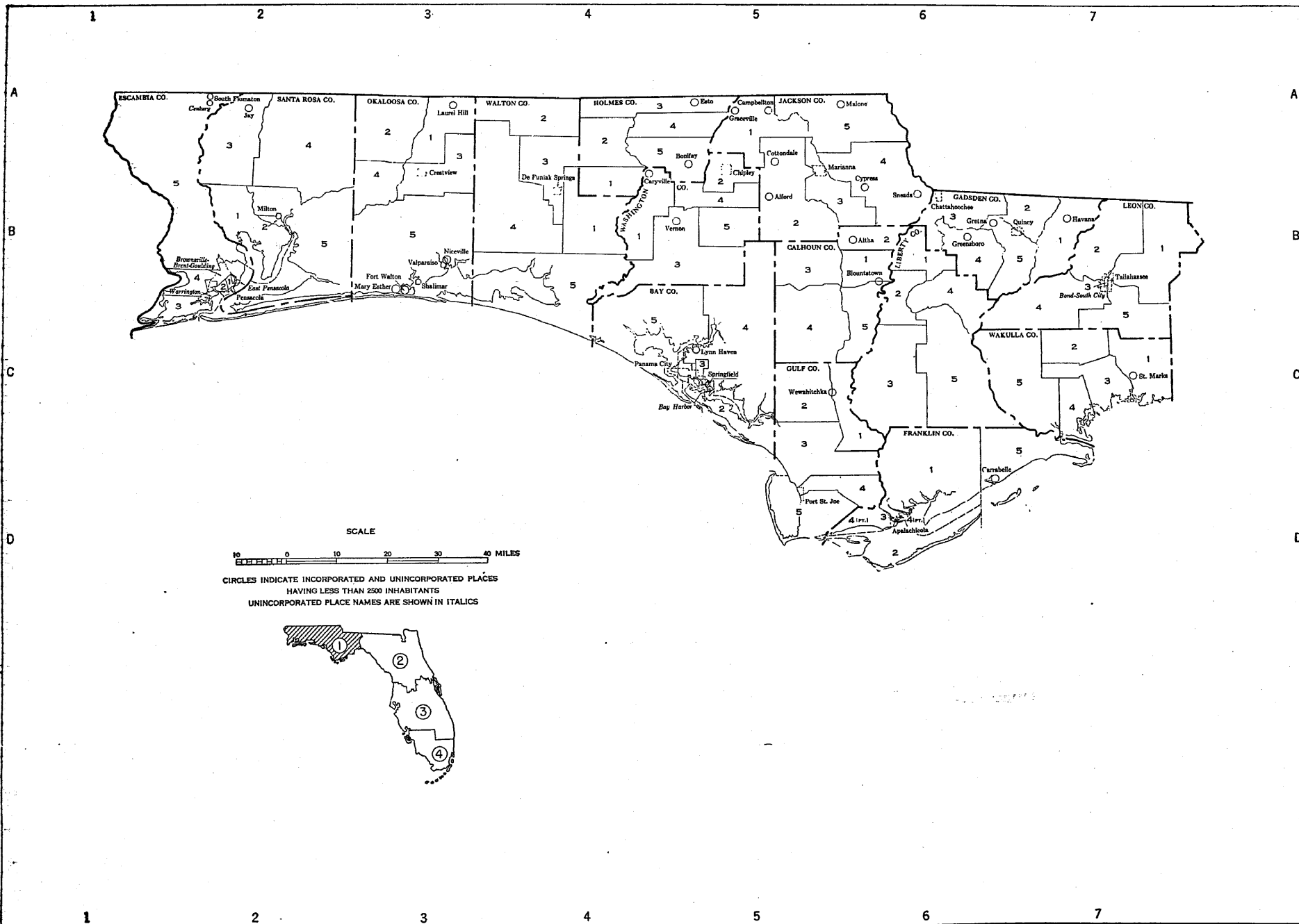
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