

HOMECOMING THRILLER

Iowa 0 0 7 6--13
Ohio State 6 6 0 17--29

FIRST PERIOD

Iowa won the toss and elected to receive; Ohio State to defend the south goal.

IOWA—(15)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Harris on the 5 and he returned to the 22. Harris reversed 1 over left tackle. Krause lost 3 at right end, Tolford getting the tackle. Szykowny passed to Webb for 15 and first down on the Iowa 35. Krause cut back inside right end for 4. Szykowny's pass to Webb bounced off his fingers. Szykowny passed to Webb for 18 and first down on the Ohio 43. Perkins slanted off right guard for 2. Harris fumbled and Perkins picked it off in mid-air and ran 55 yards for a touchdown. Time: 3:53. VanRaaphorst's conversion try was no good. Ohio State 6, Iowa 0.

IOWA—(11:07)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Krause on the goal line and he returned to the Iowa 26. Perdue downed Harris for a 4-yard loss trying to sweep left end. Szykowny passed to Webb for 17 and first down on the Iowa 39. Perkins blasted off right tackle for 5. Perkins used the same avenue for 3. Perkins found a hole at right guard and went up the middle for 15 and first down on the Ohio 38. Krause went around right end for 25, but Iowa was penalized 15 for holding to midfield. Webb reversed 4 inside left end. Szykowny passed to Rogers for 1. Szykowny passed for 15 and first down on the Ohio 42. Wyatt lost 1 at left end. Perkins used Szykowny's pass to Webb was intercepted by Krause. Szykowny's pass to Webb gained 10 yards. Perkins was stopped at the line.

Perkins was stopped at the line and tackled, but spun off for 5 and first down on the Buckeye 7. Williams got 1 at right tackle. Williams tried off right tackle for 2. Szykowny's pass to Webb was incomplete, but Iowa was set back 15 for holding to the Ohio 19. Szykowny was tripped trying to pass but ran right end for 11. Szykowny's pass, from fake place-kick, was batted up in the air by Whisler, but fell incomplete out of the end zone. Ohio took over on its own 7.

OHIO STATE—(3:07)—Warfield swept right end for 6. Klein lost 1 trying the other side. Mrukowski passed to Bryant for 7 and first down on the Ohio 19. Ferguson failed to gain at right guard. The period ended before another play. Score at end of first period, Ohio State, 6; Iowa, 0.

SECOND PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Ferguson gained 4 at left tackle for first down on the Ohio 46. Warfield lost 2 at right end, Perkins tackling. Ferguson regained the 2 over center. Klein got 2 over left tackle. Hardman punted to Wyatt on the 3 and he was tackled by Klein on the 5.

IOWA—(12:23)—Krause swept right end for 20 and first down on the Iowa 25. Krause made 4 over right tackle. Perkins slid inside right end for 4. Perkins plunged center for 3 and first down on the Iowa 36. Krause was spilled at right end for no gain. Tinsley intercepted Szykowny's pass on the Iowa 45 and he returned to the 30.

OHIO STATE—(9:46)—Ferguson cut back over right tackle for 4. Ferguson added 4 over right guard. Ferguson spilled over left tackle for 1, inches short of first down. On 4th down, Ferguson went off right tackle and cut back for 7 and first down on the Iowa 14. Snell reversed

left tackle for 1. Ohio was set back for too much time. Sparma passed to some end Bryant on the 5 and he led the sideline to pay dirt. Time: 5. VanRaaphorst missed the conversion. Score: Ohio State, 12; Iowa, 0.

IOWA—(6:35)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Wyatt on the 2 and he returned to the Iowa 26. Krause smacked off right tackle for 2. Szykowny passed to Webb for 32 and first down on the Ohio 40. Perdue tackled Harris for no gain. Szykowny's pass to Harris was low. Ingram burst through to down Szykowny for an 8-yard loss on an intended pass play. Calhoun punted out of bounds on the Ohio 9.

OHIO STATE—(3:35)—Warfield slanted over center for 3. Ferguson blasted over the middle for 8 and first down on the 20. Ferguson met a host of tacklers all center but made 2. Sparma passed out of bounds. Warfield tried right tackle for 1. Ohio was penalized 5 for delay of game on Hardman's punt. On a second try, Hardman punted to Krause on the Iowa 46 and he returned to the Iowa 49.

IOWA—(0:49)—Szykowny's pass to Rogers was incomplete. Szykowny's pass was intercepted by Bryant on the Ohio 43 and he returned to the Iowa 37.

OHIO STATE—(0:35)—Sparma's pass to Bryant was broken up by Wyatt. Sparma's pass to Bryant was knocked down by Krause. Krause also batted down Sparma's next pass to Bryant. Sparma's pass to Bryant was batted down by Krause for the third straight time. Iowa took over on its own 37.

IOWA—(0:13)—Szykowny ran for 1. Krause made 6 as the half ended. Score at end of second period: Ohio State, 12; Iowa, 0.

THIRD PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Fisher kicked off to Middleton on the Ohio 32 and he returned to the 46. Ferguson plunged for 3. Warfield swept right end for 1. Sparma passed to Bryant for 8 and first down on the Iowa 42. Ferguson pounded the middle for 5. Ferguson powered center for 4. Katterhenrich slid through right tackle for 5 and first down on the Iowa 29. Ferguson spun at right tackle for 2. Sparma's pass to Ricketts was almost intercepted by Krause. Sparma's pass to Middleton was low. Sparma's pass to Klein was long and Iowa took over on its own 27.

