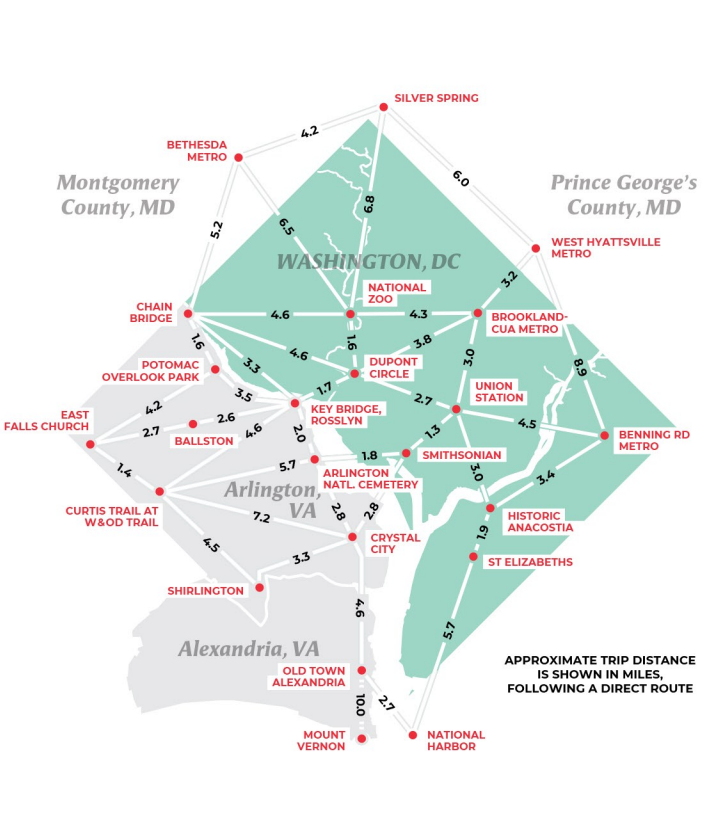


**Trip Distances**

Capital Bikeshare for All is available to individuals who qualify for certain local, state, and federal assistance programs including SNAP, WIC, TANF, SSI/SSDI, LIHEAP, and Medicaid. Features: \$5 annual membership, access to bikes 24/7 year-round, 60 min of ride time, and no usage fees. Must be 16 years or older to ride.
