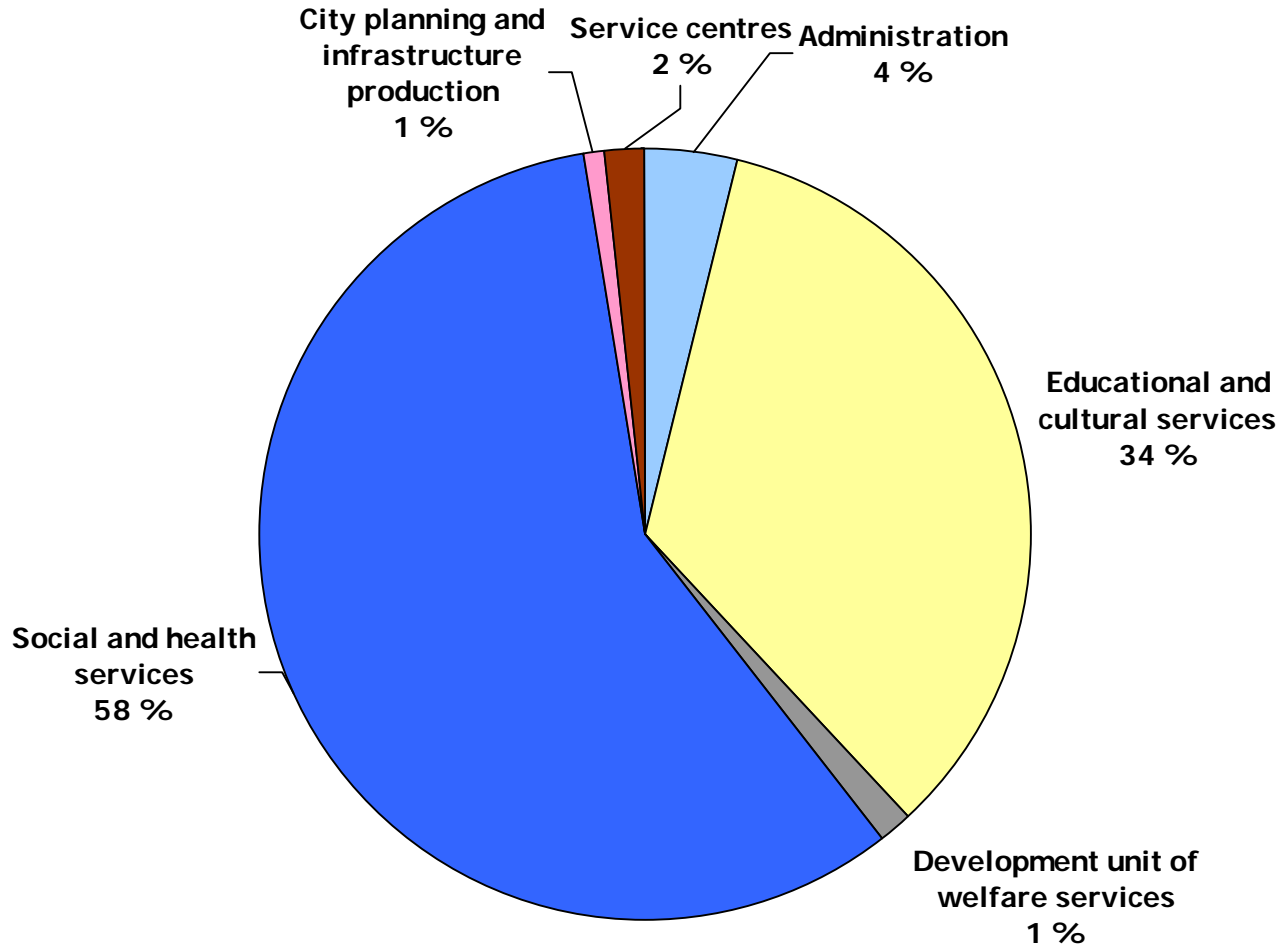
