


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Area: ILO\* unemployment

# In January 2017, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was estimated at 5.4%

- Unemployment rate in January 2017 decreased with 0.1 percentages points as compared to the previous month (5.5%).
- Men's unemployment rate was higher than that of women with 0.9 percentages points.

# **Evolution of the unemployment rate**





The number of unemployed (aged 15-74 years) estimated for January 2017 was of 488 thousand persons, decreasing as compared to the previous month (493 thousand persons), as well as compared to the same month of the previous year (582 thousand persons).

According to the breakdown by gender, men's unemployment rate was with 0.9 percentage points higher than that of women (the values concerned are 5.8% for men and 4.9% for women).

#### Table data (xls)

The unemployment rate of adult persons (aged 25-74 years) was estimated at 4.3% for January 2017 (4.8% in the case of men and 3.7% in that of women's).

The number of unemployed aged 25-74 years accounted for 74.6% of the total number of unemployed estimated for January 2017.
