FIRST PERIOD

Ohio won the toss and elected to receive; TCU to defend the south goal. The temperature was 81; wind 20 m.p.h. from the southwest.

OHIO STATE—(15)—Gibbs kicked off to Bryant on the Ohio 45. Ferguson plunged center for 6. Ferguson tried left tackle this time for 3. Ferguson drove hard over the same spot for 4 and first down on the TCU 42. Ferguson went over the right tackle this time for 3. Mrukowski sneaked for 4. Ferguson went over left tackle for 3 and first down on the 32. Warfield reversed for 1 at right tackle. Ferguson bumped center for 2. Mrukowski rolled out around right end for 6. On the 4th and 1, Ferguson powered for 5 at center and first down on the TCU 18. Ferguson slanted over the left guard and carried three TCU linemen for 6. Ferguson was met at left guard and lost 1. Ferguson tried right tackle for 4. On 4th and 1, Ferguson blasted right tackle for 6 and first down on the 7. Ferguson failed to gain at left guard. Ferguson plowed over left guard and pulled for 4. Ferguson's plunge at right guard carried 1 to the 2. Mrukowski rolled around left end and lobbed a pass to Bryant in the end zone. Time: 7:55 Van Raaphorst kicked the extra point. Score: OSU 7, TCU 0.

TCU (6:05)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Gibbs on the 18 and he returned to the 34. Hill was met by Hart at left tackle after 2. Iles made a catch of Gibbs' pass on the 33, a 31-yard gain and first down. Crutcher plunged at right tackle for 2. Dent lost 1 at the same point. Crutcher ran the draw play over the left side for 11 and first down on the Ohio 21. Gibbs kept inside left end for 6. Gibbs' pass overshoot Dodson on the end zone. Gibbs passed to Dodson, who made a leaping catch and drove to the Ohio 4. It was a gain of 11 and first down. TUC was set back 5 for offside. Dent took a deep kickout at left end, but Perdue spilled him for a 2-yard loss. Gibbs passed to Crutcher in the right flat for 4. Smith's pass to Dent in the end zone was long. On 4th

and 7, Gibbs passed to Crutcher, who had the ball momentarily at the goal line, but dropped it for an incompleion. Ohio taking over.

OHIO STATE—(33)—Ferguson bounced center for 3. Ferguson went 4 over left tackle as the quarter ended. Score at end of first period—OHIO STATE, 7; TCU, 0.

SECOND PERIOD

OHIO STATE—13:15—Ferguson went over left tackle for 4 and first down on the Ohio 18. Warfield slanted off right tackle for 1. Mrukowski pitched back to Warfield, who ran 2 around right end. Wallace's pass to Bryant was low, Ulmer punted to Hoffman on the TCU 34 and he returned to the 45.

TCU—(13:15)—Priddy slanted over right tackle for 2. Mynatt picked up 2 over the middle. Nix passed to Priddy in the left flat for 5. With 4th and 1, Thomas broke around right end and slanted to the sidelines for 20 and first down on the Ohio 26. Thomas tried the same route for 2. Nix's pass was intercepted by Tidmore on the Ohio 20. The Bucks declined an illegal procedure penalty.

OHIO STATE—(10:38)—Ferguson punched over the middle for 3. Ferguson broke loose over left tackle and stumbled after going 14 for first down on the 37. Ferguson found 2 at right guard. Ferguson bumped center for 3. Ferguson fumbled at Midfield and Magoffin recovered on the TCU 49.

TCU—(8:12)—Thomas slid off right tackle for 3. Richter went up the middle for 8 and first down on the Ohio 40. L. Thomas swept left end for 2. G. Thomas tried right tackle for 1. Mills' pass to G. Thomas was no good. Ohio declining a backfield in motion penalty. G. Thomas punted out of bounds on the Ohio 3.

OHIO STATE—(5:33)—Mrukowski sneaked for 4. Ferguson slanted through right tackle for 3. Ferguson pushed the middle for 3 and first down on the 13. Ferguson ran right tackle for 1. Mrukowski's pass to Bryant was knocked down and almost intercepted. Ulmer punted to the TCU 36.

TCU—(3:01)—L. Thomas ran 6 on a double reverse at left end. Richter was met at left tackle for no gain. Mills' pass to Richter was no good. G. Thomas punted dead on the Ohio 28.

OHIO STATE—(1:29)—Mrukowski sneaked for 3. Mrukowski passed to Hess for 11 and first down on the Ohio 42. Wallace lost 5 trying to pass. Mrukowski sneaked for 4 as the half ended. Score at end of second period: OHIO STATE, 7; TCU, 0.

THIRD PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Gibbs kicked off to Warfield on the 10 and he returned to the 32. Ferguson glasted at center for 1. Mrukowski rolled out at right end for no gain. Gibbs intercepted Mrukowski's pass on the TCU 42 and he returned to the Ohio 45.