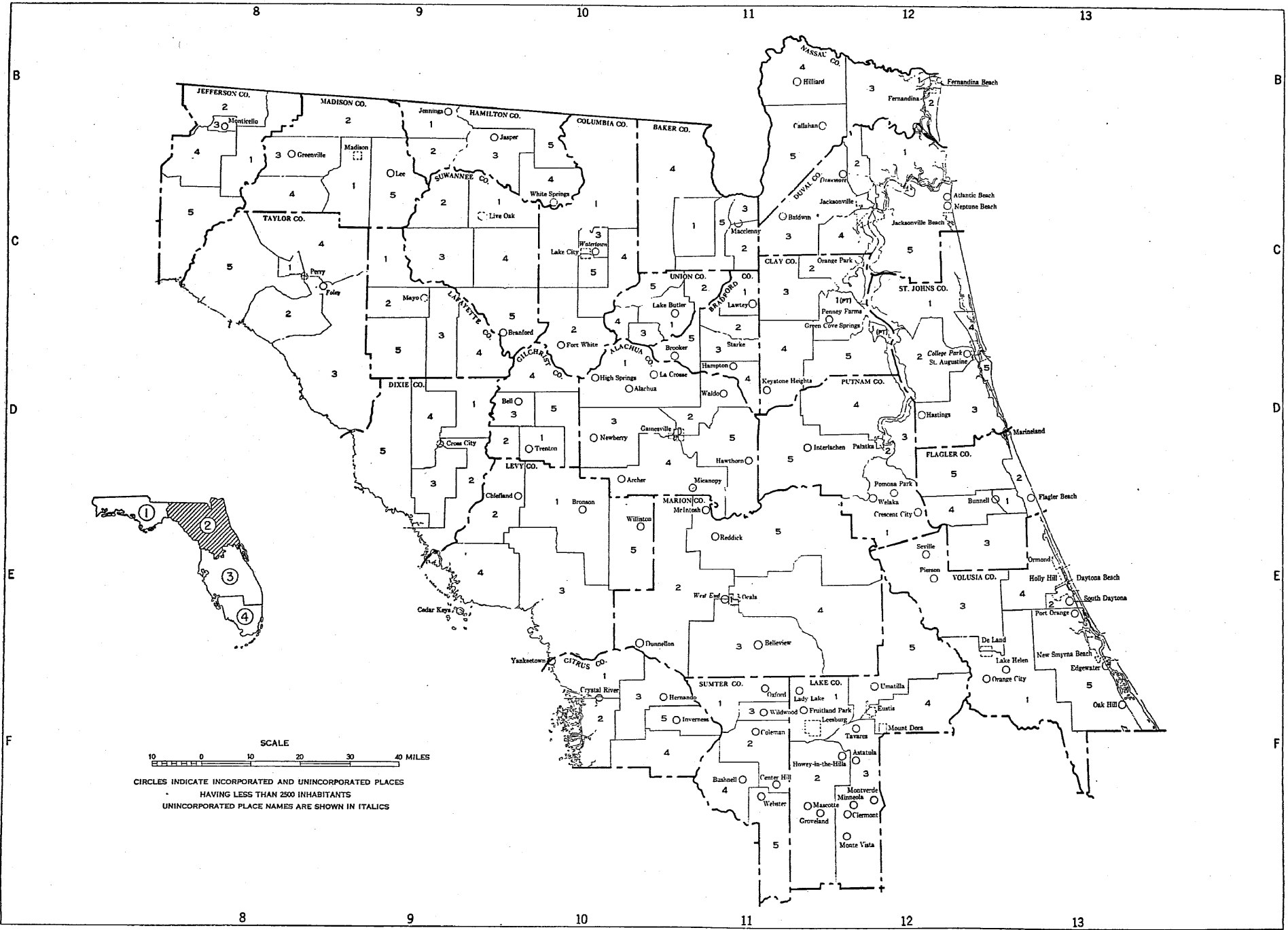
FLORIDA—SECTION 