# 1 Season Overview

Ladies and Gentleman,

Your Executive takes pleasure in presenting the Ninety-Fourth Annual Report and Financial Statements of the Club's activities for the 2014-15 season.

## 1.1 Senior Playing Fields

Unfortunately silverware eluded the Club this season however 2014/15 was a much improved season on field for First Grade finishing runners-up in the Two Day Competition and third in the Overall and One Day Competitions. The Club were also represented in semi-finals by the Second Grade One Day side and Fourth Grade.

In First Grade, there were strong performances across the playing group to contribute to the side's success. Noticeable performances throughout the season included:

- Ronan McDonald – 6/23 vs Ipswich/Logan including a hat-trick. First hat-trick for Toombul in the First Grade Two Day Competition since Tom Gillogly against Valleys in 1976/77 with Cameron Boyce collecting a T20 hat-trick in 2011 also against Valleys (including a catch by Ronan)
- Ryan Harris (125) and Preston White (97) who combined for a new record 5<sup>th</sup> wicket partnership of 162 runs in Round 16 against Norths beating the previous record partnership
- Matthew Renshaw (160) and Chris Sabburg (102) who broke the record set just one week earlier by Ryan and Preston. Against Sunshine Coast the pair put on 205 for the 5<sup>th</sup> wicket after coming together at 4/56.
- Tom Rowley with a maiden First Grade Century (130) in the Semi Final at quick pace to allow the Bulls to set a target that proved too much for second placed Norths.



A consistent performer throughout the season, Preston White proved his all-round worth to the side and collected this season's Cricketer of the Year award. He scored 554 runs in the two day competition including a belligerent 106\* off 60 in the second innings of the Grand Final which saw him pass 2,000 runs in First Grade. He also collected 29 wickets with a combination of swing and spin with a best of 7/88 against Wynnum Manly. Preston's performances earned him a top 10 finish in the Burge Medal count.

In the lower grades the standout performance of the season went to an unlikely recipient, groundsman Grantly Hodgins. In Round 2, Grantly filled in for Sixth Grade against Souths and volunteered to open the batting after being sent in. At 1/0 Grantly was joined at the crease by Caleb Risson and together they put on 287 for the second wicket before Risson was dismissed for 130. Grantly then kicked into gear and powered on before eventually falling for a new Sixth Grade highest score of 287 off just 195 balls with 24 boundaries and 13 sixes as the side posted 7d/490 off just 60 overs.

## ***1.2 Our Juniors***

This season the Club's Juniors swelled in numbers once again. The Club now has over 500 registered Juniors and Milo In2Cricketers. The Club is indebted to the Juniors committee led by President John Martin for their continued support and involvement.

Many thanks also to the reliable band of volunteers who helped throughout the year, especially on Friday Nights with our thriving concept that has now grown to 16 teams and is a wonderful whole of Club activity.

## ***1.3 Representative Honours***

### **Australian Honours**

This year the Club has been represented by several players at the national level.

Ryan Harris played three test matches for Australia against India which ultimately were his final appearances for the nation. Ryan managed a new top score with 74 in the Boxing Day Test and added a further 10 wickets to take his international tally to an impressive 113 wickets at 23.52 from 27 Test Matches. Ryan will be sorely missed by the national side and this has already been evident in the recent Ashes Test Series where the side lacked his reliable and consistent bowling.

Cameron Boyce made his T20 International debut in the UAE and hit the ground running with 2/10 off his 4 overs against Pakistan. Since that game Cameron has been Australia's first choice T20 spinner, notching a further three appearances against South Africa in Australia collecting four wickets in that series at an average of just 19.

Throughout the year Cameron Boyce and Chris Lynn have also been selected to represent Australia A whilst Matthew Renshaw has played for Australia Under 19s.



### Queensland Bulls

Cameron Boyce was the Club's sole representative as Queensland attempted to retain the Matador BBQ One Day Cup. Cameron played in 6 of the fixtures, collecting four wickets to help the Bulls to second place and an Elimination Final appearance. In the final, Boyce bowled well to claim 1/16 off 4 overs removing the set batsman Peter Nevill before being taken out of the attack and not returning despite being one of the most economical of the bowlers as the Bulls total was overrun with 2 balls to spare.

The Club was well represented in the Sheffield Shield competition with five players, including debuts from Charlie Hemphrey and Matthew Renshaw. Chris Lynn put his name in lights for higher honours with a destructive 250 against Victoria along with two half centuries in another injury shortened season to finish with a First Class average of 63 for the summer and career at 46. Charlie Hemphrey also impressed with a maiden first class century, posting 118 against South Australia in the final round of the Shield season.

