



STATES AND LOCALITIES THAT HAVE RAISED THE MINIMUM LEGAL SALE AGE FOR TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO 21

As of April 17, 2018, five states – California, New Jersey, Oregon, Hawaii and Maine – have raised the tobacco age to 21, along with at least 300 localities, including New York City, Chicago, San Antonio, Boston, Cleveland and both Kansas Cities. Some of the 300 localities are in the states that subsequently enacted statewide laws.