1, NORTHWESTERN PART

FLORIDA—SECTION 2, NORTHEASTERN PART

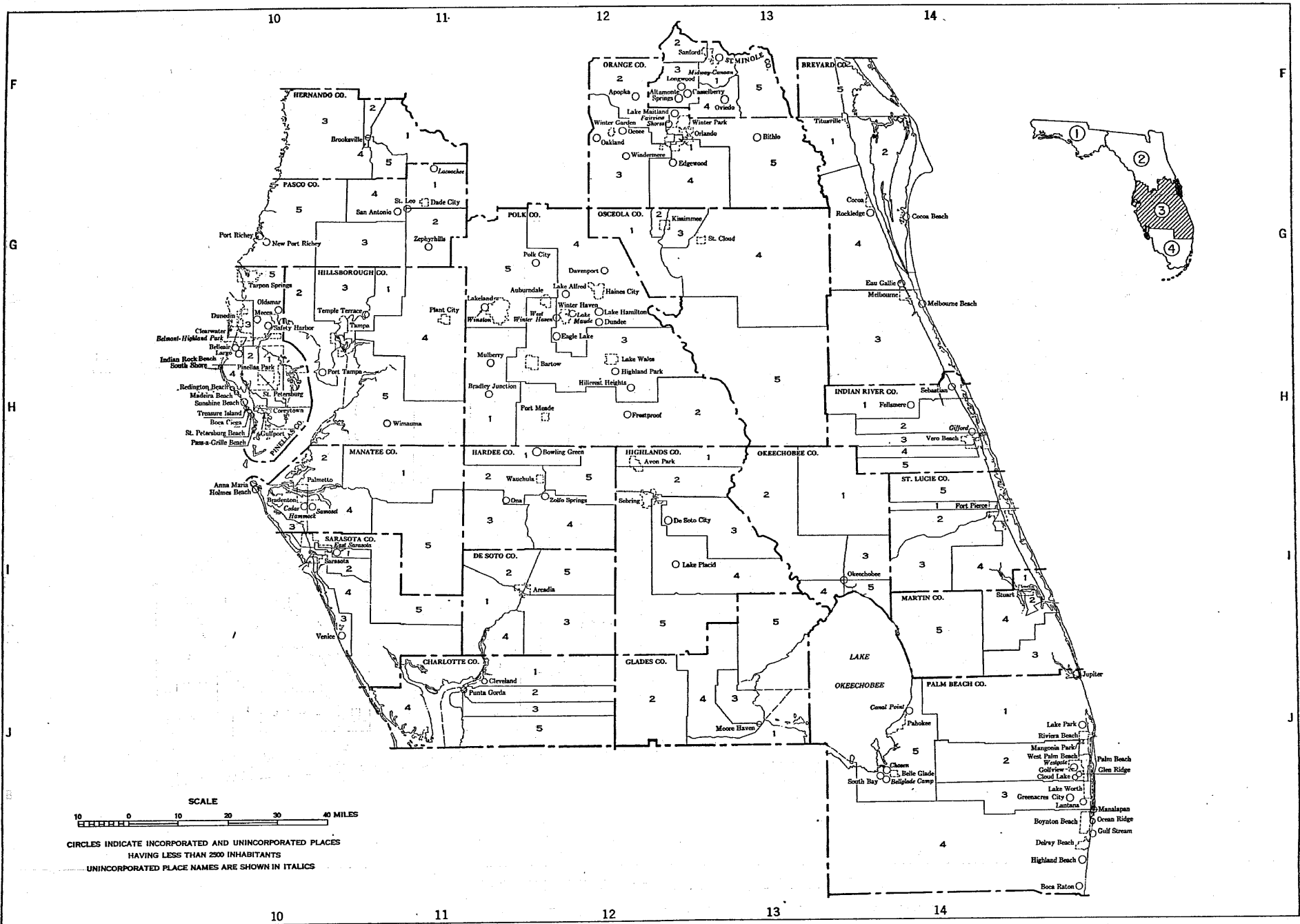

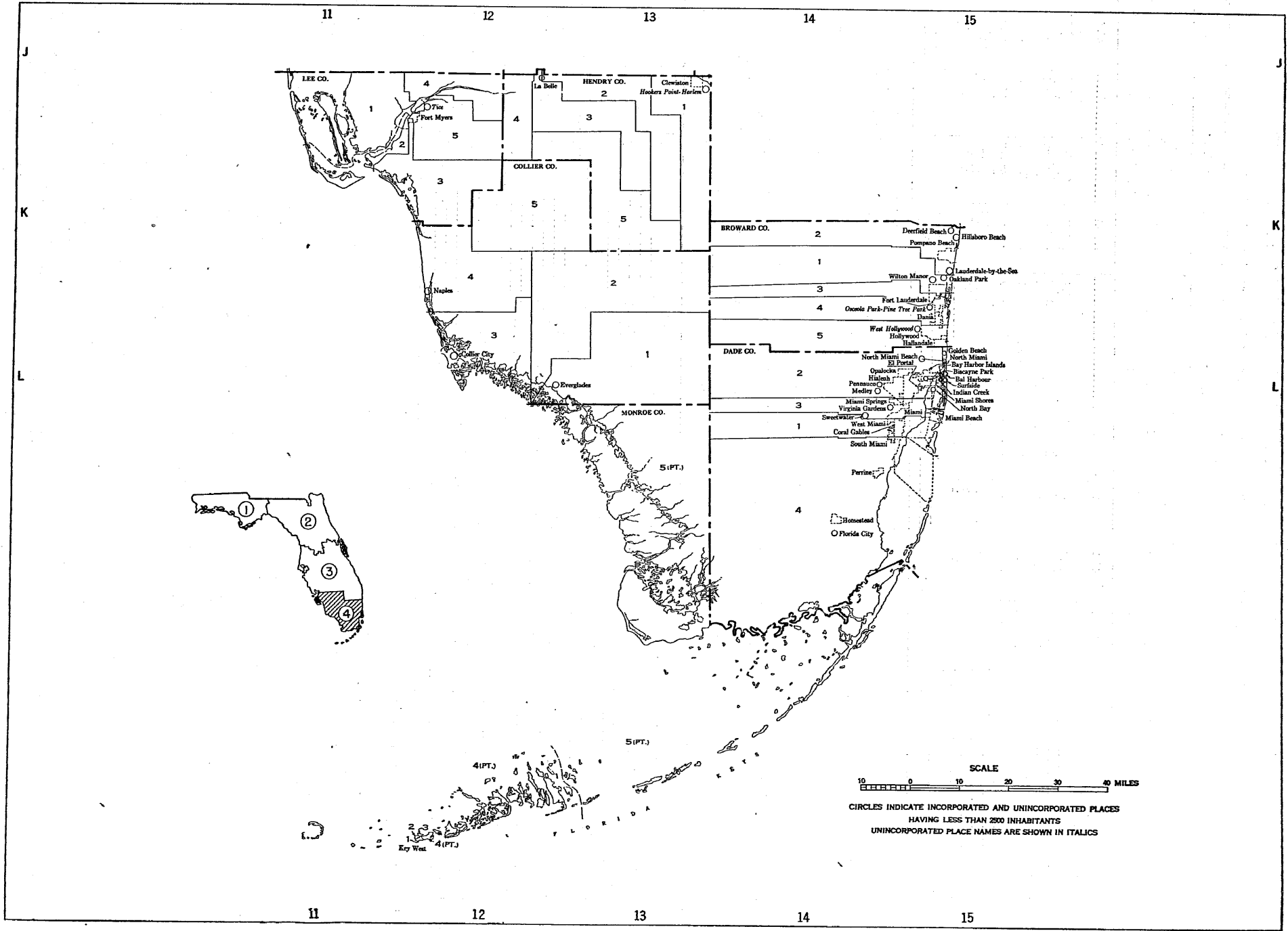

