

WILDCATS PROVE TOUGH

Ohio State 0 3 0 7---10

FIRST PERIOD

The temperature was 50 degrees; wind from the north 8 m.p.h. Northwestern won the toss and elected to defend the north goal; Ohio State to receive.

OHIO STATE—(1:5)—Kimbrough kicked off to Warfield on the 4 and he returned to the 21. Mummy pitched out to Warfield on the option around right end for 14 and first down on the Ohio 35. Ferguson fumbled a handoff and Pike recovered on the Ohio 37.

NORTHWESTERN—(14:06)—Snider made 1 at right guard. Benz went straight over center for 3. Swingle sliced off left tackle for 2. On 4 and 5, Eickhoff pitched out wide around right end to Snider for 19 and first down on the Buckeye 12. Eickhoff sneaked for 3. Benz lost 2 trying to get around Ohio's right end. Quinn found no pass receiver and ran over left tackle for 4. On 4th and 5, Dammi attempted a field goal from the 15, but it was wide to the right.

OHIO STATE (11:12)—With the ball on the 20, Warfield swept right end for 4. Snell reversed over left tackle for 5. Ferguson bounced through a hole at left tackle for 5 and first down on the Ohio 34. Warfield failed to gain around right end. Warfield tried over right guard for 3. Mummy rolled out around left tackle for 6. Ulmer punted to the Northwestern 27, but the ball bounced back all the way to the 47.

NORTHWESTERN—(7:38)—Snider took a pitchout from Eickhoff around right end 15 for first down on the Ohio 38. Snider added 3 over left tackle. Benz picked up 2 at center. Eickhoff bootlegged inside left end for 5 and first down on the Ohio 28. Eickhoff kept inside right end for 3. Snider tried center for 1. Benz swept left end for 5. On fourth and 1, Eickhoff lost 1 and Ohio took over on its own 20.

OHIO STATE—(4:32)—Mummy got 1 around right end. Ferguson broke over the middle for 38 and first down on the NU 41. Hess tried to cut back at left tackle and got 2. Mummy lateraled to Snell around left end for 4. Ferguson smashed down two NU tacklers for 11 yards over right tackle, first down on the NU 24. Ferguson cracked over left tackle for 4. Warfield cut back over left tackle for 11 and first down on the Wildcat 9. He did a beautiful bit of running and was spilled by the safety man. Ferguson blasted cen-

ter for 2 as the quarter ended. Score at end of first period: OHIO STATE, 0; NORTHWESTERN, 0.

SECOND PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(1:15)—Mummy's pass to Warfield was no good when the latter fell. Mummy's pass to Bryant was baited down by Van Raaphorst, from the 14, kicked a field goal. Time: 0:10. Score: Ohio State, 3; Northwestern, 0.

NORTHWESTERN—(14:50)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Brainard on the 5 and he returned to the NU 21. Flatley plunged end for 2. Flatley picked up 1 on the trap at center. Quinn passed to Brainard for 13 and first down on the NU 37. Quinn passed to Machalski for 13 and first down on the 50. Quinn's pass was batted down. Flatley spun off right tackle for 2 on the trap play. Quinn lost 6 trying to pass, Ohio declining a motion penalty. Cox punted to Ulmer on the 12 and he returned to the 20.

OHIO STATE—(11:55)—Ferguson fought over center for 4. Snell was tripped up around left end for 2. Mrukowski kept inside right end for 3, inches short of first down. Ulmer punted to Benz, who signalled for a fair catch, but the ball bounced into Ingram's hands on the NU 39. Mummy kept at right tackle for 2. Mrukowski lost 4 trying to pass. Onesti spilled Mrukowski for a 9-yard loss on a pass play. With fourth and 21, Ulmer punted to Snider on the 16 and he returned to the NU 29.

NORTHWESTERN—(6:58)—Snider cut back over right tackle for 4. Snider took a double reverse over right guard for 3. Swingle added 3 at left tackle, a first down on the NU 39 by inches. Snider found daylight at Ohio's left end for 7. Swingle sliced off right tackle for 2. Eickhoff kept over right guard for 2 and first down on the 50. Benz swept left end for 3. Snider was spilled by Tingley for a 5-yard loss at right end. Eickhoff swept left end for 7. On fourth and 5 at the Ohio 45, Cox punted to Ulmer, who fumbled and Warfield recovered on the Ohio 17.

OHIO STATE—(2:34)—Mummy cut back wide inside left end for 9. Mummy rolled around left tackle for 4 and first down on the Ohio 30. Snell tried left tackle and fell for 1. Ferguson found a hole at right guard for 13 and first down on the 44. Mummy passed to Bryant for 44 and first down on the NU 12. Mummy swept right end for 5. Mummy's pass to Warfield was

almost intercepted and dropped. Mummy's pass to Bryant was too high in the end zone. With 4th and 5, Sparma's pass to Warfield was no good when Warfield was knocked down. Northwestern took over on its own 7.

NORTHWESTERN—(0:08)—Eickhoff failed to gain as the half ended. Score at end of second period: OHIO STATE, 3; NORTHWESTERN, 0.

THIRD QUARTER

OHIO STATE—(1:15)—Kimbrough kicked off to Bryant on the 21 and he returned to the 32. Mummy ran inside left end for 9. Ferguson got 2 and first down on the Ohio 43. Mummy rolled out at right end and cut back for 4. Snell cut back inside left end for 4. Mummy kept around right end for 8 and first down on the NU 41. Ferguson hurled himself 2 over the middle. Snell swept left end for 2. Onesti caught Mummy from behind on a sweep right for a yard loss. Ulmer punted dead on the NU 11.

