Benin, 2 reports: 2 killings – Both in 2012

Botswana, 3 reports: 3 survivors – September, 1998

Burkina Faso, 9 reports: 2 killings / 6 survivors / 1 asylum - Most recent - August 14, 2012

Burundi, 28 reports: 17 killings / 7 survivors / 4 grave robbery - Most recent – October 21, 2013

Cameroon, 7 report: 2 killings, 1 survivor, 3 asylums, 1 grave robbery - Most recent – August 2013

Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 27 reports: 7 killings / 16 survivors / 4 grave robberies - Most recent – December, 2013

Egypt, 1 report: 1 asylum – September 16, 2011

Ghana, 1 report: 1 survivor – July 16, 2009

Guinea, 9 reports: 2 killings / 4 survivors / 3 asylums - Most recent – June 4, 2013

Ivory Coast, 25 reports: 6 killings / 11 survivors / 4 missing / 2 asylums / 2 abandoned - Most recent – March 6, 2014

Kenya, 12 reports: 4 killings / 8 survivors - Most recent – March 15, 2013

Malawi, 3 report: 2 survivors, 1 missing – Most recent - July 2, 2013

Mali, 8 report: 2 killings / 2 survivors / 1 missing / 3 asylums - Most recent - 2011

Mozambique, 2 reports: 1 survivor, 1 unknown status – Most recent – July 29, 2009

Namibia, 2 reports: 1 killing / 1 survivor - Most recent - May 12, 2012

Nigeria, 8 reports: 4 killings / 1 missing / 1 asylum / 1 kidnapping / 1 attempted kidnapping - Most recent April, 2013

Rwanda, 1 report: 1 grave robbery – July 2, 2013

Senegal, 7 report: 3 alleged killings / 3 survivors / 1 asylum - Most recent – 2011

South Africa, 4 reports: 1 killing / 1 missing / 1 survivor / 1 grave robbery - Most recent – February 22, 2013

Swaziland, 9 reports: 2 killings / 7 survivors - Most recent – September 2, 2013

Tanzania, 139 reports: 72 killings / 49 survivors / 18 grave violations - Most recent – Dec 15, 2013

Zambia, 1 reports: 1 killing December 2011

Zimbabwe, 2 report: 1 killing 2011 / 1 asylum - November 29, 2012

NOTE #1: Countries known to be involved in the cross-border trade of PWA and their body

parts: Tanzania, Burundi, Kenya, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Mozambique, South Africa, Swaziland,

NOTE #2: The actual number of attacks & killings of PWA are likely much higher than indicated

above since many are never reported or documented. These muti (medicine) killings have been going on for time beyond memory.