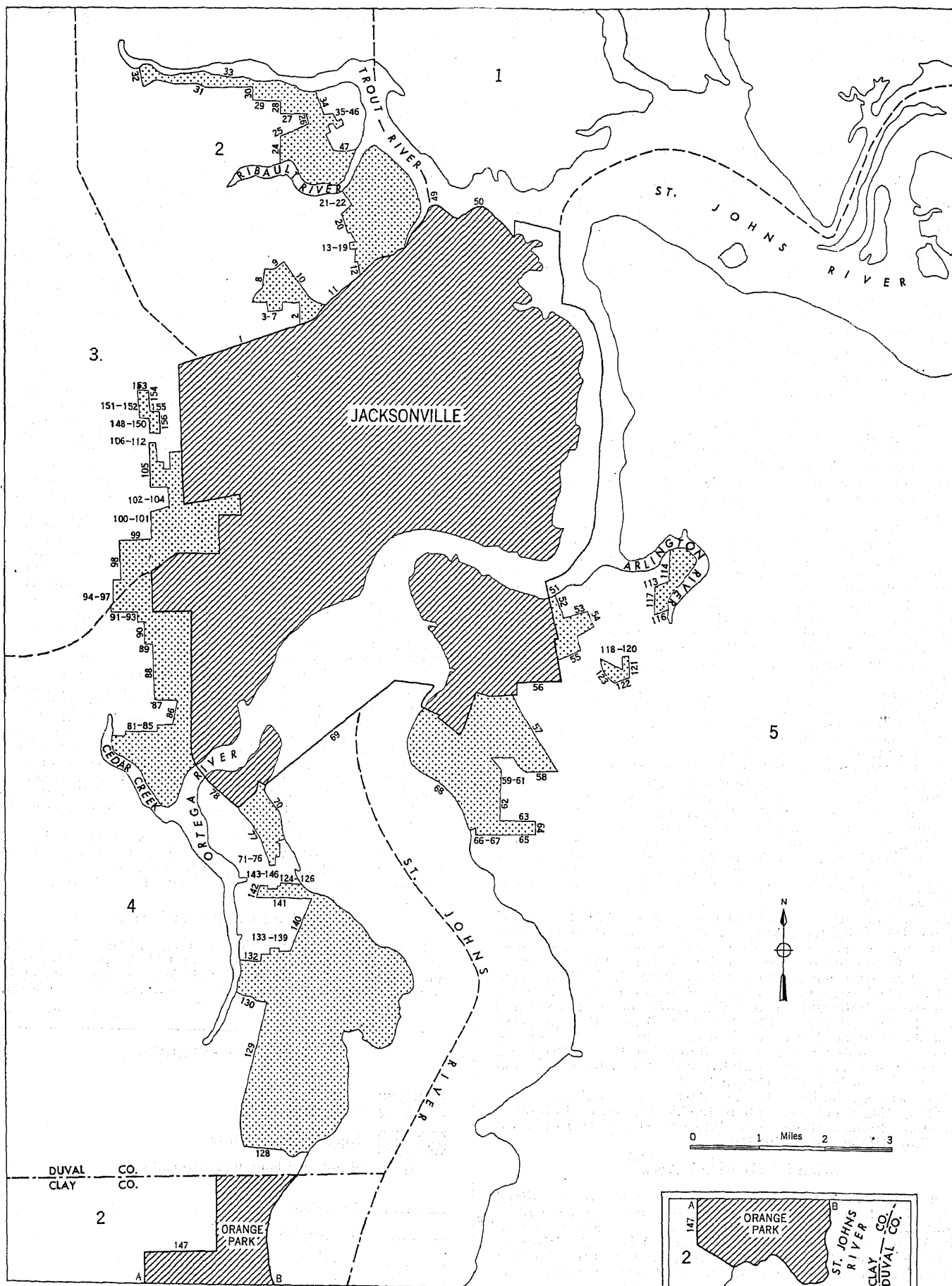

MIAMI URBANIZED AREA—NORTHERN PART

