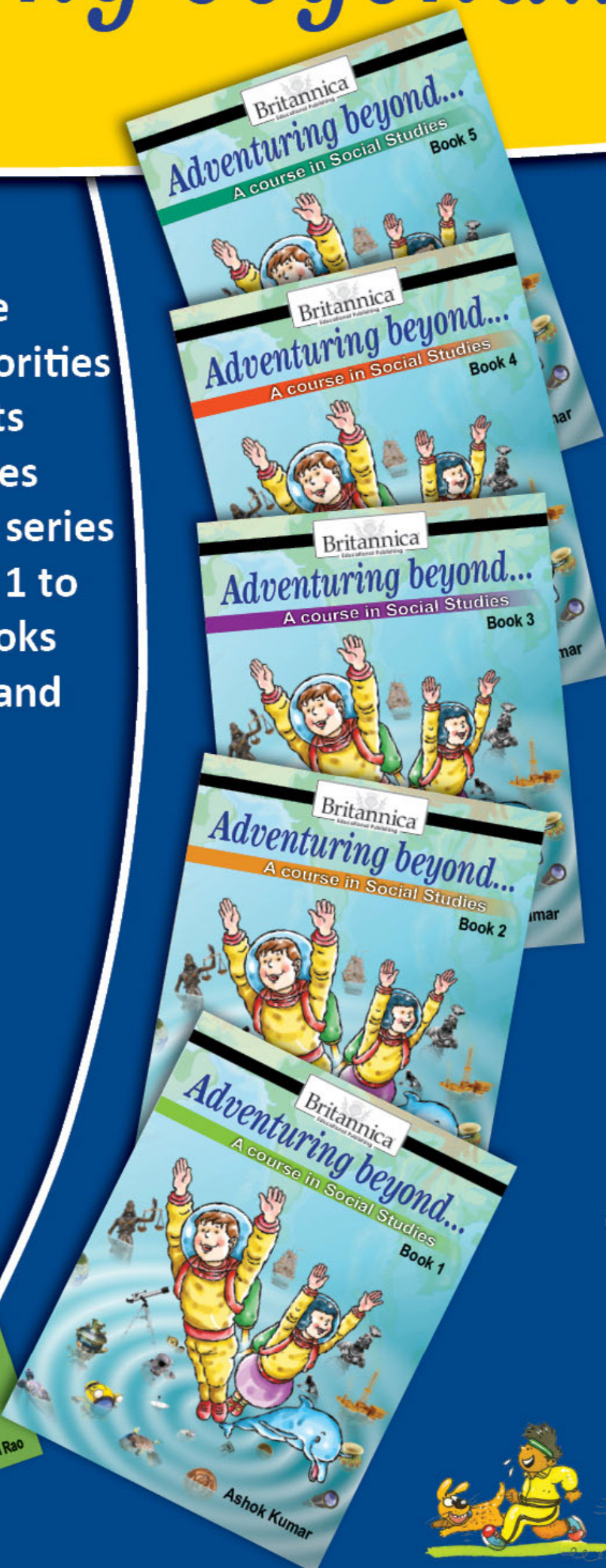

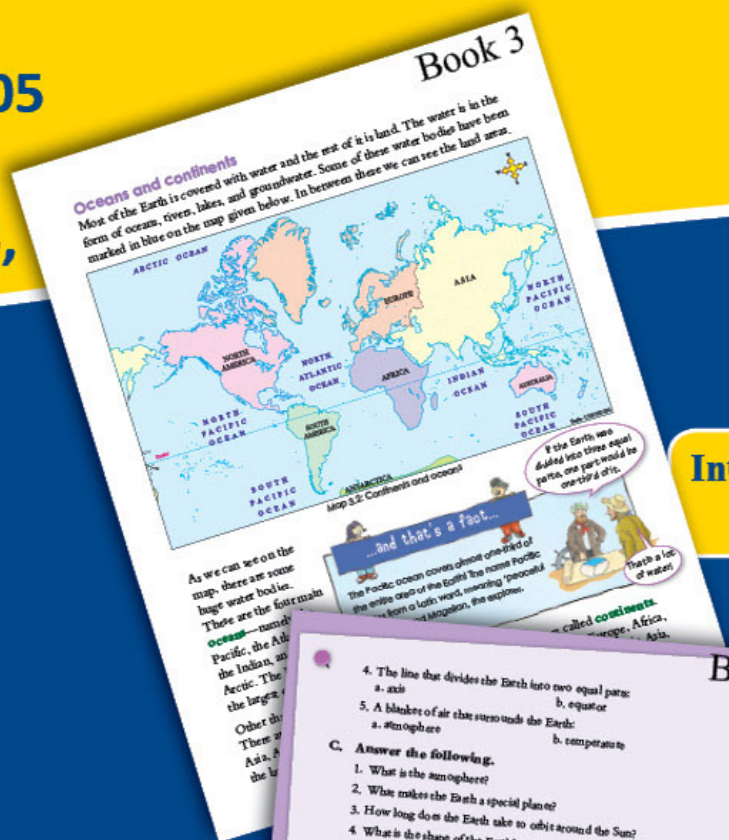

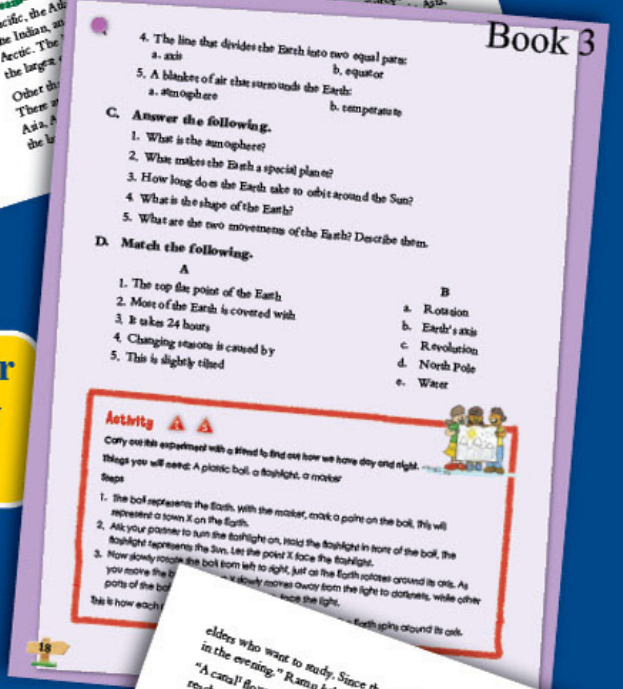

- implements CBSE guidelines through Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS).

