WILDERNESS FIRST RESPONDER

Dates: January 16-23, 2011

Cost: \$795.00 **Public Course Fee**
(includes meals & lodging)
\$588.00 **National Park Service Employees**

This Wilderness First Responder course will be led by instructors from Roane State Community College Continuing Healthcare Education. Meals and dorm accommodations are included in the fee and will be provided at Great Smoky Mountains Institute at Tremont. The schedule will be a full one with instruction beginning each morning at 6 AM and ending each evening at 8 PM. The curriculum will meet the Tennessee EMS standards and national standards for First Responder training while focusing on the special situations that may develop in the wilderness. Participants will be eligible for national registry and the Tennessee state testing upon completion of the program.

NOTE all participants are required to:

- **Have completed Professional Level CPR beforehand.**
- **Bring TWO sets of clothing that can be destroyed in scenario training.**
- **Bring glasses or goggles for eye protection.**
- **Bring 2 flashlight sources, one being a headlamp for the nighttime scenario.**

Financial aid is available for Wilderness First Responder through the Louise Barber Endowment. 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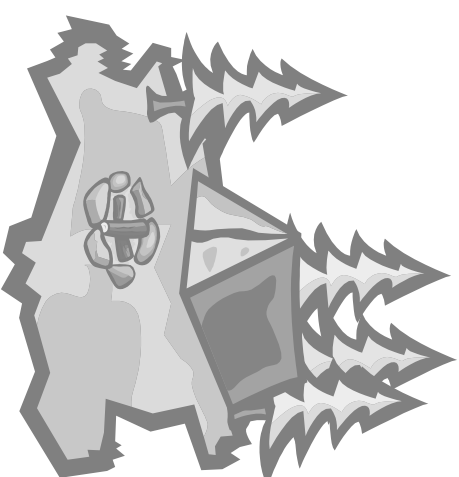