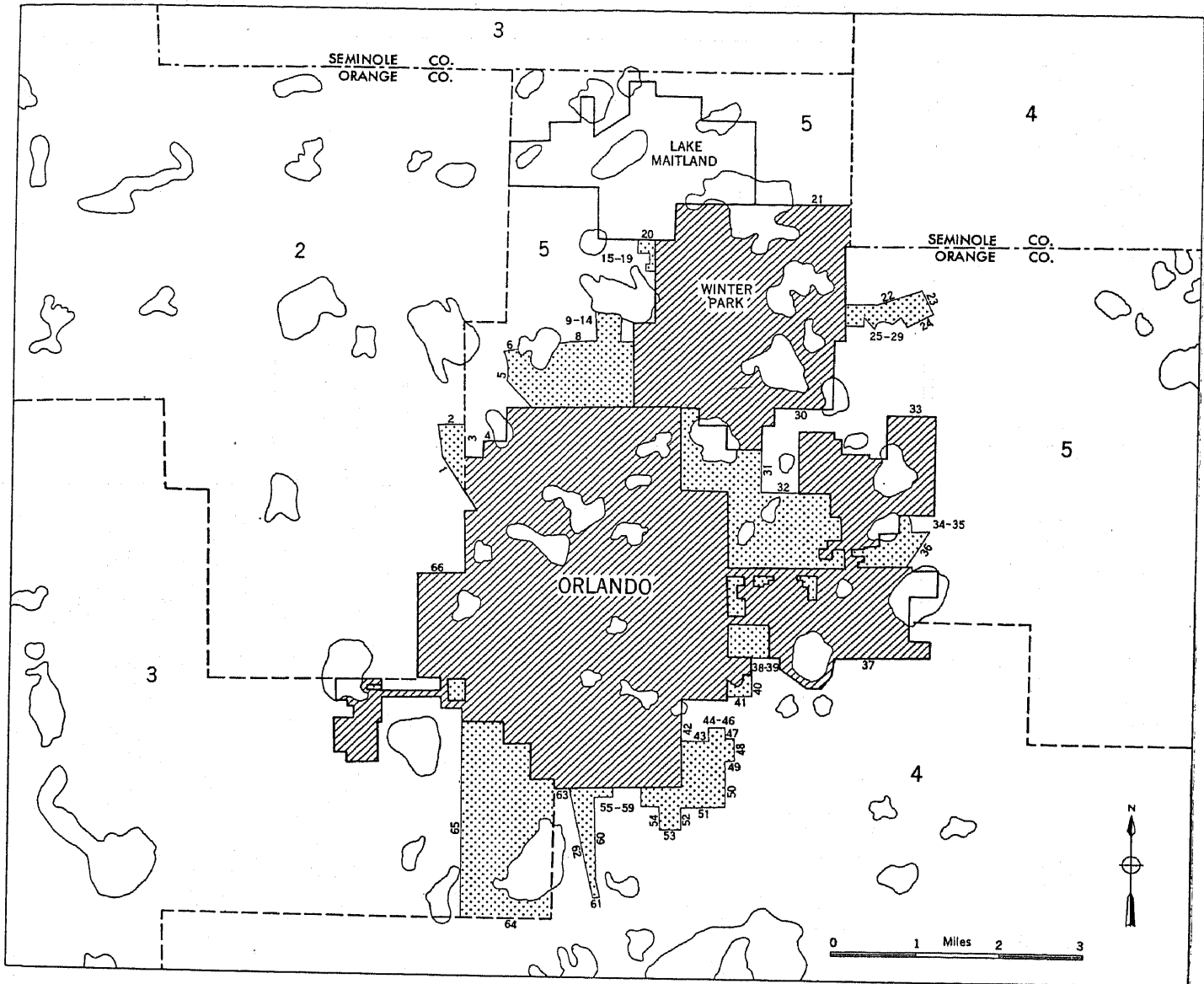








MIAMI URBANIZED