

**Preface**

After four years promotion of the 17 SDGs the 193 countries agreed on in 2015 in Addis Ababa, five reports on the progress of the SDGs appeared in summer 2019.

This synopsis shows which of the 17 Goals were addressed in priority and which ones were left behind.

The results are featured here in order to consider the interlinkages between the Goals. E.g. the five major Goals Health, Energy, Climate, Water and Education in regions of conflict entirely depend on Goal 16 which is Peace. As well Poverty cannot be reduced without reducing inequalities and creating social cohesion. Same with Gender Equality. And, of course, improving Energy supply needs Technology and as a result leads to SDG Goal Clean Energy. But the saddest finding is the last rank for maintaining our biodiversity on Land and below Water.
