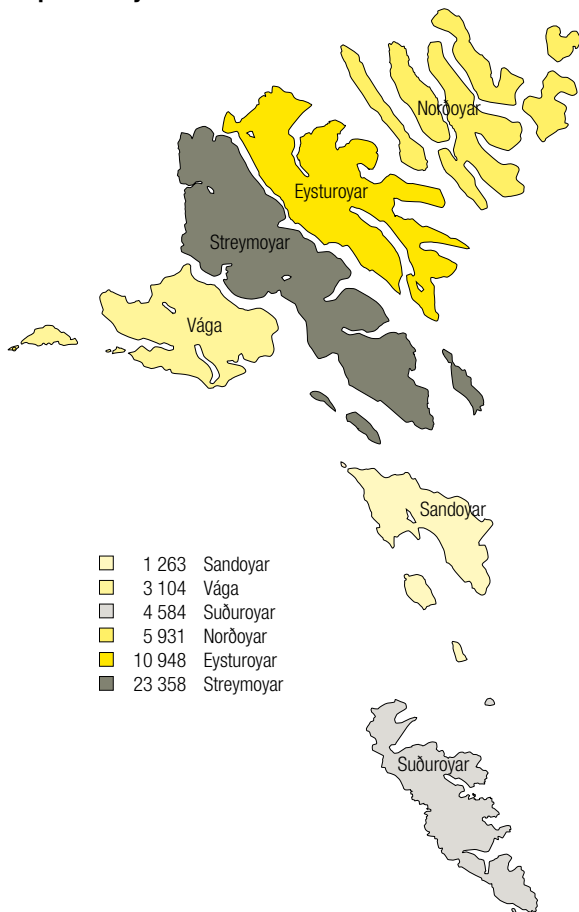

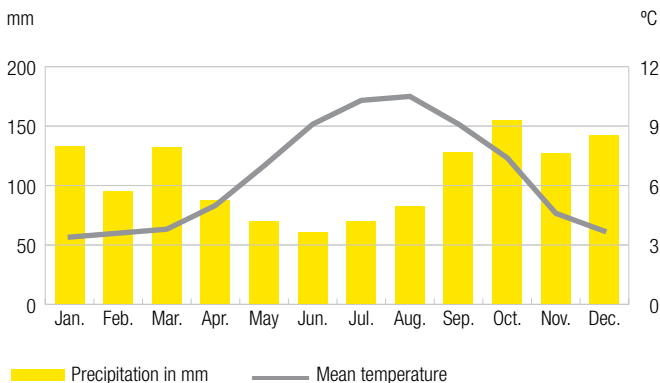

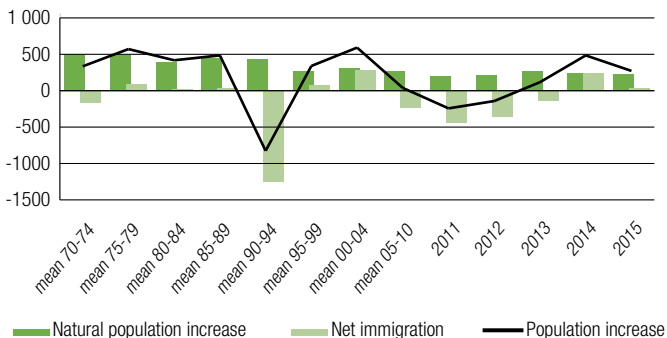

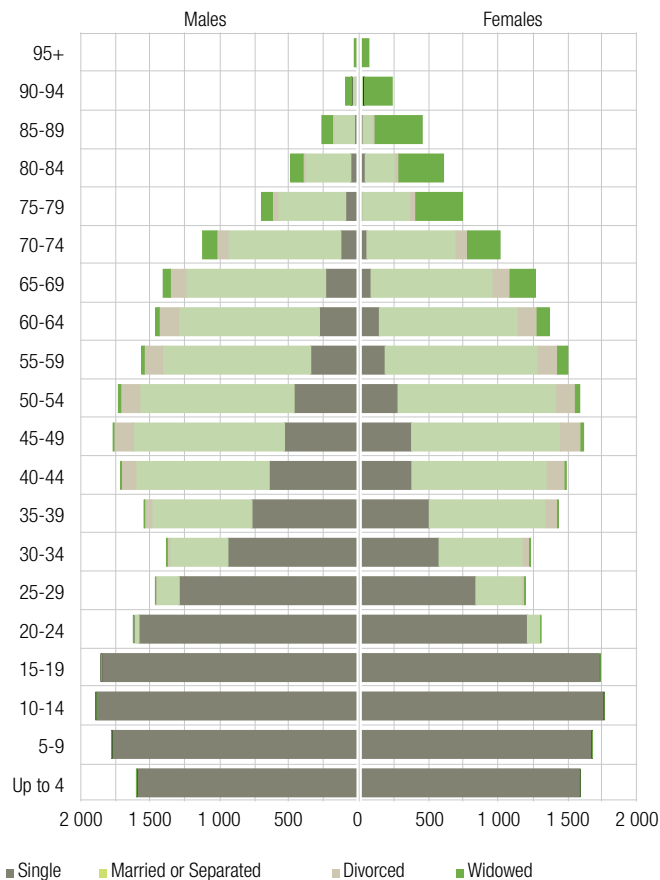

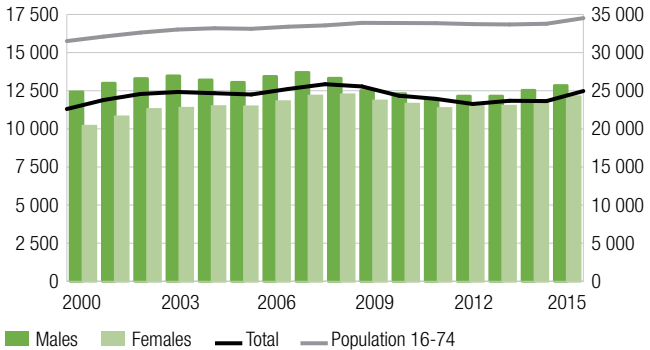

