In Tanzania, discrimination against persons with albinism is commonplace. Too often it has escalated into grisly mutilations, murder and trafficking in human body parts due to the teachings of witchdoctors. Many of the victims are children. Under The Same Sun is passionately committed to ending this deadly discrimination.

Our Present Projects

Our Tanzanian office in the city of Dar es Salaam employs local staff, over half of whom are persons with albinism. This amazing UTSS team makes up two well-staffed departments to help achieve its goals. The departments are:

- Education Scholarship Fund (ESF)
- Advocacy and Public Awareness (APA)

Education Scholarship Fund

ESF offers grants to children, youth and adults with albinism at all levels of education in many regions of Tanzania. Our grantees are placed in the best and safest educational environments Tanzania has to offer.



Advocacy and Public Awareness

APA uses a variety of media to educate the public on albinism. It also conducts specific programs to diffuse existing myths that often lead to discrimination and justify macabre killings.
