Provisional Key Census Results

The Economic Affairs Division of Treasury has released provisional key results from the 2011 Census.

The figures reveal that on Census Day (27th March 2011) the Island's resident population stood at 84,497, an increase of 5½% on the 80,058 recorded in 2006 when an Isle of Man Census was last conducted. The number of people in employment has increased by 2,349 (5.8%).

Presented together with comparable figures for 2006, the initial results are:-