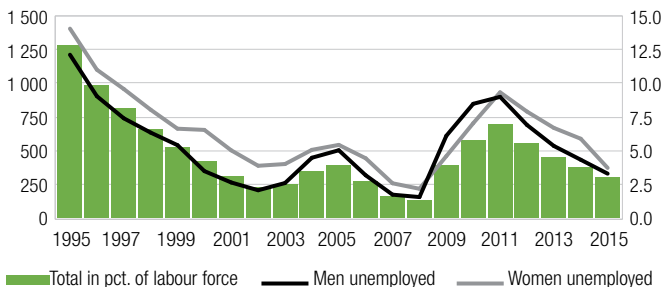

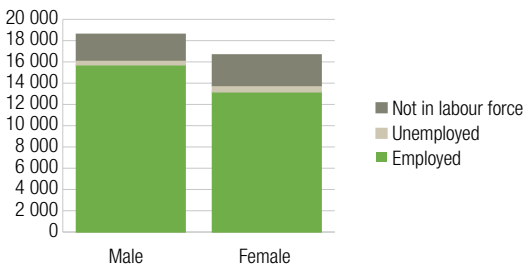

Labour force composition Nov. 2015



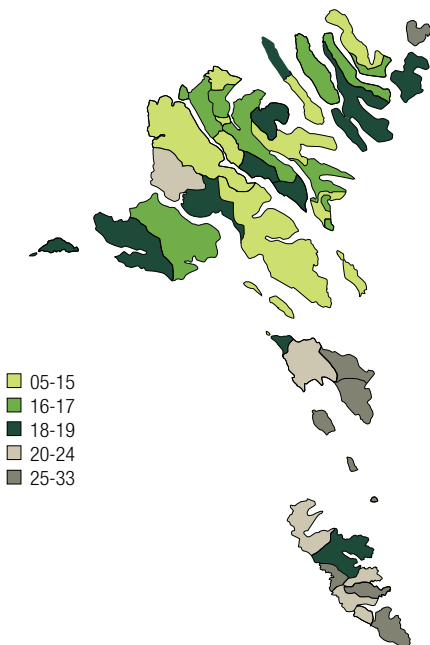

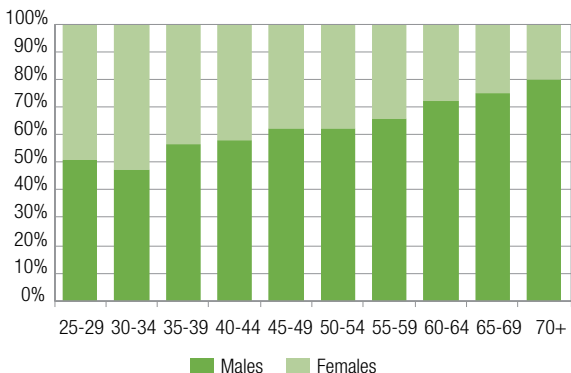

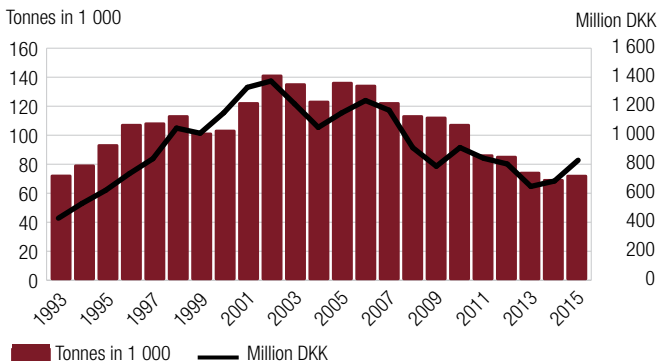

