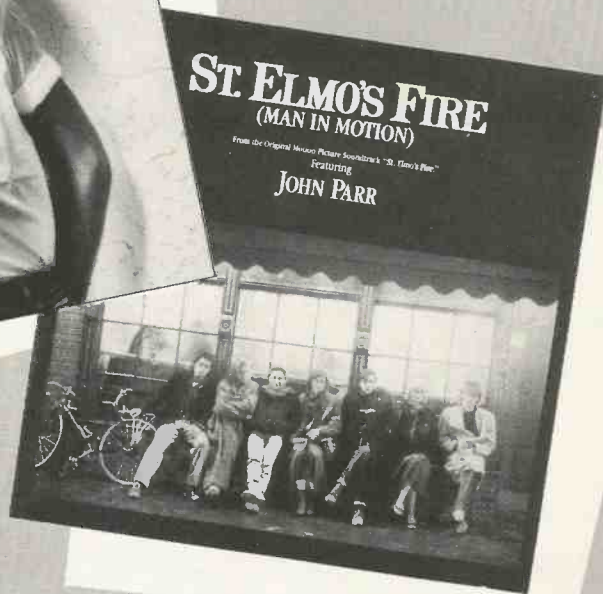

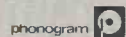

It is very clear that, even in spite of the bad weather, summer has arrived at the European Media. Many of our correspondents will not be reporting during the next three weeks and we wish all of you a great holidays and good weather! Don't forget to send us an original postcard from your favourite beach or mountain... We have a 'special' price for the most original contribution. In the meantime we are working on an advanced system for reporting your tips and in any case we will start as from next week with a new feature called **Highlights**. On this page we will sum up the most significant changes per territory, which will give you an instant glance into the important European happenings of that week. It also gives us the chance to further improve our dedication towards music produced in Europe. We have a very good feeling about the fact that more and more European productions are crossing over, not only to other territories in Europe, but also in vast quantities to the USA, Australasia and Japan. Make sure to follow the 'Highlights' section

every week as it will give you a chance to spot the next Crossover hits at a very early stage. We are already starting to mention these Highlights in this Radio Guide and they will be continued in the special section as from next week.

#### ROCK ME AMADEUS

Starting with Germany, the major stations are very early with their supportive reports on Harold Faltermeyer's follow-up hit *Fletch*, as it is already record of the week for influential station SWF. Another international single getting early positive reactions is English John Parr with his theme song to the not yet released film *St. Elmo's Fire*. And it is good to see that Carly Simon's new single and album are being added to various playlists. Falco's *Rock Me Amadeus* is doing great too. Going to the Benelux, the top spot remains for Springsteen (Fire), but he is challenged by Faltermeyer's *Axel F*. Other international risers include Five Star, Tina Turner (expect Top 3), Eurythmics, Bryan Adams, Howard Jones and Euro-Crossover Baltimore. Dutch productions are doing very well and in different styles. George Baker scores yet another hit as his *Santa Lucia* jumps in the Top 10. Stevie Wonder sound-alike Georgie

Davies has a major hit for CNR, a company that is doing extremely well with Dutch productions as is further proven this week by Roberto Jacketti & The Scooters (Alarmschijf... actually Carrere), Albert West and the afore mentioned George Baker. Other Dutch productions doing well include Band Of Gold and Anita Meyer (Ariola), Gerard Joling (WEA), Vanessa (EMI) and CBS's Time Bandits, who actually have a US hit with a song released almost two years ago.

#### FRENCH DELIGHTS

As we all know French audience is very loyal once it has discovered a national pop hero and one can still sell a million singles. Rita Mitsouko definitely has a major smash with *Marcia Baila* but on FM level the most added single is CBS's Jean Jacques Goldman: *Je Marche Seul*. The French also have their own *Live Is Life*, as Stargo's version is competing with Opus for the top spot. Other French productions doing very well include Johnny Halliday's latest, Etienne Daho, Lune De Miel, Marc Lavoine and Gold. But more about this next week.