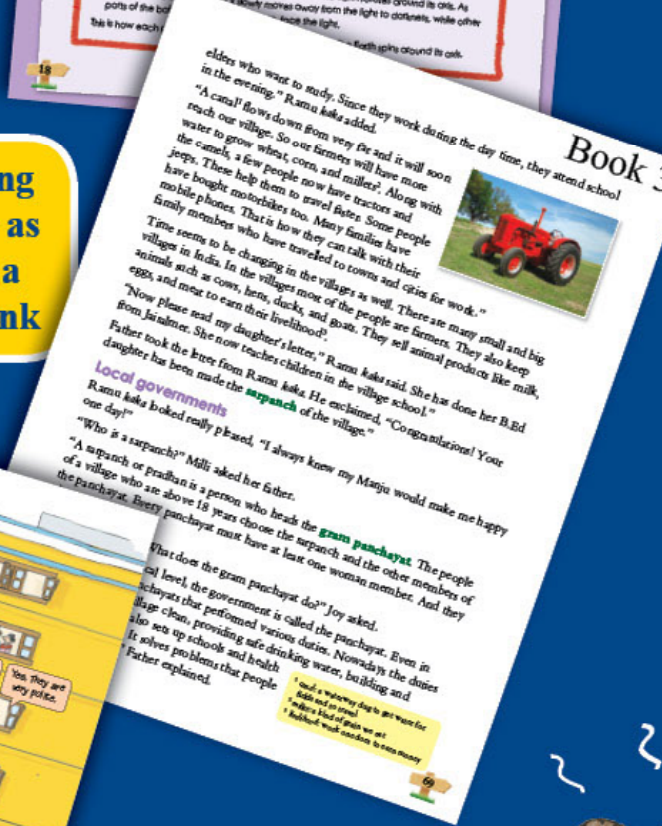