TCU—(12:50)—Gibbs passed to Glasscock at the sideline for 9. Gibbs sneaked over left guard for 3 and first down on the OSU 33. Hill picked his way inside left end for 2. Crutcher slanted hard at left guard for 4. Crutcher was met at left tackle after 1. Gibbs sneaked for 2. Ohio taking over on downs on its own 24.

OHIO STATE—(10:17)—Warfield plunged for 1. Mrukowski's pass to Warfield was on the ground. Mrukowski threw a screen pass to Ferguson, who was spilled for no gain. Ulmer kicked out of bounds on the TCU 35.

TCU—(8:34)—Gibbs ran right end for 2. Crutcher lost 2 on the draw play. Gibbs' pass to D. Smith was no good. Thomas punted to the Ohio 29.

OHIO STATE—(7:03)—Ulmer broke over right tackle and cut back to the middle for 15 and first down on the 44. Ferguson got 2, but Ohio was penalized 5 for backfield motion to the 39. Warfield fumbled and Plummer recovered on the Ohio 42.

TCU—(6:01)—G. Thomas went 3 inside right end. The same play netted 6. Crutcher failed to gain at right tackle. Crutcher bolted over the middle for 1 and first down on the 32. Tidmore recovered G. Thomas' fumble on the Ohio 32.

OHIO STATE—(3:31)—Mrukowski's fumble was recovered by Ulmer for a 3-yard gain. Ferguson piled over center for 2. Mrukowski rolled around left end for 6

and first down on the 43. Mrukowski lost 5 as Mangum broke through. Ferguson picked up 6 on the draw. Mrukowski passed to Snell for 8.

The period ended before another play. Score at end of third period: Ohio State, 7; TCU 0.

FOURTH PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Ulmer's punt rolled dead on the TCU 21. It had been 4th and 1.

TCU—(14:00)—Gibbs passed to Iles in the right flat for 9, but TCU was set back 5 for illegal motion to its own 16. Crutcher plunged for 1. Gibbs passed to D. Hill for 63 yards and first down on the Ohio 20. Ulmer made the tackle. Gibbs' pass to Hill on the 10 was long. Ulmer batted down Gibbs' pass to Iles. Gibbs passed to Glasscock for 9 to the Ohio 11. Crutcher found daylight at right tackle for 3 and first down on the Ohio 8. Gibbs fumbled and recovered for a 4-yard loss. Gibbs passed to Glasscock, who was alone in the left side of the end zone. Time: 3:40. McAteer converted. Score: OHIO STATE 7; TCU 7.

OHIO STATE—(1:20)—Gibbs kicked off to Warfield on the 2 and he returned to the Ohio 19. Mrukowski cut back over right tackle for 7. Ferguson pumped hard over left tackle for 5 and first down on the 31. Ferguson found a hole at left tackle for 6. Ferguson was piled up at left guard, but got 3. Ferguson cut back over left tackle for 3 and first down on the Ohio 43. Warfield went 5 over left tackle. Ferguson drove straight ahead for 3. Mrukowski sneaked for 3 and first down on the TCU 46. Warfield was good for a yard at right tackle. Mrukowski lateraled to Warfield, who cut back at right end for 4. Ferguson was stacked up at left tackle after getting 1. On fourth and 4, Mrukowski passed to Brant in the middle for 7 and first down on the TCU 33. Mrukowski rolled around right end and cut back for 4. Ferguson ran 16 through left guard for first down on the TCU 13, fighting and carrying half a dozen Texans with him until he was finally swarmed under. Mrukowski cut back inside right end for 3. Mrukowski was grabbed trying to pass, but threw the ball anyway. Gibbs intercepted on the TCU goal line and he ran back to the 6.

TCU—(2:30)—Crutcher plunged over right tackle for 1. Crutcher used same play for 1 more. Gibbs sneaked over right tackle for 3. G. Thomas punted to Hess on the Ohio 32 and he returned to the Ohio 47.

OHIO STATE—(0:58)—Wallace rolled out around right end for 5. Wallace passed to Bryant for 14 and first down on the TCU 33. Wallace was spilled trying to pass for a 8-yard loss. Wallace passed to Warfield for 6 to the TCU 36. On 3rd and 13 with 14 seconds remaining Van Raaphorst attempted a 44-yard field goal, which was short and grabbed by Larry Thomas. He reversed his field and was tackled, spilling into the end zone. Officials ruled he was down on the 1-yard line. FINAL SCORE: OHIO STATE 7; TCU 7.

CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS*

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1 — FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2 — RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a **net** figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3 — FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is **no** pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team. The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team

is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4 — LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling — Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards, then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving." Player B is credited with **NO** pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving." Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing.")

(Approved Ruling — Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns." Player B is credited with **NO** return and with 5 yards under "punt returns.")

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing." If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5 — TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of **net** gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are **not** included in total offense.

WILD PASS FROM CENTER.

Any loss resulting from an **obvious** wild pass from center is charged to "center pass," and not to any individual player.
