

Eastleigh Constituency Poll

Prepared on behalf of the Mail on Sunday



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Fieldwork Dates: 6th February - 8th February 2013

Data Collection Method: The survey was conducted via telephone. A combination of random numbers seeded from the complete BT directory of households in the Eastleigh wards and, in addition, a smaller amount of targeted lifestyle data for specific age brackets were called.

Population Sampled: All adults aged 18+ in the Parliamentary constituency of Eastleigh (2010 borders)

Sample Size: 504

Data Weighting: Data were weighted to the profile of all adults aged 18+. Data were weighted by gender, age and 2010 vote. Targets for the weighted data were derived from ONS data. Quotas were used to ensure an adequate representation of all electoral wards across the constituency.

Margin of Error: It should be remembered at all times that a sample of 504 residents aged 18+ were interviewed, and not the entire population. Consequently, all results are subject to margin of error, which mean that not all differences are statistically significant. For example, in a question where 50% (the worst case scenario as far as margin of error is concerned) gave a particular answer, with a sample of 504 we can be 95% certain that the 'true' value will fall within the range of **4.4%** either side of that 50% figure from the sample.

Data were analysed and weighted by Survation and presented by Patrick Briône and Damian Lyons Lowe.
