IMPORT PRICE INDEX – December 2018 Quarter (Base Period: March 2009 quarter = 100.0)

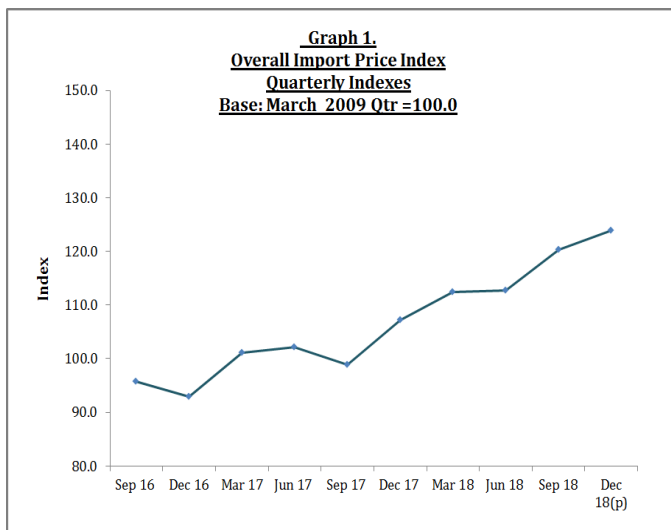
Highlights of the quarter

- Import Price index rose 3.1 percent from the September 2018 quarter.
- Mineral Products index recorded the largest increase (up 5.8 percent).

Overview

The Import Price Index for the December 2018 quarter showed an overall increase of 3.1 percent from the September 2018 quarter. This increase was mainly driven by higher prices for mineral products. In comparison with the December 2017 quarter, the current import price index rose 15.6 percent.

The four quarters ending December 2018 showed a 14.7 percent increase in the overall import price index when compared with the four quarters ending December 2017 quarter. See table 1 and graph 1.

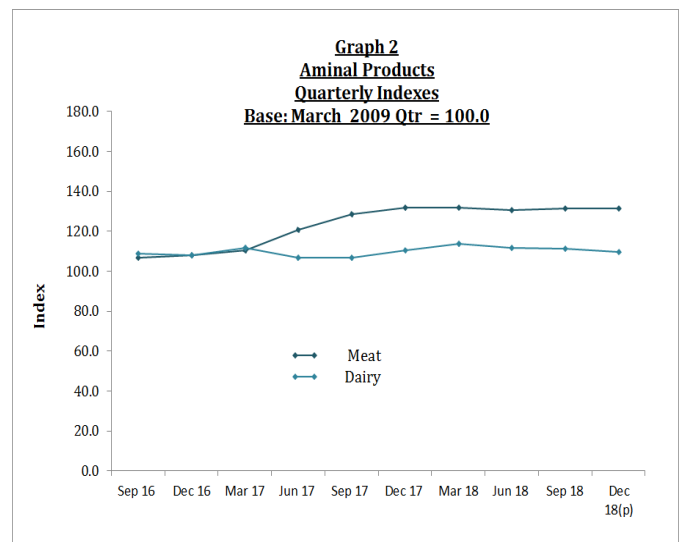

HS Section 1: Live Animals; Animal Products prices fall 0.3%.

Import prices for Live Animals and Animal Products in the December 2018 quarter fell 0.3 percent. This fall was mainly influenced by dairy products reflecting lower prices of liquid milk (down 3.2 percent), powder milk (down 1.5 percent) and butter (down 1.5 percent). In comparison with the December 2017 quarter, the current live animals and animal products index decreased 0.3 percent.

Reviewing the four quarters ending December 2018 over the four quarters ending December 2017, the current overall animals and animal products index increased 5.7 percent. See tables 1 & 2 and graph 2.



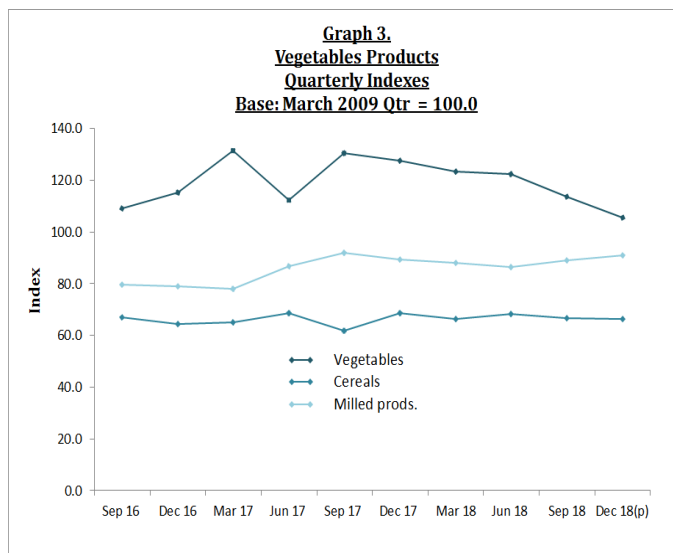

HS Section 2: Vegetable Products prices fall 0.7%.

Import prices for Vegetable Products in the December 2018 quarter fell 0.7 from the September 2018 quarter. This fall was mainly

driven by lower prices of vegetable products (down 7.3 percent) reflecting lower prices of potatoes (down 22.5 percent). Prices for cereal products also decreased (down 0.5 percent). In comparison with the December 2017 quarter, the current vegetables products index decreased 4.1 percent.

Reviewing the four quarters ending December 2018 over the four quarters ending December 2017, the current overall vegetable products index decreased 0.3 percent. See tables 1 & 2 and graph 3.