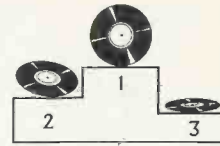

## POINTERS BREAK OUT!

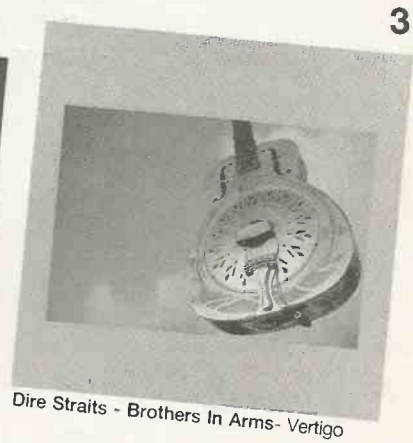
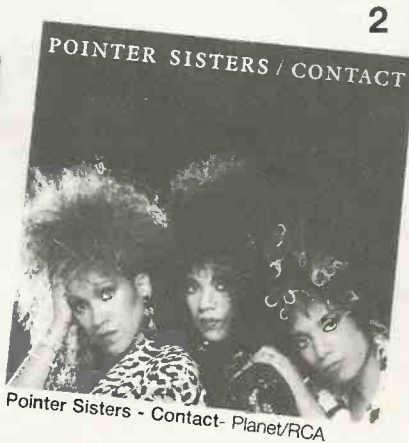
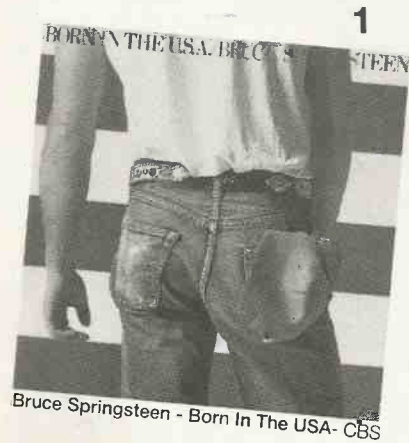

Many of our deejays are hoping for an early release on the next Tina Turner *Mad Max* album, to follow the instant single success, but we believe Capitol doesn't plan this release for a while yet. Billy Joel has delivered his double *Greatest Hits* album, which presents you all with an easy tool for a 'Joel Hour', especially now that the single *You're Only Human (Second Wind)* is taking off. Strong reports on this track already from the UK and Holland (Steunplaat). The slow-rising but sure-hitting *Heaven* urges you all to re-examine Bryan Adams'

present and former material. Believe us, it sounds great on radio and Bryan is on his way to become a rock favourite for whom we can predict a long lasting career. This kind of artist finds usually a more instantaneous breeding ground in the US (although Bryan comes from Canada), but once European audience (and radio for that matter) discovers these kind of talents, we are quick to follow. Just look what's happening with Uncle Bruce! The single hit *Let Me Be The One* for RCA's *Five Star* is translated into an interesting debut album, which is therefore one of our frontpage tips this week, together with Billy Joel. They are complimented with yet another debut album (and a good one too!) for Jaki Graham. No doubt the Euro Airwaves will be filled with a lot of Laura Branigan now that she releases her follow up album *Hold Me* on Atlantic and the single *Spanish Eddie* is already record of the week on various stations. She is very suitable for summer play as is the new Beach Boys LP. We don't think their single *Getcha Back* will be a very big European hit, but don't underestimate the amount of airplay this title receives.

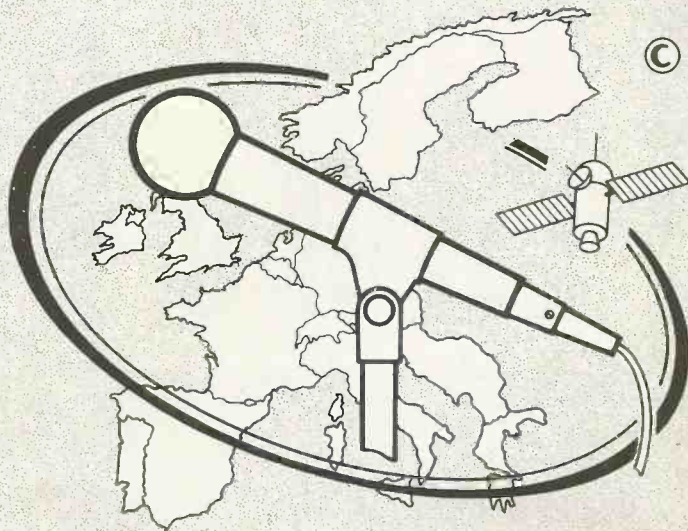
