

## Weather Overview

Warm | Dry | Breezy to Windy  $\rightarrow$  Elevated to Critical Fire Weather Conditions

## Key Impacts:

- Warm and dry with repeated rounds of breezy to windy conditions throughout the week.
  - Critical fire weather conditions expected Thursday and Saturday, with elevated fire weather conditions Friday and Sunday.
  - Winds will be strongest on Saturday when gusts near 50 mph will be possible across eastern NM.

Critical conditions will be most concerning for areas that have not yet experienced green-up. However, with repeated days of very low humidity, concern will increase toward the end of the week even in areas of green-up.

- Virga induced erratic gusty winds will impact outdoor activities across far northeast NM today.
  - Gusts will be sudden with little to no warning from preceding rainfall.
