



**Cars in the EU are on average 8.2 years old**

➔ **Car Fleet\* by Age | 2008**



## The five largest markets account for 68% of the EU fleet


### ➔ Car Fleet by country (in units and % share) | 2008




➔ Car Fleet Growth (% change) | 1996-2008


## The EU vehicle fleet composition


### ➔ EU Fleet by Fuel Type | 2008