### Big Bash

This season the Club had two players on show during the Big Bash with Lynny lining up for the Brisbane Heat and Boycey playing for the Hobart Hurricanes.

Boycey again performed strongly for the Hurricanes as he collected another 10 wickets to match his stats from last season. He also added some handy lower order runs at the very impressive strike rate of 186 as Hobart fell short in the grand final against Perth.

Lynny was the leading run-scorer for the Heat with a best of 81 off just 35 balls with 12 fours and three sixes against Boyce's Hurricanes.

## 1.4 Grounds & Facilities

During the 2014/15 season the Club was successful in attaining grant funding to install security lighting at Oxenham Park and \$10,000 to undertake Strategic & Master Planning for the Club. The Club has engaged a consultant to undertake the Master Planning which will put the Club in a good position for coming seasons. Works are underway to improve the training nets with new netting, increased heights and new doors on the complex.

The Club has moved to employ a fulltime groundsman, with Grantly Hodgins accepting the position. The move to a fulltime groundsman has been taken to improve the appearance of the surrounds, standard of wickets and allow the Club to host representative fixtures.

### ***1.5 Vale Errold La Frantz***

This season saw the passing of the man most synonymous with the Toombul District Cricket Club, Errold La Frantz MBE. For over 83 years Errold was a member of the Club, first as a player, then administrator and finally Life Member and Supporter. Words cannot do justice to the legacy of this great man and the mark he has left, not only on our Club but also cricket in general within the state. A left-handed batsman, Errold played 15 seasons of First Grade for the Club and a solitary match for Queensland in 1941-42 before serving in World War II. He went on to be a State selector and leading figure in Brisbane Grade and Junior cricket in particular where he helped create the first organised Junior Cricket Association in Queensland, along with fellow Club Life Member Cec Anstey and George Christensen.

He received Life Membership of Toombul DCC in 1958, Queensland Cricket in 1971 and Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association in 2001. At the time of his passing, he was the oldest Life Member of Toombul DCC and QC.

### ***1.6 Old Boys***

This season the Club fielded sides in the Sunday Legends T20 and Over 40s One Day competitions to encourage TDCC Old Boys back to the Club.

During the offseason, Andrew Knight undertook the momentous task of tracing the history of the Club to determine the First Grade Cap Numbers. An arduous task, searching through online records and newspapers dating back to 1897, however the Club is indebted to his efforts that developed the list with Toby Abernathy, our most recent debutant, being the 612<sup>th</sup> First Grade player.

### ***1.7 Committee***

Your committee for the past season has had a good blend of playing and non-playing members and has enjoyed good stability from previous seasons. The Club thanks departing Committee members Nathan Byrne and Ian Renshaw for their services.

### ***1.8 Conclusion***

In conclusion we hope that the upcoming season will see the Club build on the successes of this season. We recognise the contribution of all the volunteers (especially Irene, Kate and Gav) throughout the season and thank them for their services.

This harsh reminder of the risks associated with our beloved game, gave way to an international outpouring of support. The term #putoutyourbats and the numbers 408 and 63\* are now a part of the fabric that makes up Australian cricket.

Just a few short months ago, Toombul lost its icon. Club members often sing that the history of Brisbane cricket is dressed in red and blue, but without Errold La Frantz there is no history of Brisbane cricket. For the nearly 50 members who attended his funeral, we were reminded of just how much this man had given to the club and game he loved. Having the opportunity to be on his field on the Friday night and Saturday morning during the minute silences will again be memories I will hold dear. A life well lived, through depressions, serving in World War II, to businessman, coach, selector, founding Brisbane junior cricket, an entire speech could be dedicated to Errold's achievements and awards.

It isn't just his achievements that I will remember. It was his grace and humility. His ability to make you feel like you were making a difference, even from beyond the grave. If you will indulge me for a moment, during his eulogy his daughter spoke of the last time he came down to Toombul. It wasn't a Saturday, rather a Friday night. Errold had come down to see what was happening on his field under lights. For an hour, he sat and watched as the children ran out and played the game he loved, at the club he built. He went home proud, and would talk of the great things happening at Toombul to everyone he came across. To be able to make a man such as Errold proud through what we as a club have achieved in recent years fills me with great happiness and pride, not sadness.

Sure there will not be another letter or speech at the Annual General Meeting, or a quiet conversation while watching a game, for that time has passed. Every time that a player, be it a boy, a girl, a 4 year old or a 64 year old, steps onto a field wearing a maroon cap with the badge of TDCC, that will be the legacy of Errold La Frantz MBE. Vale Errold, thank you for the history of Brisbane cricket, may we keep it dressed in red and blue.