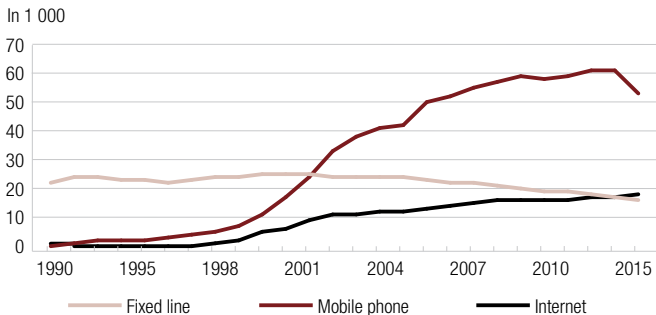

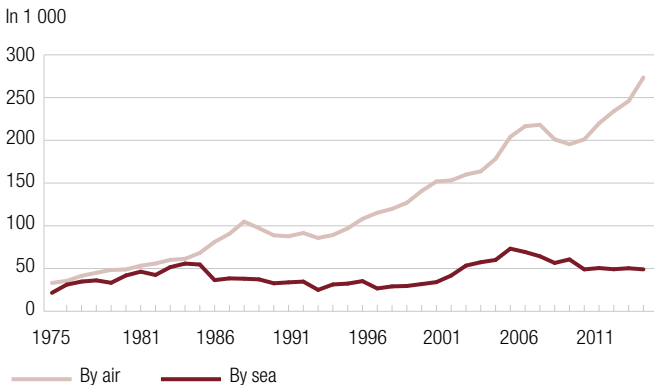

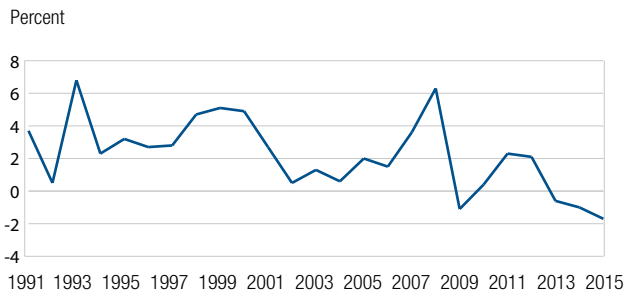

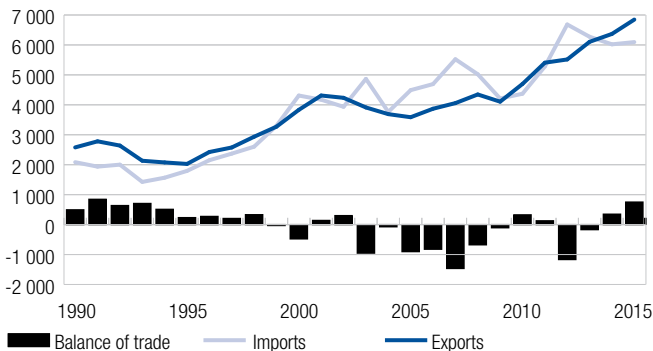

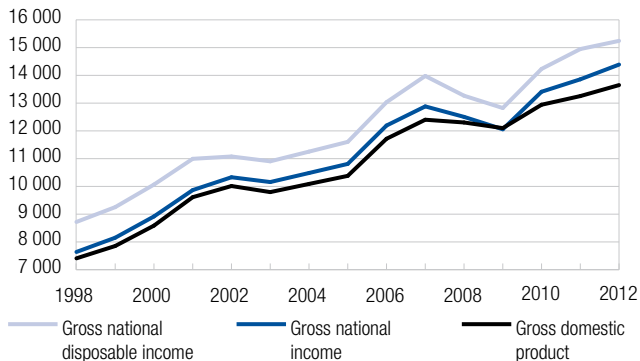
