# PROJECT OVERVIEW – MAJOR MILESTONES

#### **1996: Feasibility** Study/Site Selection

1997-2007: Project refinement, NEPA, land acquisition 2008: Phase I Construction of Infrastructure and P&R Lot





2009: Phase II Architectural Design & Engineering for Terminal Building

2010: State of Good Repair Grant Awarded for Phase II 2012: CSX rejects platform permit without sidetrack; site is no longer cost feasible









- Opened in 1956
- Owned by CSX/located in CSX right of way
- Operated by Amtrak
- Adjacent to warehouses & industrial businesses






- 1,800 vehicles/day on Gaynor Avenue between Amtrak Station & Montague Avenue
- □ 193 (11%) are vehicles with 6+ tires or 3+ axles








## **CONCEPTUAL SITE PLAN - ROADWAYS**


### **CONCEPTUAL SITE PLAN – VEHICLE ACCESS**



# Conceptual Site Plan – Pedestrian & Bike Access