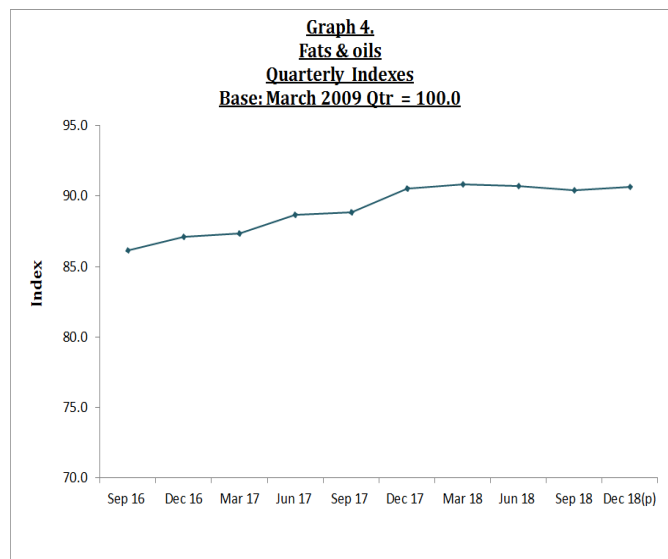

HS Section 3: Animal or Vegetable fats & oils prices rise 0.3%.

Import prices for Animal or Vegetable Fats and Oil rose 0.3 percent in the December 2018 quarter. The rise over the previous quarter was mainly influenced by higher prices of hydrogenated oils (up 2 percent). When compared with the December 2017 quarter, the current animal or vegetable fats and oils index increased 0.1 percent.

The four quarters ending December 2018 showed a 2.1 percent increase in the overall animal or vegetable fats and oils index over the four quarters ending December 2017. See tables 1 & 2 and graph 4.

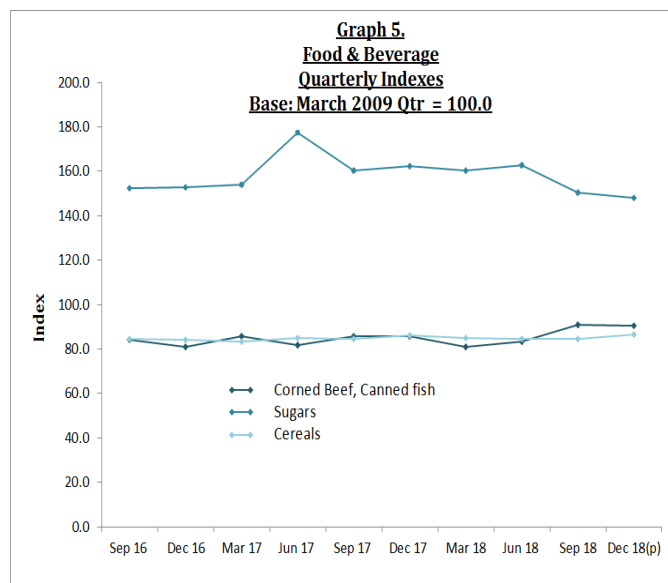

HS Section 4: Food and Beverages prices fall 0.1%.

Food and Beverage import prices fell 0.1 percent in the December 2018 quarter. This fall was mainly driven by sugar (down 1.8 percent). Prices of canned meat/fish also decreased (down 0.3 percent) reflecting lower prices of corned beef (down 6.7 percent). In comparison with the December 2017 quarter, the current food and beverages index decreased 1.1 percent.

When comparing the four quarters ending December 2018 with the four quarters ending December 2017, the current overall food and beverages index decreased 1.0 percent. See tables 1 & 2 and graph 5.

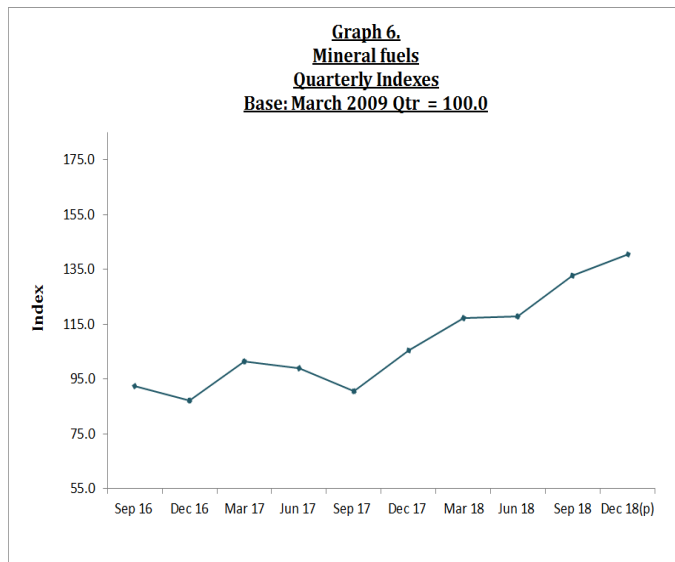

HS Section 5: Mineral Products prices rise 5.8%.

Mineral products import prices recorded a 5.8 percent increase in the December 2018 quarter. When compared with the December 2017 quarter, the current mineral products index increased 33.3 percent.

The overall mineral products index in the four quarters ending December 2018 was 28.3 percent higher when compared with the four quarters ending December 2017. See tables 1 & 2 and graph 6.

Technical Notes

The Import Price Index (MPI) measures changes in the cost, insurance, and freight (CIF) prices of imports of merchandise into Samoa. It is a fixed weight index with March 2009 quarter = 100.0 and is calculated on a quarterly basis using the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS). The items included in the index were selected on the basis of their importance to the total import.

The scope of the MPI relates to the following sections of the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS): 1. Live Animals: Animal Products, 2. Vegetable Products, 3. Animal or Vegetable fats and oils, 4. Food and Beverages and 5. Mineral Products, The index represents 50 percent of total Imports.

The MPI report for March 2019 quarter is expected to be available on 10th May 2019.
