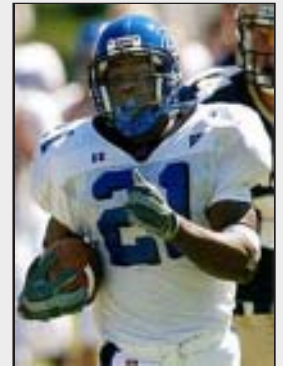

**Improvement** -- The Blue Devils won two of their last three games to finish 4-8 overall and eighth in the ACC with a 2-6 league mark ... Duke's 41-17 win over Georgia Tech (Nov. 8) snapped a 30-game losing streak in ACC play ... the four victories doubled the win total of the previous three seasons combined.

**Under one Roof** -- Ted Roof, a former All-ACC linebacker at Georgia Tech, was named Duke's interim head coach on October 19, replacing Carl Franks ... Roof was later named the school's 20th head coach on December 6 ... guided the Blue Devils to two wins (Georgia Tech & North Carolina) in his five games.

**Departed Devils** -- Duke had two first-team and two second-team All-ACC selections in 2003 ... tailback Chris Douglas was third in the ACC in rushing with 1,138 yards and five TDs ... Douglas ran for 3,122 yards and finished his career second on the ACC's career all-purpose yardage chart with 5,748 yards ... four-year starter Ryan Fowler finished his career with 495 tackles, but fell four tackles short in his bid to become the first player in ACC history to lead his team in tackles for four straight years.

eight games at quarterback as a freshman, throwing for 1,220 yards and a team-high four TDs ... fourth on the team in rushing with 181 yards and one score ... Schneider finished with 1,401 yards in total offense, the 12th-best mark by a freshman in ACC history ... Schneider will be in spring competition with senior Chris Dapolito and sophomore Curt Dukes, a transfer from Nebraska.

**Senior wideouts** -- Senior wide receivers Lance Johnson and Senterrio Landrum are the team's leading returning receivers from 2003 ... Johnson was second on the team last fall with 23 catches for 247 yards and one TD ... Landrum had 11 receptions for 101 yards and was second on the team with 971 all-purpose yards ... Landrum was second in the ACC and seventh nationally in kickoff returns (28.4).

**Dargan Data** -- Cedric Dargan is the team's leading returning rusher after rushing for 264 yards and five TDs as a sophomore in 2003 ... scored a TD in each of the final three games of the season ... ran for a season-high 54 yards on 13 carries versus Tennessee.

**Lone Devil** -- The Blue Devils graduated one four-year starter and three three-year starters (totaling 142 career starts) from their 2003 offensive line ... the team's lone returning offensive line starter is senior tackle Christian Mitchell, who has 26 career starts.

**Tight end trio** -- New offensive coordinator Marty Galbraith welcomes back three tight ends -- Andy Roland, Calen Powell and Andy Patrick - who combined for 40 catches for 606 yards and two TDs a year ago ... Roland has 13 career starts while Powell has started 10 games.

**Alexander the Great** -- Senior defensive end Phillip Alexander was third in the ACC in tackles for loss (18.5) and eighth in quarterback sacks (6.5).

**Top Tackler** -- Junior linebacker Brendan Dewan is the team's leading returning tackler with 91 ... started 11 games in 2003 and had eight games with seven or more tackles.

**Senior Devil Defender** -- Senior cornerback Kenneth Sanford started 11 games last year and was fifth on the team with 63 tackles ... has 31 career passes defended, including a team-high 13 in 2003.

### Ted Roof

Ted Roof, a former All-ACC linebacker at Georgia Tech and Duke's interim head coach for the final five weeks of the 2003 season, was named the program's 20th head coach on December 6, 2003. Under Roof's guidance, Duke snapped a 30-game losing streak in ACC play with a 41-17 victory over Georgia Tech on November 8, and then closed out the season by defeating North Carolina, 30-22, for the Blue Devils' first win over the Tar Heels since 1989. Duke placed two players - Chris Douglas and Matt Zielinski - on the All-ACC first team, marking the first time more than one Blue Devil has been honored with the distinction since 1994, while Ryan Fowler and Terrell Smith were tabbed to the second team all-league unit. Roof, who was nominated in 2000 for

the Broyles Award given to the nation's top assistant coach, previously served as an assistant coach at Duke from 1990-93. Before returning to Durham, Roof was the defensive coordinator at his alma mater from 1999-01. In 2002, Roof directed the Blue Devil defense to marked improvements from the previous season. After finishing ninth in the ACC against the run in 2001, Duke led the league in rushing defense a year later by allowing just 120.5 yards per game on the ground. In 2003, the Blue Devils jumped from ninth in passing defense in the ACC to a third-place standing. Over the past two seasons, the Blue Devils moved from ninth to fifth in the ACC and from 113th to 58th nationally in total defense. At Georgia Tech, Roof coached the linebackers in 1998 before being elevated to defensive coordinator prior to the 1999 season. In 1998, the Yellow Jackets went 10-2, shared the ACC title with Florida State and upended Notre Dame in the Gator Bowl. The 1999 Tech team went 8-4 and finished the year ranked 21st in the Associated Press poll. In 2000, the Yellow Jacket defense ranked 12th in the nation in rushing defense and 20th in scoring defense, allowing just 19.0 points per game, as Georgia Tech posted a 9-3 record and was ranked 17th in the final national poll.
