

Columbus Tower

This 100,000 square meter development at West India Quay on the Isle of Dogs incorporates a mix of office, hotel and residential uses together with a variety of retail, leisure and civic amenities in an architecturally impressive sixty-three storey landmark, high-rise tower.

The scheme, developed for SKMC Developments, has been granted resolution to grant permission. The resolution was received less than twelve months after submission of the Planning application.

The design, which features a striking sculptural massing and external expression, derives its form and language for formal and thematic precedents associated with the navel dockyard and aviation history of the London Docklands.

The design has received a warm reception from the lay and professional communities alike and has been favourably received by the Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment.
