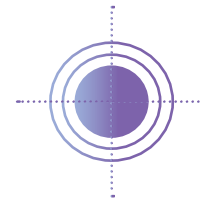

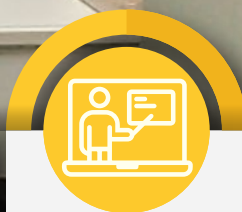

Bustan-e Sa'di

Sa'di is a great Iranian poet and writer of the 7th century AH. After studying in Baghdad and many trips to different countries of the world, he returned to Iran and wrote valuable masterpieces about human life and ethics, as in Bustan and Gulistan. This is a course to introduce Saadi's thoughts and teachings, which is offered based on special textbooks for Persian students.

Gulistan-e Sa'di

This book by Sa'di has eight chapters on various topics: the Kings Morality, the Ethics of Dervishes, the Virtue of Contentment, the Benefits of Silence, Love and Youth, the Impact of Education and Speaking Etiquette. Its text is fluent and simple, in a way that it has had an extraordinary effect on keeping the Persian language simple. Sa'di's different life experiences as a true adventurer, and his wisdom and thoughtfulness, has a mature and realistic influence on his writings in Gulistan where he speaks of great concepts that are still pertinent today.

Masnavi Ma'navi, by Jalāl ad-Dīn Muhammad Balkhī, another great Iranian poet of 7th century AH, is the most important mystical book in the Persian-speaking world and it can rightly be considered, along with Dante's Divine Comedy, the greatest masterpiece of mystical literature in the world. This valuable book offers many human and moral messages, transcending borders. Translations of Masnavi into various languages and the acceptance of it by people of other countries, prove this book's powerful impact and recognition as a world masterpiece.

Masnavi Ma'navi

In this course, students get acquainted with a selection of Maulana Jalaluddin Mohammad Molavi Balkhi Rumi's lyric poems and learn various points about words, grammatical constructions and literary arrays of Maulana poetry. Rumi is well-known and famous all over the world and his poems have been translated into many languages of the world, but the literary and linguistic subtleties of his poems are best revealed in Persian because Rumi wrote his poems in Persian. Rumi has composed most of his lyric poems in memory of his mystic master, Shams Tabrizi.

Dekhoda program is not limited to only learning Persian language, but it also offers learning Iranian culture, literature and art. These courses add diversity to your learning at Dekhoda, studying the ancient culture, literature and arts of Iran.

Divan of Hafez

Divan of Hafez, one of the eminent poets of 8th century AH, is a book that can rightly be considered one of the greatest literary masterpieces in the world. Ethical lessons, philosophical points, mystical jokes and many social critiques shine in the golden pages of this valuable book and give freshness to the soul and heart of the reader. Although Divan of Hafez is deeply intertwined with the Persian language, its human and moral messages are certainly not limited to Iran and the Persian language, creating links with those that appreciate beauty and perfectionism all around the world. Hence, Hafez's rich poems are also instructive and uplifting for the inhabitants of other lands.

Persian Contemporary Poetry

Persian literature is one of the oldest, most extensive, richest, and most popular examples of literature in the world, and Persian poetry has a special place in the field of world poetry. Great Persian-speaking poets such as Ferdowsi, Khayyam, Maulana, Saadi, and Hafez are well-known all over the world and have many devotees. Students get acquainted with the life and works of a number of famous Iranian poets in the present century and learn points about the characteristics of contemporary Persian poetry and the minds and languages of contemporary poets.

Shahnameh Ferdowsi

Shahnameh is the greatest Iranian epic book by Hakim Abolghasem Ferdowsi, an epic poet of the 4th century AH. This book includes three important parts: mythology, heroism and history, and contains many Iranian customs and cultural parameters, and at the same time, in the mythological part, it shows the commonality of Iranian myths with world myths.

Manteq-al-Tair Attar

Mantiq al-Tair is a mystical poetry by Attar Neyshabouri, a poet and mystic of the 6th and 7th centuries AH, who teaches his audience interesting and wonderful materials about the basic terms of mysticism, wisdom and knowledge.

Art and Iranology Courses

This course is dedicated to the introduction and study of Iran's long history (dating back more than 2,500 years) covering different political periods to present day Iran.

Iranian History

Calligraphy is one of the visual arts that has a long history and great importance in Iran and Persian language. Ancient Iranian calligraphers, emphasizing aesthetic principles, have left us several scripts and methods of calligraphy that have countless devotees. In this course: Nasta'liq, Broken Nasta'liq and Script Writing are taught from the treasure of Iranian calligraphy.

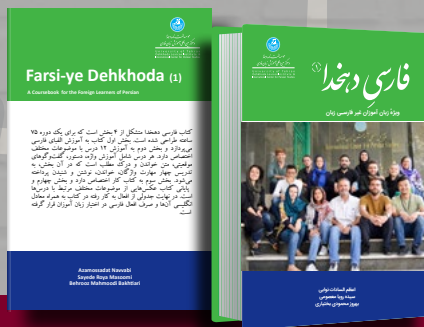
Calligraphy Course

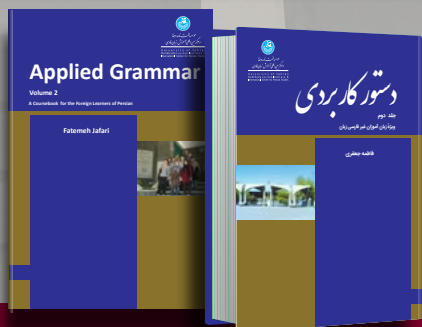

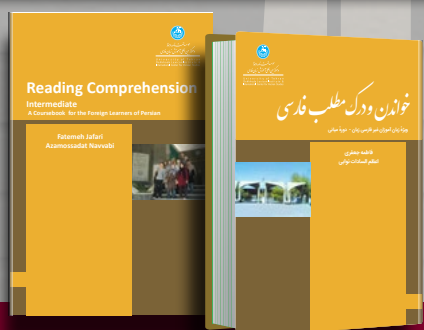

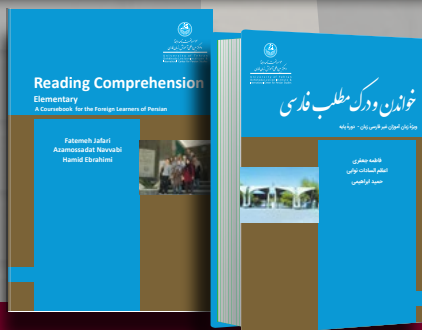

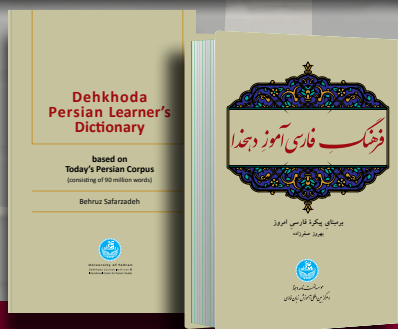
