APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS- FOR INDOOR USE AT RESIDENTIAL SITES: Surface spray uses are limited to spot treatments only. Broadcast surface applications are prohibited. Do not wet the treated area or article to the point of runoff. Do not use treated article until sprays have dried.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS **INDOORS**: FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: With Raid® Flying Insect Killer there is no need to spray directly at flying insects - the mist in the air will kill them. Close all doors and windows. Spray Raid® Flying Insect Killer up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture, until room is filled with mist. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.
