Extension to Consultation Period for Command Paper on Marriage Act

On 22nd December 2015 the draft Bill to amend the Marriage Act was published as a Command Paper for public consultation. This is the start of the consultation in the legislative process; the stage before the proposal becomes a Bill for consideration and debate in Parliament.

The standard two week consultation period for Command Papers was originally extended to three weeks to accommodate the Christmas holidays. After receiving numerous responses Her Majesty's Government of Gibraltar is further extending the consultation period until Friday 29th January 2016 in order to ensure the widest possible public consultation.
