

Port Jervis High School

COMMUNITY: Port Jervis City School District serves a community of 9,000 people over an area of 125 square miles which includes the City of Port Jervis and the Town of Deerpark in Orange County, New York. We are located in upstate NY; the tri-state area of NY, NJ and PA. Our secondary schools also include tuition students from Montague, NJ. The community has a relatively low socioeconomic status with a large senior citizen population. The metropolitan area of New York City is approximately 85 miles from Port Jervis.

<u>SCHOOL:</u> Port Jervis High School a located on Rt. 209, Port Jervis, NY. It is a modern structure, attached by Anna S. Kuhl Elementary School. Enrollment in grades 9 through 12 is **800.**

RANK IN CLASS AND GPA: Grade point average and class rank reflect the academic achievement of all students during their enrollment at Port Jervis High and are computergenerated throughout the year. All courses are included in the computation with the exception of those graded on a pass/fail basis. Honors, AP, and College classes are weighted an additional 5 points for ranking.

<u>CURRICULA:</u> Comprehensive High School program with sequential courses available in all college preparatory subjects as well as in art, music, family and consumer science, business and technology. Twenty-two credits including physical education, computer literacy, and the successful completion of New York State Regents exams are required for graduation. New York State Regents and Advanced Regents high school diplomas are available.

Port Jervis High School requires a minimum of 22 credits and passing grades on NY State Regents exams for graduation.