IOWA—(10:47)—Harris got inside left end for 5. Harris ran the same play for 18 and first down at midfield. Perkins got loose over the middle and went 27 and first down on the Ohio 23. Harris reversed for 1 at left end. Williams smashed right tackle for 3. Szykowny passed to Rogers for 14 and first down on the Ohio 5. Perkins drove at right tackle for 1. Perkins slanted off left tackle for 1. Wyatt reversed for 2 1/2 inches from the goal line. Szykowny sneaked for a touchdown. Time: 8:42. Szykowny converted. Score: Ohio State, 12; Iowa, 7.

OHIO STATE—(6:18)—Krause kicked off to Snell on the 11 where he fumbled and fell on the 12. Mummy rolled around right end and went 49 yards, but Ohio was penalized 5 for offside to its own 7. Ferguson pilled into right tackle for 4. Ferguson broke over right tackle and cut back for 20 and first down on the 31.

Warfield cut back on a sweep right end for no gain. Sparma's pass to Middleton was incomplete. Sparma's pass to Bryant was no good. Hardman punted to Krause on the 23 and he returned to the Iowa 34.

IOWA—(3:23)—Krause tried right tackle for 2. Krause reversed into the middle for 2 more. Perkins went up the middle for 4. Calhoun punted to Warfield, who fumbled and recovered on the Ohio 25.

OHIO STATE—(1:11)—Mummy rolled around left tackle for 2. Mummy cut back inside right end for 16 and first down on the Ohio 43. The quarter ended before another play. Score at end of third period: Ohio State, 12; Iowa, 7.

FOURTH PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Ferguson pounded for 4, but Ohio was penalized 5 for offside to its own 37. Bryant took a pass from Sparma on the Iowa 35, danced his way out of the grasp of three Iowa defenders and sprinted into the end zone with Webb making a lunging tackle at the goal line. Time: 0:21. Score: Ohio State, 19; Iowa, 7.

IOWA—(14:39)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Williams on the 5 and he returned to the Iowa 30. Harris lost 1 trying around left end. Szykowny's pass to Harris was incomplete. Ingram broke through to spill Szykowny for a 9-yard loss. Calhoun punted to Hess on the Ohio 45 and he returned to the Iowa 49.

OHIO STATE—(12:37)—Ferguson plunged for 4. Ferguson got loose inside left end for 10 and first down on the Iowa 35. Ferguson got 4 off left tackle. Ferguson kept digging off right tackle for 7 and first down on the Iowa 24. Ferguson cut back over left guard for 4. Ferguson pounded center for 3. Ferguson cut through right tackle for 6 and first down on the Iowa 11. Warfield swept right end for 3. Ferguson failed to gain at left guard. Ferguson swept left end for 2. VanRaaphorst, from the 19, kicked a field goal. Time: 6:54. Score: Ohio State, 22; Iowa, 7.

IOWA—(8:04)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Krause on the 6 and he returned to the 26, but Iowa was set back to its own 5. Krause made 2 over center. Harris cut back inside left end for 9 and first down on the Iowa 17. Krause failed to gain at right end. Ingram tackling. Szykowny's pass to Whisler picked up 9. Krause shook loose around right end for 4 and first down on the 30. Szykowny passed to Whisler for 12 and first down on the Iowa 42. Szykowny's pass to Whisler was almost intercepted by Houck. Turici ran 7 on the draw play. Williams spun over right tackle for 4 and first down on the Ohio 47. Szykowny passed to Whisler for 17 and first down on the Ohio 30. Moeller almost intercepted Szykowny's pass to Williams. Szykowny was thrown for a 3-yard loss by Moeller. Moeller intercepted Webb's pass on the Ohio 26 and he returned down the sidelines to the Iowa 21, a 53-yard return. Hinton made the tackle.

OHIO STATE—(2:43)—Mummy kept for a 2-yard loss. Mummy sneaked for 10. Ferguson broke over the middle and went all the way untouched. Time: 13:05. VanRaaphorst converted. Score: Ohio State, 29; Iowa, 7.

IOWA—(1:55)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Williams in the end zone and he returned to the 16 where Perdue made the tackle. Turici went 8 over center. Turici picked up 2 but Ohio was penalized 15 for personal foul, giving Iowa first down on the Iowa 43. Williams tried right end for 4. Calhoun passed to Williams for 38 and first down on the Ohio 15. Calhoun's pass to Lyon was ruled complete on interference at the Ohio 4. Turici plunged the middle for a touchdown. Time: 14:48. Szykowny missed the point. Score: Ohio State, 29; Iowa, 13.

OHIO STATE—(0:12)—Krause kicked off to Jones on the 15 and he returned to the Ohio 24. Lambert carried for 3, but Iowa was penalized 15 for personal foul to the Ohio 40. Francis got 2 as the game ended. Final score: Ohio State, 29; Iowa, 13.

CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS*

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1 — FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2 — RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a **net** figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3 — FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is **no** pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team. The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team

is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4 — LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling — Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards, then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving." Player B is credited with NO pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving." Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing.")

(Approved Ruling — Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns." Player B is credited with NO return and with 5 yards under "punt returns.")

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing." If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5 — TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of **net** gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are **not** included in total offense.

WILD PASS FROM CENTER.

Any loss resulting from an **obvious** wild pass from center is charged to "center pass," and not to any individual player.