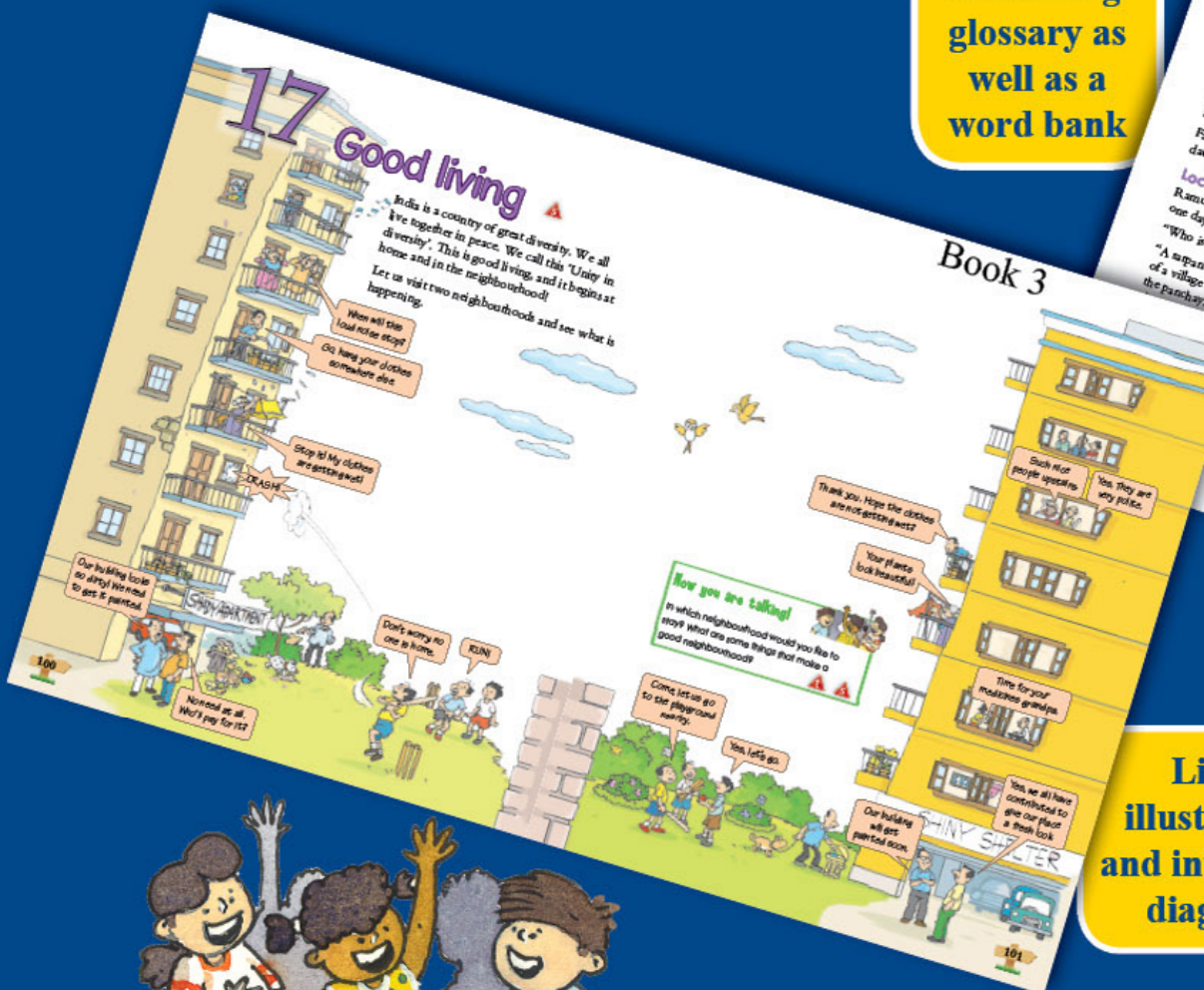

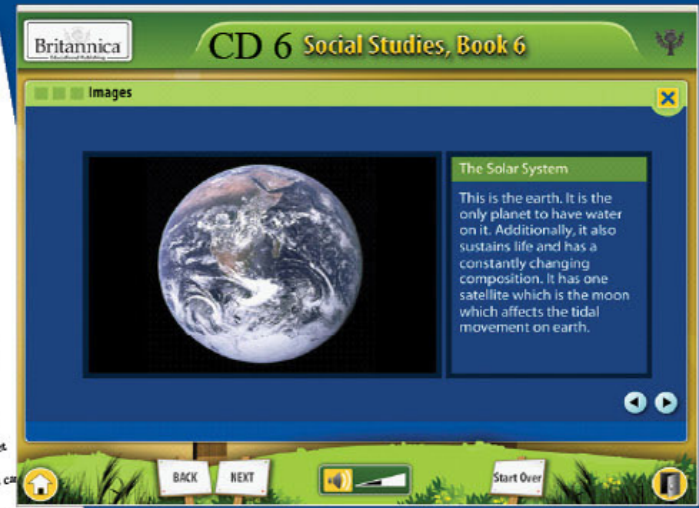