AREA—SOUTHERN PART



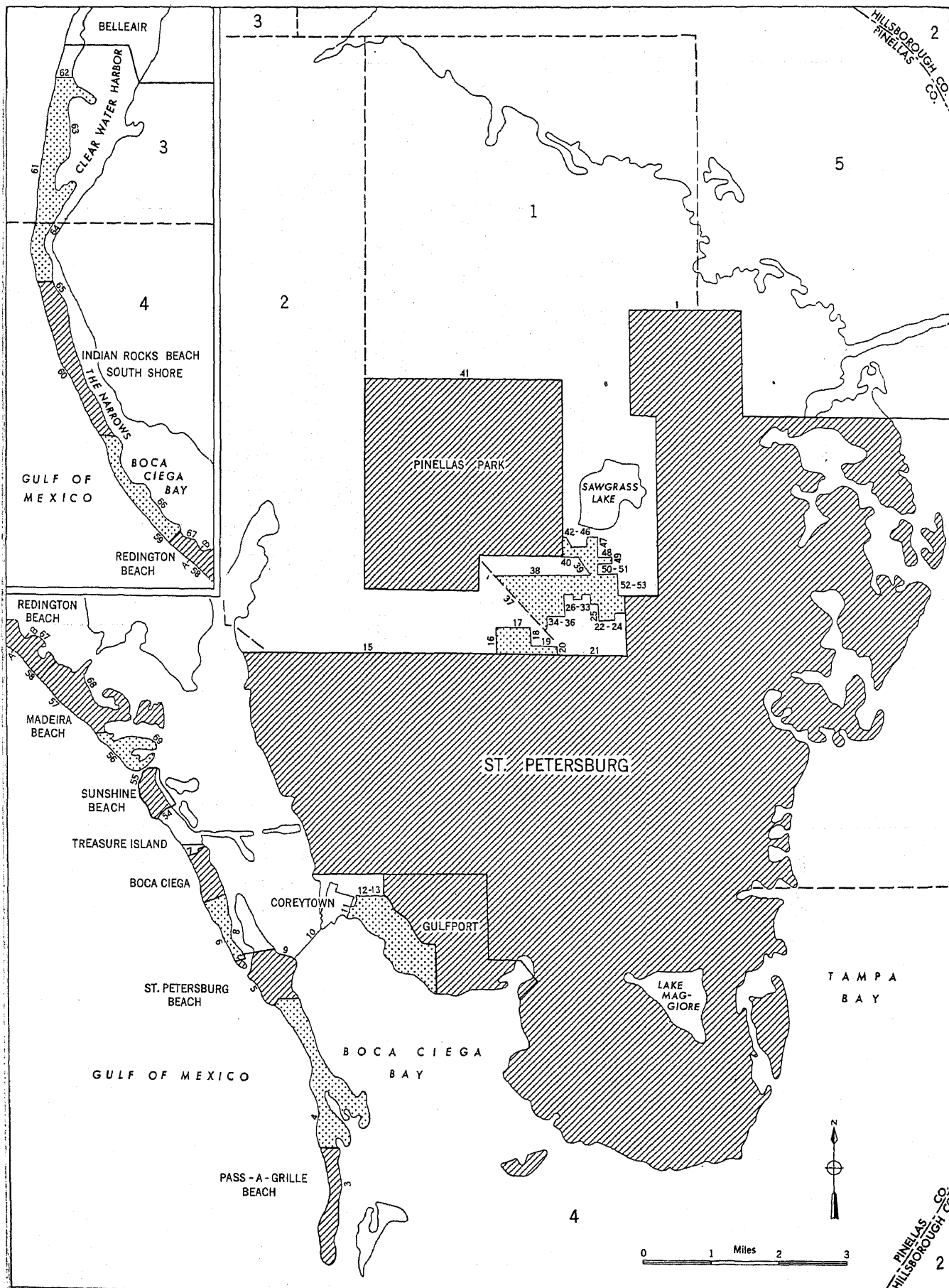

NUMBER OF