TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS 2004-2009

The Division of Police experienced a significant decline in reported traffic accidents in 2009.

The summary report to the left provides insight into the trend.

EMERGENCY CALLS RECEIVED AND DISPATCHED BY THE CLEVELAND DIVISION OF POLICE 2001-2009

The statistics reflect Incoming Calls for service via 9-1-1 or 216-621-1234 to the City of Cleveland Bureau of Communications and Incidents Dispatched by the Cleveland Division of Police. Calls for service are not prioritized until dispatch and therefore, only total Incoming Calls are shown. When a call is dispatched for Police it is prioritized on a scale of 1 to 4 with 1 being the highest priority for service.

The difference in Incoming Calls and Incidents Dispatched varies widely for numerous reasons. For example, there may be multiple calls for service at the scene of a highway accident, calls may be cancelled by the caller, or calls may be referred to the Divisions of Fire and EMS, other departments, and in some cases, other jurisdictions.

Incident counts are based on dispatched 9-1-1 and 216-621-1234 calls. "On-view" incidents are excluded. "On-view" incidents include those that are initiated as a result of normal patrol activities. Calls for service are not typically received in the Bureau of Communications for "on-view" incidents.
