




QI: Are you satisfied with the general performance of the Greek government so far?





Q2: Do you believe that SYRIZA abandoned its election program?




Q3: Do you feel the Greek government has capitulated to the demands of the creditors?









Q5: Which are the three (3) most important policy areas that the government should emphasize at this moment?










Q6: Under the current circumstances, do you prefer staying or leaving Eurozone?




Q7: Do you believe that Grexit has been avoided?




Q8: Do you believe that Greece is still on the brink of bankruptcy?




