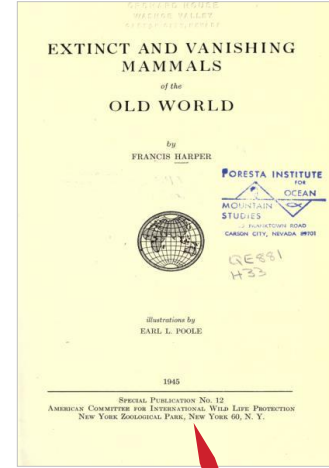
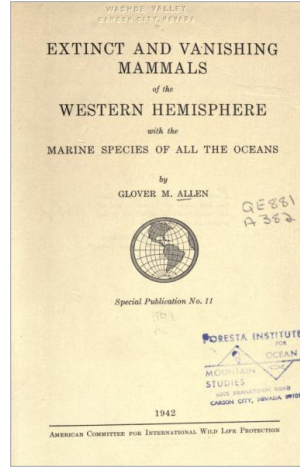

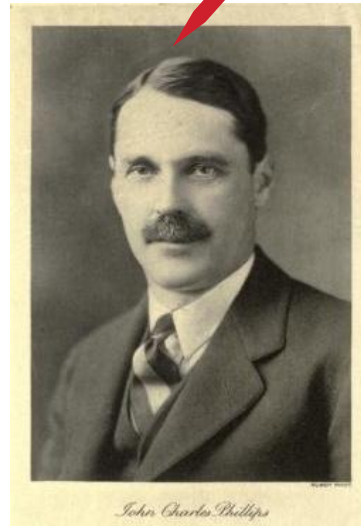
THE LAST LIVING PASSENGER PIGEON
