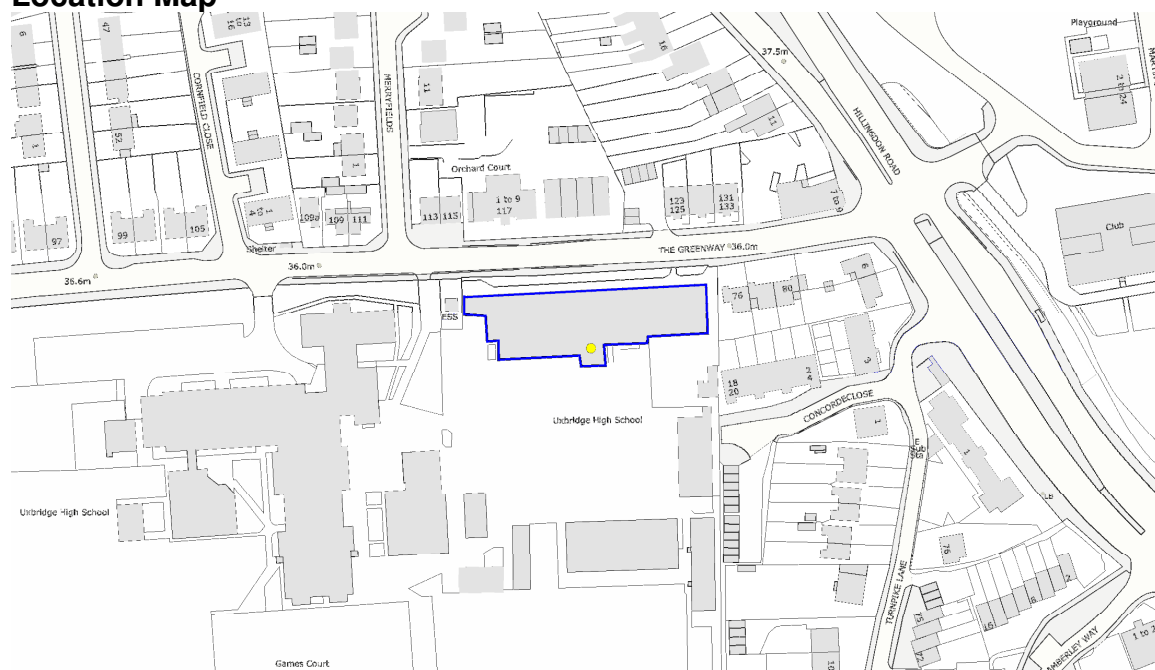


Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1907, the school was designed for the Middlesex Education Committee by their architect H G Crothall. Red brick with stone banding and dressings. Two gables with stone coping fronting The Greenway, with long arched headed windows, with key stones and decorative spandrels over. Steeply pitched tiled roof with cupola and weather vane.
Townscape: Contributes to local character
Historical: Opened in September 1907, it was the Borough's first secondary school.