I would like to acknowledge the love and support of my family again this year, without you it would not be possible for me to be here.

Finally to the people who make up the Toombul community, you who play, cheer and volunteer. Thank you for your support, your ideas, your assistance and your passion for all things Toombul.

It's good to be a Bull.

## ***2.2 Treasurer's Report***

The result for the year is an accounting profit of \$28,588 compared to a profit of \$7,114 in 2014. After excluding non-cash expenses (e.g. depreciation) and timing adjustments, the net cash position for the club increased by \$63,620.40 during the financial year, with total cash at 30 April 2015 of \$93,342.85.

This is very pleasing and continues to build on the good financial platform established over recent years. This has been made possible through the hard work and diligence of the committee and club volunteers.

The result for the year was affected by the following:

- A significant contribution from our Junior division through sponsors and improved registration fees;
- Growth in Friday night cricket for junior teams and In2Cricket. This enabled further fundraising opportunities for the Club through bar and canteen;
- A significant increase in bar and canteen takings through the introduction of EFTPOS facilities and POS system;
- Investment in quality of grounds and surrounds with employment of full time groundsman;
- Reduction in revenue from Sponsors for the Senior Club and fundraising through raffles;
- Increase in insurance premiums;
- Purchase in club clothing (to be used for 2014/15 and 2015/16 seasons);
- Successful application for Brisbane City Council Grant to fund strategic plan for the club;

Overall, we have strengthened the financial position of the club, placing us in a position to undertake major projects in the upcoming financial year, including repairs to the practice nets and improvements to the grounds and surrounds, for which we will be assisted by funding from sources such as Queensland Cricket and Brisbane City Council.

### ***2.3 Club Coach's Report***

The 2014-15 season was my first in charge as a head coach at Toombul. Previously I had assisted Nick Fitzpatrick before and felt that I had a good grasp on the playing group through all the grades and was keen to see the club build on previous successes and move forward.

Trying to balance the demands of varying levels of cricket skill, dedication and goals is always a challenge with a large group as well as achieving outcomes and goals from outside the playing group. I went into the season confident we could get at least half our teams involved in finals and the goal of winning a premiership in any grade. Our first grade still had the bulk of the core that won a premiership a couple of seasons back and I felt the depth to back them up was present and this should see the second grade team build on their 20/20 premiership from the year before.

We had three players achieve Australian honours before the season had gotten underway, with Cameron Boyce joining Chris Lynn and Ryan Harris at the highest level, after playing 20/20 for Australia. Even though as a club coach, we probably don't have a great influence over our representative players, it's a great for the club to see our players in those teams.

One of the great positives for our club is the willingness of our representative players to come back to club and give back to those here in the lower grades or connected by our junior club. Ryan probably spent more games with us than he would have liked but was always happy to contribute in any way he could. Chris and Cameron were great for me, whether it was to bounce ideas off or asking them if they could take a specialised session here or there and I am very thankful they have a strong connection to the club.

One of the goals for TDCC is to develop and contribute players to the next level, which is playing for the QLD Bulls. Chris and Cameron are both players firmly entrenched in the Bulls line up, but it was great to see Charlie Hemphrey and Matt Renshaw both make Shield debuts in the latter half of the season. Ronan McDonald and Sam Rowley both played at QAS level with Sam Rowley also achieving Australian U/19 selection after a strong showing in the state title. Preston White, Mark Thompson and Jackson Paton represented QLD at the Imparja Cup, with Preston captaining the side.

It was a pity we couldn't turn the depth we have at the moment into any premierships in any form of the game and I feel that we need to capitalise on this while we still have it. We have been on the bottom for a while, especially through the early 2000s and it is not often you have strong teams all through the grades. As a club we need to be aiming high and playing to our potential because we have the players to win games as well as competitions. I would like to thank the committee for all their support. David Oldham, Andrew Oldham and Simon Mammino have all been a great help. The other people who have been on the committee of the last two seasons who have offered me support, I thank you as well. Gavin Fitness and Nick Fitzpatrick were great coaches to learn from and bounce ideas off. Warren Dillon and Daniel Mills who both had a season in charge with the Taverners while I have been in a coaching position. Ian Renshaw and Harry Frei were a great help throughout the season passing on some knowledge to those who wanted to listen. To all the players in the club, from the first graders to the six graders to the Taverners, I would like to offer a big and heartfelt thank you. You were the guys who came to training each and every session, did everything I asked with a minimal fuss, tried to follow my ideas when sometimes the explanations didn't seem to make sense and always put in at training. It has been a pleasure to be the head coach of the club I love and I hope I have somewhat improved you all not only as cricketers but as people.