INHABITANTS ORLANDO URBANIZED AREA

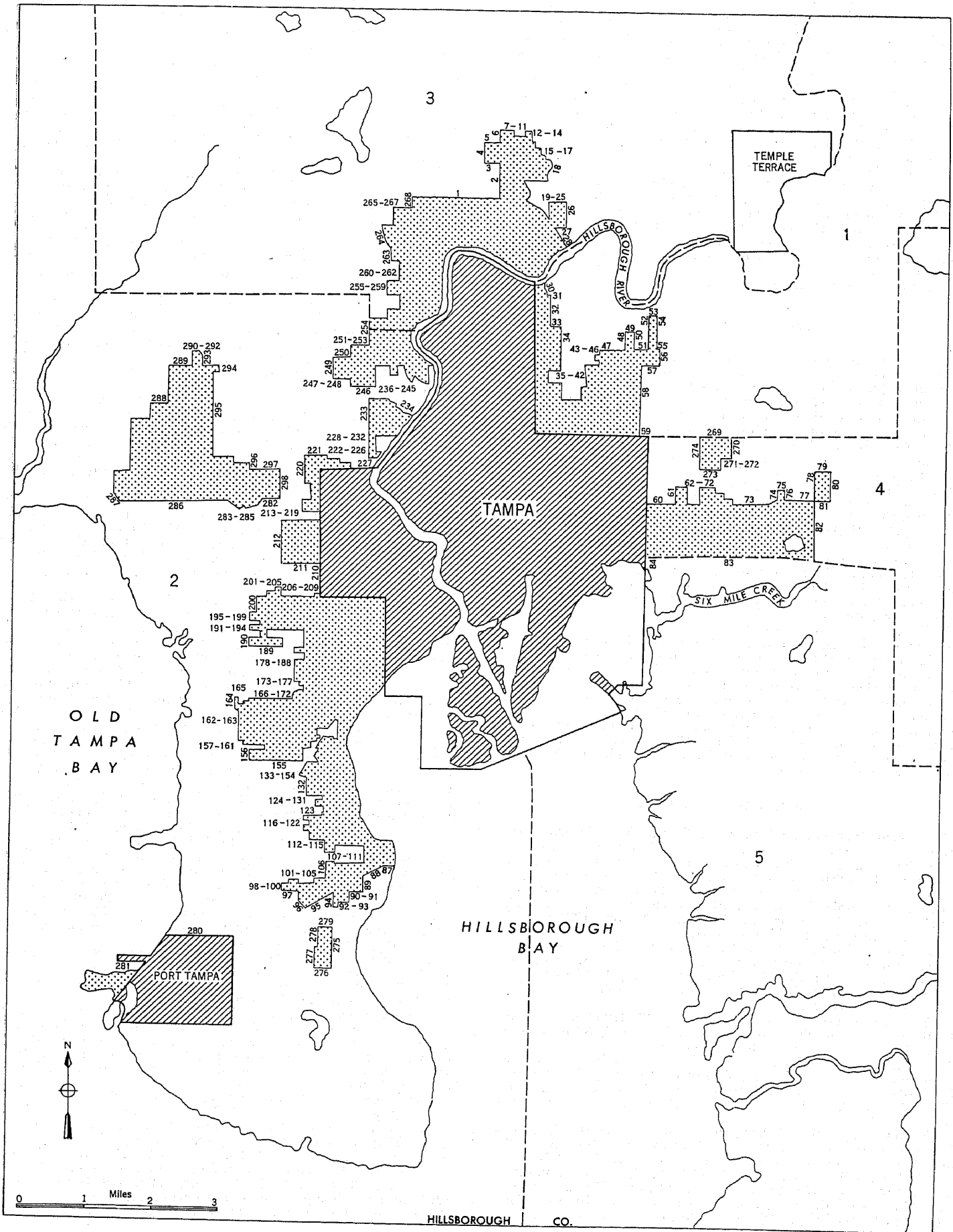