NORTHWESTERN—(9:24)—Eickhoff was trapped for a 4-yard loss. Ingram getting the tackle. Eickhoff rolled out at left tackle for no gain. Cox punted to Warfield on the Ohio 48 and he returned to the Ohio 48.

OHIO STATE—(7:48)—Ferguson bounced left guard for 4. Mummy picked up 2 around left end. Mummy passed to Middleton for 8 and first down on the NU 38. Ferguson dragged a hole of Wildcats for 8 up the middle. Ferguson went off right tackle with great power again for 4 and first down on the NU 26. Ferguson added 3 at the same spot. Ferguson piled hard over the left guard for 2. Sparma's pass was intercepted by Benz on the NU 13 and he returned to the 18. Warfield made a saving tackle.

NORTHWESTERN—(4:16)—Benz picked up 2 over left guard. Eickhoff swept inside left end for 2. Eickhoff passed to Benz in the right flat and he cut back for 10 and first down on the NU 32. Perdue rode over a blocker and threw Benz for a 7-yard loss. Ingram brought down Benz after a yard gain on a pass from Eickhoff. Quinn passed to Dillon for 14. Cox punted to Ulmer on the Ohio 15 and he returned to the 24. The period ended. Score at end of third period: OHIO STATE, 3; NORTHWESTERN, 0.

FOURTH PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(1:15)—Snell swept left end for 5. Warfield ran the other end for 3. Ferguson spilled over left tackle for 1 and Ulmer punted to the NU 43.

NORTHWESTERN—(12:56)—Ulmer intercepted Quinn's pass on the NU 49 and he returned to the NU 42.

OHIO STATE—(12:20)—Warfield cut back on a sweep of right end for 4. Ferguson found running room at left tackle and blasted for 6 and first down on the NU 32. Warfield swept far around right end for 3. Ferguson drove for 2 off left tackle. Snell cut back over left tackle for 3. With fourth and 2, Mrukowski lateraled to Snell, who fumbled out of bounds and Northwestern took over on its own 22 on downs.

NORTHWESTERN—(9:27)—Swingle got around left end for 19 and first down on the NU 41. Swingle went inside the other end for 9. Flatley plunged center for 4 and first down on the Ohio 46. Tingley spilled Brainard for a 3-yard loss at right end. Quinn's pass to Dillon was long. Quinn passed to Stinson for 9. On fourth and 4, Cox punted to the Ohio 27.

OHIO STATE—(7:15)—Mrukowski lateraled to Warfield around right end for 3. Ferguson plowed over left guard for 5. Ferguson tried the same spot and made 1, a foot short of first down. With fourth and a foot, Ferguson spun at left guard and made 2 for first down on the Ohio 38. Snell cut inside left end for 5. Snell added 4 at the same spot. Ferguson broke over right tackle and kept fighting for 1 and first down on the NU 42. Snell tried wide around left end for 3. Ferguson broke loose at right guard for 21 and first down on the NU 18. Ferguson pushed left guard for 3. Warfield lost 5 trying to get wide right. Mrukowski rolled out around left end for a touchdown. Time: 12:55. Van Raaphorst converted. Score: OHIO STATE, 10; NORTHWESTERN, 0.

NORTHWESTERN—(2:04)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Stinson on the 1 and he returned to the NU 25. Ohio was penalized 5 for delay of game. Swingle ran through right tackle for 13 and first down on the NU 43. Warfield intercepted O'Grady's pass on the Ohio 34 and he returned to the 40.

CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS*

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

(Continued from back of form 347-A)

SECTION 6—PUNTS.

Article 1: Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note — "Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense.

(Note — "Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns.")

Article 2: When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line **only**, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

Article 3: If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball **continues toward his goal line**, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back **toward the kicker's goal**, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers.

Article 4: A blocked punt is recorded as a "team" entry, and not charged against the individual kicker. Thus, in the case of a blocked punt which does not pass the line of scrimmage, enter the word "team" in lieu of kicker's name and charge one punt for NO yards, so the blocked punt is included under "Times Kicked" in team totals.

If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **blocking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **kicking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick—and the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost, except on fourth down.

SECTION 7 — KICK RETURNS.

Article 1: Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns. (**Exception** — Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

Article 2: The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are no "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

Article 3: The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

SECTION 8 — FREE KICKS.

Free kicks are recorded as kickoffs if made from placement, and as punts if the ball is punted. The receiving player is credited with a kickoff return, or a punt return, respectively.

SECTION 9—GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

For the sake of uniformity in an area where considerable disagreement has existed, it is recommended that all news story and record reference to a successful field goal cite the yard line from which kicked, rather than the distance kicked, i.e., "field goal from 25-yard line," rather than "25-yard field goal."

Field goals are not recorded under punting.

SECTION 10—POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWN.

Article 1: A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is **not** charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes an opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team," rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt **is** charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

Article 2: The try-for-point-after-touchdown is made while time is out and is **not** recorded as a play from scrimmage (rush, pass or kick).

When a try-for-point-after-touchdown is by forward passing, the passer is charged (under SCORING) with the attempt. If successful, the receiver is credited under SCORING with the conversion and points scored, and the passer is credited with a conversion under FORWARD PASSING.

SECTION 11 — SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

SECTION 12 — FUMBLES.

On any play **terminated** by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling — On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)