Finally one last thank you. Chic Leeder. Your sacrifice to the club has never gone unnoticed by me. First to training every night, making sure the players were organised and looked after. I sometimes think you made it too easy for them. Organising the batting and bowling line ups for me for the nets to making sure the top grade was looked after and didn't need anything. But most of all I thank you for your friendship. It has been a great privilege to work alongside you and I don't think the club, especially the first graders, realise how much you actually did for the players. ### **Round 1 v University of Queensland at UQ #2.**

UQ 118 & 4/59 defeated Toombul 114 & 7/92 dec on first innings.

This narrow defeat was the closest we came to a win. Jordan Cabot won the toss and Toombul batted first, posting 114 from 49 overs. The UQ opening bowling pair were the Queensland Under Sixteen opening bowling pair. Under immediate pressure we slumped to 6/44 before Rob Lutton 26 (59), Joey Davissen 22 (49) and Jackson Paton 15\* (55) gave us a meagre total to defend. Our bowling group competed strongly, keeping us in the match. Ryan Wilson was the most successful bowler with 5/26 (10.1). Dave Memmott 2/25 and Jay De Zubicaray 2/6 (4) were the other multiple wicket takers.

In our second innings Jordan top scored with 34 (92). Pursuing an unlikely outright win we declared. In the thirteen overs that followed Dave captured 4/14 (6).

Positives from this narrow loss were increased belief within the group that they could compete and the performance of the bowling group. Opportunities for improvement were identified as placing a higher value on your wicket when batting, avoiding losing wickets in groups and the importance of momentum during the match.

### **Round 2 v Norths at Ken Mackay Oval.**

Norths 3/154 dec & 1/37 defeated Toombul 150 & 114 on first innings.

Jordan again won the toss and Toombul batted first. The batting group showed determination, facing lots of balls and placing a high value on their wickets. Jay topped scored with an entertaining 41 (57). The bowling group again performed at a high standard and competed strongly for long periods. Jackson and Dave bowled particularly well without luck. When Norths declared, two batsman had shown great application and batsmanship posting scores of 74\* (158) and 47\* (207). Highlights of our second batting innings included Ryan Wilson 20 (68) and Ryan Pitts 21 (39). A number of batsmen applied themselves well and looked comfortable at the crease. Disappointingly, loss of concentration and poor shot selection / execution led to soft dismissals and the loss of wickets in groups.

Increased emphasis on batting technique, application, match awareness and the importance of momentum featured in the training sessions that followed.

**Round 3 v Valley at La Franz Oval.**

Valley 8/285 dec defeated Toombul 69 & 82 outright

Valley won the toss and chose to bat. Rob captained Toombul in this match.

The bowling group applied consistent pressure and reaped rewards. Valley lost 6 wickets cheaply before scores of 63 from number six, 103\* from number eight and 33\* from number 11 saw Valley post a commanding total. Jackson 3/19 (12), Dave 2/56 (14) and Rob 2/58 (14) impressed with the ball.

In both innings our batting was again disappointing. In the first innings only Brandon 17 (91) and Jay 18 (40) occupied the crease for a significant period. In the second innings Joey 24 (33) and Jordan 20 (76) contributed most of the runs.

Emphasis at training focused on improving batting technique and batsmanship.

**Round 4 v Sunshine Coast at Kev Hackney Oval.**

Sunshine Coast 4/214 defeated Toombul 8/126 by 88 runs.

Sunshine Coast won the toss, chose to bat posting a daunting total in this forty over match. Rob captained Toombul in this match and returned the best bowling figures of 1/26 (8). Joey 28 (42) and Ryan Pitts 26\* (19) contributed most of the runs.

**Round 5 v Sandgate Redcliffe at Dixon Oval.**

Sandgate Redcliffe 198 defeated Toombul 138 & 4/164 on first innings.

Rob won the toss and Toombul batted first. Ryan Wilson 37 (73) and Joey 33 (50) provided a solid opening partnership of 59. Jordan, Jay and Rowan Donohue all occupied the crease for extended periods. Again losing wickets in groups eroded the good start resulting in vulnerable total. Rowan 3/38 (14.2), Jackson 2/33 (15) and Dave 2/57 (14) all bowled very well keeping Toombul in the contest for long periods.

Our second innings highlight was the batting highlight of the season as Jordan scored 92\* (139) featuring a partnership with Evan 38\* (63). Brandon again occupied the crease for an extended period.
