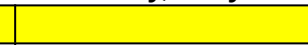
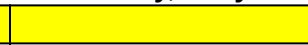
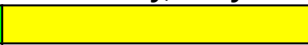

Weather Overview

Warm | Dry | Breezy to Windy → Elevated to Critical Fire Weather Conditions

Key Impacts:

- Warm and dry with repeated rounds of breezy to windy conditions throughout the week.
 - Critical fire weather conditions expected Thursday and Saturday, with elevated fire weather conditions Friday and Sunday.
 - Winds will be strongest on Saturday when gusts near 50 mph will be possible across eastern NM.
- Critical conditions will be most concerning for areas that have not yet experienced green-up. However, with repeated days of very low humidity, concern will increase toward the end of the week even in areas of green-up.*
- Virga induced erratic gusty winds will impact outdoor activities across far northeast NM today.
 - Gusts will be sudden with little to no warning from preceding rainfall.
