FAQs



How can I find out what's on?

This programme lists all the Festival14 events. Please read the event entry to find out the time, location and whether you will need a ticket for that event. Our website and the Canary Wharf App will also have the most up to date information.

Do I need a ticket?

The majority of the events are not ticketed, however some of our events with more limited capacity will be ticketed. Please check the individual event entry for details. If the event is not ticketed you can just turn up on the day. However, if a venue has reached capacity you may find the venue has closed or has a queuing system in place.

What happens if it rains?

Unfortunately we cannot guarantee sunshine but a little bit of rain won't stop us! We aim to go ahead whatever the weather so please dress appropriately if you are attending an outdoor event. In case of extreme weather conditions we may adapt or cancel events.

Is the festival family friendly?

Yes, the majority of our events are suitable for the whole family and we have a programme of events especially for our youngest audience members. There are a few exceptions with a number of theatre and comedy events which are recommended for 16+ years.

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, well behaved dogs on leads are welcome. Please just bear in mind some events will be noisy and crowded so please consider whether your pet will be comfortable. Please note dogs are not allowed in some indoor venues and retail areas except Assistance Dogs.

Can I bring food and drink to an event?

Yes, you can bring food and drink to any of our outdoor events, there are plenty of nearby cafés, shops and bars where you will be able to purchase take-away food and drink. For everyone's safety only plastic bottles will be permitted.

Are all the venues accessible?

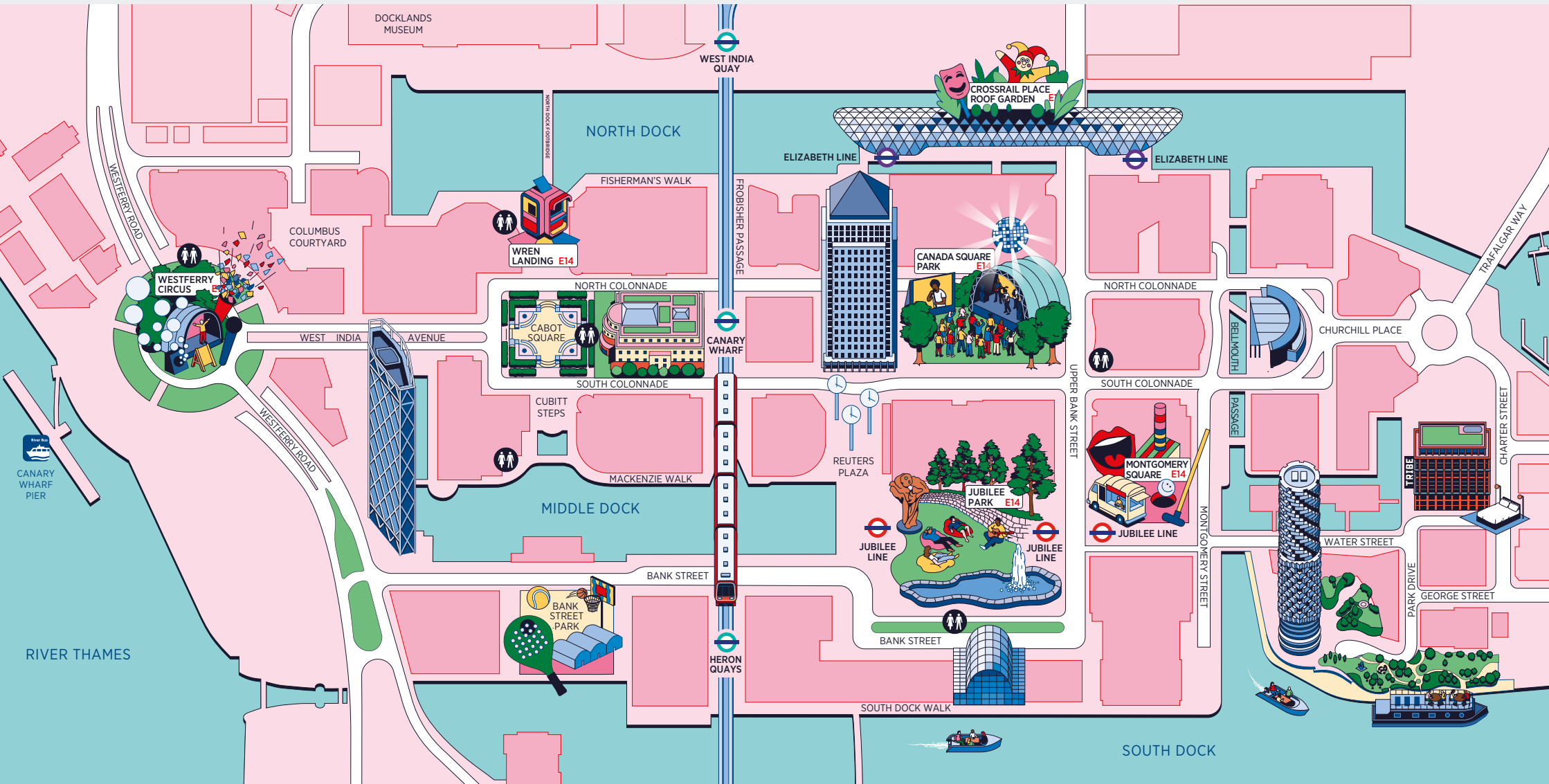

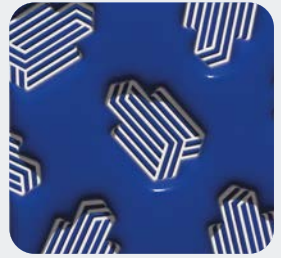
