Whereas the Local Government Commission for England, acting pursuant to section 15(4) of the Local Government Act 1992(a), has submitted to the Secretary of State a report on its review of the county of Hampshire, together with its recommendations:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the recommendation in relation to the creation of a parish in the borough of Eastleigh:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 17(b) and 26 of the Local Government Act 1992, and of all the powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Eastleigh (Parishes) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 14 December 1995.

Interpretation

In this Order-"borough" means the borough of Eastleigh; and "maps" means the maps prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Maps of the Eastleigh (Parishes) Order 1995", and deposited in accordance with regulation 27 of

Creation of new parish

3. In the borough, there shall be created a new parish of Bishopstoke consisting of the unparished area marked E1 on the maps.
