

19 26. Getting infected with genital herpes from Raymond has devastated [REDACTED]

20 She feels that her health and body have been ruined. From the day she was infected  
21 continuing to the present, [REDACTED] has suffered severe emotional distress and has been  
22 extremely depressed. In [REDACTED] she cried all the time and did not want to leave her  
23 house. Not a day has gone by where she does not feel desolation and despair about her  
24 herpes infection knowing that there is no cure. Her infection has destroyed her sense of self,  
25 wholeness, health and beauty and she fears that she will never be able to have the type of  
26 relationship she had hoped for.

9 19. On March 16, [REDACTED] told Raymond that he had given her genital herpes.  
10 She had told him that he had devastated her, ruined her body, and their relationship.  
11 Raymond was very apologetic and promised to figure things out.

12 20. On March 17 or 18, Raymond called [REDACTED] at her house with his doctor on  
13 the phone. [REDACTED]'s mother was at her house caring for her and the two of them spoke to  
14 Raymond and his doctor on the speaker phone. Raymond's doctor advised [REDACTED] and  
15 her mother that Raymond had been diagnosed with genital herpes in 2009 or 2010.

16 21. [REDACTED] is informed and believes that Raymond knew he was infected with  
17 genital herpes in 2009 or 2010. [REDACTED] is informed and believes that Raymond learned  
18 that he was infected with genital herpes after they started their relationship and engaged in  
19 unprotected sex. And after learning that he was infected with genital herpes, Raymond  
20 consciously and purposefully withheld that information from her and continued to have  
21 unprotected sex with her. By engaging in unprotected sex with her without disclosing his  
22 infection, Raymond knowingly and consciously exposed [REDACTED] to the virus and did not  
23 give her the opportunity to protect herself from infection.

24 22. [REDACTED] received the results of her blood test on March 20. The test results  
25 indicated that she was positive for genital herpes and her doctor told her that it was a first-  
26 time infection. [REDACTED] is informed and believes that classical first outbreaks typically  
27 occur within seven to twenty-one days after initial exposure or infection with genital herpes.  
28 Based on the timing and nature of her outbreak, [REDACTED] is informed and believes that

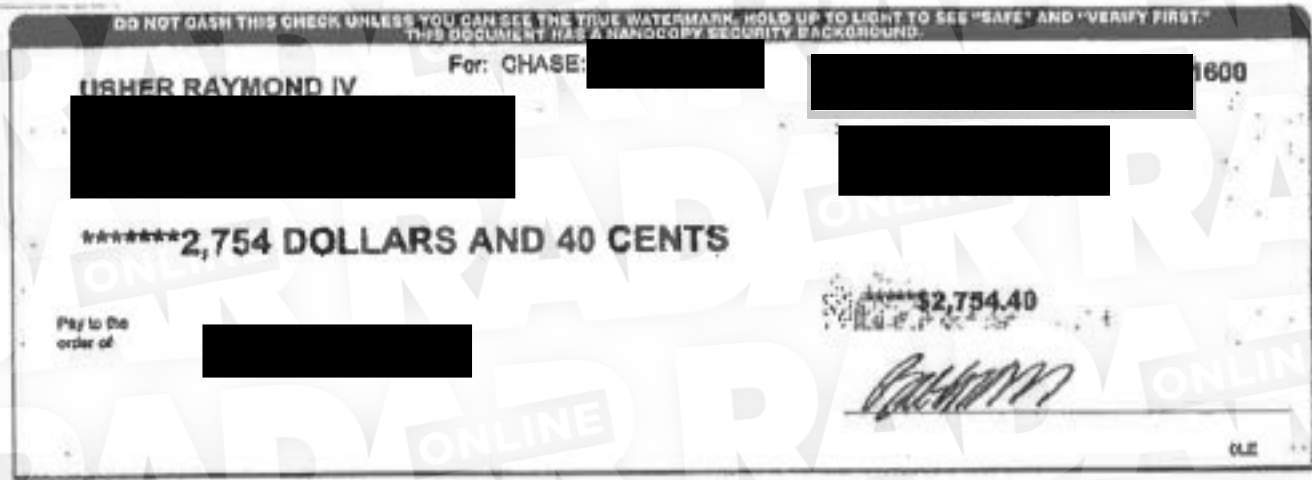

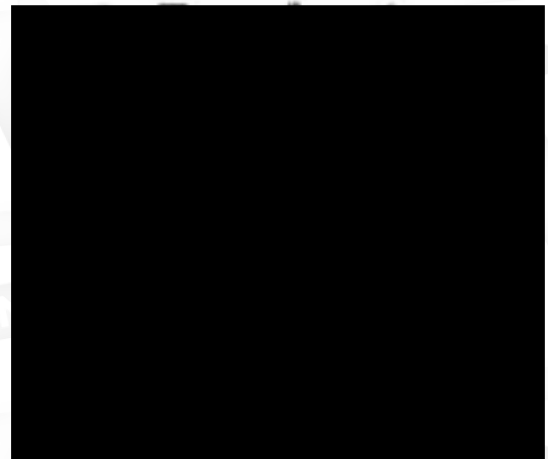
